




Total Manufacturing

Moving Average




Total Manufacturing

Inventories to Shipments





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Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in July increased \$0.5 billion or 0.1 percent to \$333.4 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows a 2.9 percent June decrease. Year to date, new orders for 2001 are 6.8 percent below the same period a year ago.

Shipments increased \$1.8 billion or 0.5 percent to \$339.1 billion, following a 2.9 percent June decrease. Year to date, shipments for 2001 are 3.6 percent below the same period a year ago.

Unfilled orders, down seven consecutive months, decreased \$5.7 billion or 1.0 percent to \$568.4 billion, following a 0.8 percent June decrease. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 4.21, down from 4.22 in June.

Inventories, down six consecutive months, decreased \$2.8 billion or 0.6 percent to \$469.2 billion, following a 1.0 percent June decrease. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.38, down from 1.40 in June.

New Orders

New Orders for manufactured durable goods in July decreased \$1.2 billion or 0.7 percent to \$182.2 billion, revised from the previously published 0.6 percent decrease.

Computers and electronic products had the largest decrease, \$1.5 billion or 4.5 percent to \$32.4 billion, due to semiconductors. Machinery decreased \$0.5 billion or 2.1 percent to \$23.7 billion. Transportation equipment increased \$0.5 billion or 0.9 percent to \$52.7 billion.

New orders for nondurable goods increased \$1.7 billion or 1.1 percent to \$151.2 billion.

Shipments

Shipments of durable goods in July increased slightly to \$187.9 billion, revised from the previously published 0.2 percent increase.

Transportation equipment had the largest increase, \$0.4 billion or 0.8 percent to \$54.1 billion. Machinery increased \$0.4 billion or 1.7 percent to \$24.6 billion, due to turbines,

generators, and other power transmission equipment. Computers and electronic products, led by nondefense communications equipment and semiconductors, decreased \$1.2 billion or 3.1 percent to \$35.8 billion; this is the seventh consecutive decrease. Electrical equipment decreased \$0.4 billion or 4.0 percent to \$10.5 billion; this is the sixth decrease in the last seven months and the largest since January 1999.

Shipments of nondurable goods increased \$1.7 billion or 1.1 percent to \$151.2 billion. Plastics and rubber products had the largest increase, \$0.6 billion or 4.3 percent to \$15.3 billion; this is the largest increase since March 1996.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled Orders for durable goods in July, down seven consecutive months, decreased \$5.7 billion or 1.0 percent to \$568.4 billion, unrevised from the previously published 1.0 percent decrease.

Computers and electronic products, led by semiconductors, had the largest decrease, \$3.4 billion or 2.5 percent to \$133.0 billion; this is the eighth consecutive decrease. Transportation equipment decreased \$1.3 billion or 0.5 percent to \$286.3 billion, led by nondefense aircraft and parts. Machinery, down six of the last seven months, decreased \$0.9 billion or 1.4 percent to \$60.4 billion.

Inventories

Inventories of durable goods in July decreased \$2.3 billion or 0.8 percent to \$298.6 billion, revised from the previously published 0.6 percent decrease.

Computers and electronic products, led by semiconductors, had the largest decrease, \$0.9 billion or 1.5 percent to \$56.7 billion; this is the fifth consecutive decrease.

Inventories of nondurable goods, down six consecutive months, decreased \$0.5 billion or 0.3 percent to \$170.6 billion.

By stage of fabrication, July finished goods decreased 0.8 percent in durables and 0.5 percent in nondurables. Work in process decreased 0.4 percent in durables and 0.2 percent in nondurables. Materials and supplies decreased 1.1 percent in durables and 0.2 percent in nondurables.

Note: Estimates of manufacturers' shipments, inventories and orders are subject to survey error and revision. One major component of survey error is nonsampling error, which includes errors of coverage, response, and nonreporting. Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated. Further details on survey design, methodology, and data limitations are contained in our most recent annual benchmark publication, Current Industrial Reports: M3-1(00), "Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders: 1992-2000."






Total Manufacturing

Moving Average




Total Manufacturing

Moving Average




Total Manufacturing

Inventories to Shipments




Nondefense Capital Goods

Moving Average




Nondefense Capital Goods
