MORE THAN ONE IN EVERY TWO NEW MEXICO RESIDENTS IS A
MINORITY. THE TOTAL MINORITY POPULATION OF NEW MEXICO HAS
REACHED AN ESTIMATED ONE-POINT-ONE-MILLION. HISPANICS
REPRESENT THE LARGEST MINORITY GROUP HERE, WITH ALMOST 875-
THOUSAND PEOPLE. SECOND WAS AMERICAN INDIANS AND ALASKA
NATIVES, WITH 203-THOUSAND PEOPLE. NATIONALLY, HISPANICS
REMAIN THE LARGEST MINORITY GROUP, WITH BLACKS SECOND. FOR
