New Residential Construction

During 2014, local building permit offices in the 2004 Universe authorized the construction of 1,046,363 new privately-owned housing units with a total valuation of \$193.2 billion. This was 0.8 percent above the preliminary annual estimate of 1,038,491 housing units and is a 5.6 percent increase from the 2013 total of 990,822.
