Subject 15 CFR Part 30

Dear Sir:

I am from KLM Airlines responsible to ensure all new rulings take effect by deadline given.

For Mandatory Automated Export Systems have some questions from the airline point of view.

8219: The carrier shall deliver the manifest to the CBP Port Director for split shipments.

On the manifest split has to be seen. Does this mean for all split shipments the word split must show on manifest? Is there a form that airlines must submit?

8221: Each airwaybill or other document shall contain appropriate AES number.

What is the requirement of the airline? When airwaybills are received must we ensure an AES number is on the AWB? How do we recognize these numbers?

Does the airline ensure correct amount of numbers are on AWB?

After checked does the airline manually submit AWB's and manifests to customs?

If there are several HWB's there can be many AES filing citations for a MAWB. Can this be listed on a separate page or all must be on MAWB?

Thanks in advance as would like to send letter to agents as soon as possible.

Is the effective date confirmed?
