ANNOUNCER:

MORE THAN ONE IN EVERY THREE NEW YORK RESIDENTS IS A
MINORITY. THE TOTAL MINORITY POPULATION OF NEW YORK HAS
REACHED AN ESTIMATED SEVEN-POINT-SEVEN-MILLION. BLACKS
REPRESENT THE LARGEST MINORITY GROUP HERE, WITH MORE THAN
THREE-POINT-FIVE-MILLION PEOPLE. SECOND WAS HISPANICS, WITH
THREE-POINT-TWO-MILLION PEOPLE. NATIONALLY, HISPANICS
REMAIN THE LARGEST MINORITY GROUP, WITH BLACKS SECOND. FOR
