In mid-October, the Census Bureau will recommend whether Census 2000 data should be adjusted for future uses, such as the census long form data products, intercensal population estimates, and Census Bureau demographic survey controls. In order to inform this decision, further research will be conducted generating data for ESCAP's review. The analysis will focus on resolving the concerns that ESCAP identified during its deliberations for the March 1, 2001 redistricting adjustment decision. The attached document describes the research agenda.
