

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


Total Manufacturing Shipments and Three Month Moving Average




Total Manufacturing New Orders and Three Month Moving Average

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Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in April decreased \$10.4 billion or 3.0 percent to \$336.9 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows a 0.7 percent March increase. Year to date, new orders for 2001 are 4.3 percent below the same period a year ago.

Shipments decreased \$8.5 billion or 2.5 percent to \$338.9 billion, following a 0.1 percent March decrease. Year to date, shipments for 2001 are 2.4 percent below the same period a year ago.

Unfilled orders, down four consecutive months, decreased \$2.0 billion or 0.3 percent to \$584.5 billion, following a slight March decrease. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 4.28, up from 4.11 in March.

Inventories increased \$0.4 billion or 0.1 percent to \$481.0 billion, following a 0.8 percent March decrease. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.42, up from 1.38 in March.

New Orders

New Orders for manufactured durable goods in April decreased \$9.6 billion or 5.0 percent to \$184.3 billion, unrevised from the previously published 5.0 percent decrease.

Transportation equipment had the largest decrease, \$5.6 billion or 9.6 percent to \$52.6 billion. Computers and electronic products, led by semiconductors, decreased \$4.1 billion or 10.3 percent to \$36.2 billion; this is the fourth decrease in the last five months. Primary metals, down six of the last seven months, decreased \$0.4 billion or 3.2 percent to \$11.5 billion.

New orders for nondurable goods decreased \$0.8 billion or 0.5 percent to \$152.6 billion.

Shipments

Shipments of durable goods in April decreased \$7.7 billion or 4.0 percent to \$186.4 billion, revised from the previously published 3.6 percent decrease. This is the fifth decrease in the last seven months and the largest since February 2000.

Transportation equipment had the largest decrease, \$3.4 billion or 6.4 percent to \$49.2 billion. Computers and electronic products, down four consecutive months, decreased \$2.9 billion or 6.9 percent to \$39.4 billion. Machinery, down three consecutive months, decreased \$0.6 billion or 2.3 percent to \$24.7 billion. Primary metals, down nine of the last ten months, decreased \$0.4 billion or 3.7 percent to \$11.7 billion.

Shipments of nondurable goods decreased \$0.8 billion or 0.5 percent to \$152.6 billion. Basic chemicals had the largest decrease, \$0.9 billion or 2.3 percent to \$36.3 billion.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled Orders for durable goods in April decreased \$2.0 billion or 0.3 percent to \$584.5 billion, revised from the previously published 0.2 percent decrease.

Computers and electronic products, led by semiconductors, had the largest decrease, \$3.3 billion or 2.2 percent to \$143.0 billion; this is the fifth consecutive decrease. Machinery, down four consecutive months, decreased \$0.6 billion or 1.0 percent to \$61.9 billion. Transportation equipment increased \$3.4 billion or 1.2 percent to \$289.1 billion.

Inventories

Inventories of durable goods in April increased \$0.4 billion or 0.1 percent to \$307.5 billion, unrevised from the previously published 0.1 percent increase.

Transportation equipment had the largest increase, \$1.0 billion or 1.3 percent to \$76.0 billion.

Inventories of nondurable goods increased slightly to \$173.5 billion.

By stage of fabrication, April finished goods increased 0.5 percent in durables and 0.6 percent in nondurables. Work in process increased 0.1 percent in durables and decreased 0.4 percent in nondurables. Materials and supplies decreased 0.1 percent in durables and 0.5 percent in nondurables.

Note: Estimates of manufacturers' shipments, inventories and orders are subject to survey error and revision. One major component of survey error is nonsampling error, which includes errors of coverage, response, and nonreporting. Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated. Further details on survey design, methodology, and data limitations are contained in our most recent annual benchmark publication, Current Industrial Reports: M3-1(00), "Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders: 1992-2000."






Total Manufacturing Shipments and Three Month Moving Average




Total Manufacturing New Orders and Three Month Moving Average



Total Manufacturing Total Inventories and Three Month Moving Average




Total Manufacturing Ratios of Unfilled Orders and Total Inventories to Shipments




**Nondefense Capital Goods

Moving Average**




**Nondefense Capital Goods
