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Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in December increased \$3.9 billion or 1.2 percent to \$322.2 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows a 4.3 percent November decrease. New orders for 2001 were 8.2 percent below 2000; new orders for the fourth quarter were 0.3 percent below the third quarter.

Shipments increased \$1.8 billion or 0.6 percent to \$326.7 billion, following a 1.2 percent November decrease. Shipments for 2001 were 5.4 percent below 2000; shipments for the fourth quarter were 1.7 percent below the third quarter.

Unfilled orders, down eleven of the last twelve months, decreased \$4.4 billion or 0.8 percent to \$545.6 billion, following a 1.2 percent November decrease. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 4.25, down from 4.30 in November.

Inventories, down eleven consecutive months, decreased \$2.6 billion or 0.6 percent to \$448.8 billion, following a 1.3 percent November decrease. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.37 down from 1.39 in November.

New Orders

New Orders for manufactured durable goods in December increased \$3.0 billion or 1.7 percent to \$175.9 billion, revised from the previously published 2.0 percent increase.

Transportation equipment had the largest increase, \$1.7 billion or 3.6 percent to \$49.8 billion, mostly due to missiles, space vehicles, and parts. Computers and electronic products, led by semiconductors, increased \$1.0 billion or 3.1 percent to \$33.2 billion; this was the third consecutive increase.

New orders for nondurable goods increased \$0.9 billion or 0.6 percent to \$146.3 billion.

Shipments

Shipments of durable goods in December increased \$0.9 billion or 0.5 percent to \$180.4 billion, unrevised from the previously published 0.5 percent December increase.

Transportation equipment, up three consecutive months, had the largest increase, \$0.9 billion or 1.7 percent to \$54.0 billion, due to missiles, space vehicles, and parts. Computers and electronic products, up three consecutive months, increased \$0.6 billion or 1.9 percent to \$33.9 billion. Machinery decreased \$0.4 billion or 1.7 percent to \$22.3 billion. Primary metals, down four of the last five months, decreased \$0.3 billion or 2.9 percent to \$10.9 billion; this was the lowest level since December 1993.

Shipments of nondurable goods increased \$0.9 billion or 0.6 percent to \$146.3 billion. Beverage and tobacco products and petroleum and coal products had the largest increases.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled Orders for durable goods in December, down eleven of the last twelve months, decreased \$4.4 billion or 0.8 percent to \$545.6 billion, revised from the previously published 0.7 percent decrease.

Transportation equipment, led by nondefense aircraft and parts, had the largest decrease, \$4.2 billion or 1.5 percent to \$277.7 billion. Computers and electronic products, down thirteen consecutive months, decreased \$0.7 billion or 0.6 percent to \$125.1 billion, mostly due to nondefense communications equipment. Machinery, up for the first time since June, increased \$0.5 billion or 0.8 percent to \$58.3 billion.

Inventories

Inventories of durable goods in December, down eleven consecutive months, decreased \$1.8 billion or 0.6 percent to \$283.8 billion, revised from the previously published 0.4 percent decrease. Durable goods inventories were at their lowest level since January 1998.

Computers and electronic products, down ten consecutive months, had the largest decrease, \$1.6 billion or 3.2 percent to \$49.3 billion. Transportation equipment increased \$1.1 billion or 1.5 percent to \$74.3 billion, mostly due to defense aircraft and parts.

Inventories of nondurable goods, down eleven consecutive months, decreased \$0.7 billion or 0.4 percent to \$165.0 billion.

By stage of fabrication, December finished goods decreased 0.3 percent in durables and increased 0.4 percent in nondurables. Work in process decreased 0.7 percent in durables and increased 0.1 percent in nondurables. Materials and supplies decreased 0.9 percent in durables and 1.8 percent in nondurables.

Note: Estimates of manufacturers' shipments, inventories and orders are subject to survey error and revision. One major component of survey error is nonsampling error, which includes errors of coverage, response, and nonreporting. Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated. 




Total Manufacturing

Moving Average




Total Manufacturing

Moving Average




Total Manufacturing

Inventories to Shipments




Nondefense Capital Goods

Moving Average




Nondefense Capital Goods
