ALMOST ONE IN EVERY FOUR WASHINGTON RESIDENTS IS A
MINORITY. THE TOTAL MINORITY POPULATION OF WASHINGTON HAS
REACHED AN ESTIMATED ONE-POINT-FIVE-MILLION. HISPANICS
REPRESENT THE LARGEST MINORITY GROUP HERE, WITH ALMOST
610-THOUSAND PEOPLE. SECOND WAS ASIANS, WITH 517-THOUSAND
PEOPLE. NATIONALLY, HISPANICS REMAIN THE LARGEST MINORITY
