MORE THAN ONE IN EVERY SEVEN IDAHO RESIDENTS IS A MINORITY.
THE TOTAL MINORITY POPULATION OF IDAHO HAS REACHED AN
ESTIMATED 216-THOUSAND. HISPANICS REPRESENT THE LARGEST
MINORITY GROUP HERE, WITH 147-THOUSAND PEOPLE. SECOND WAS
AMERICAN INDIANS AND ALASKA NATIVES, WITH 32-THOUSAND
PEOPLE. NATIONALLY, HISPANICS REMAIN THE LARGEST MINORITY
