ANNOUNCER:

MORE THAN ONE IN EVERY THREE SOUTH CAROLINA RESIDENTS IS A
MINORITY. THE TOTAL MINORITY POPULATION OF SOUTH CAROLINA
HAS REACHED AN ESTIMATED ONE-POINT-FIVE-MILLION. BLACKS
REPRESENT THE LARGEST MINORITY GROUP HERE, WITH ALMOST ONE-
POINT-THREE MILLION PEOPLE. SECOND WAS HISPANICS, WITH
ALMOST 169-THOUSAND PEOPLE. NATIONALLY, HISPANICS REMAIN
THE LARGEST MINORITY GROUP, WITH BLACKS SECOND. FOR MORE
