

Summary

New orders for manufactured goods (excluding semiconductors) in March increased \$1.4 billion or 0.4 percent to \$318.5 billion, the Department of Commerce, Census Bureau reported today. This followed a 0.2 percent February increase. Year to date, new orders for 2002 were 5.5 percent below the same period a year ago; new orders for the first quarter were 0.3 percent below the fourth quarter.

Shipments (excluding semiconductors) increased \$2.3 billion or 0.7 percent to \$317.5 billion, following a 2.9 percent February decrease. Year to date, shipments for 2002 were 5.8 percent below the same period a year ago; shipments for the first quarter were 0.6 percent below the fourth quarter.

Unfilled orders (excluding semiconductors) increased \$1.0 billion or 0.2 percent to \$524.5 billion, following a 0.4 percent February increase. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 4.31, down slightly from 4.32 in February.

Inventories (excluding semiconductors), down fourteen consecutive months, decreased \$2.8 billion or 0.6 percent to \$431.5 billion, following a 0.5 percent February decrease. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.36, down from 1.38 in February.

New Orders

New Orders for manufactured durable goods (excluding semiconductors) in March decreased \$0.9 billion or 0.5 percent to \$173.4 billion, revised from the previously published 0.6 percent decrease.

Transportation equipment had the largest decrease, \$0.7 billion or 1.3 percent to \$56.1 billion.

New orders for nondurable goods increased \$2.3 billion or 1.6 percent to \$145.1 billion, led by an increase in petroleum and coal products.

Shipments

Shipments of durable goods (excluding semiconductors) in March slightly increased to \$172.4 billion, unrevised from the previously published estimate.

Primary metals had the largest increase, \$0.4 billion or 3.5 percent to \$11.2 billion. Machinery had the largest decrease, \$0.5 billion or 2.0 percent to \$23.0 billion, due to turbines, generators and other power transmission equipment.

Shipments of nondurable goods increased \$2.3 billion or 1.6 percent to \$145.1 billion, led by an increase in petroleum and coal products.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled Orders for durable goods (excluding semiconductors) in March increased \$1.0 billion or 0.2 percent to \$524.5 billion, unrevised from the previously published 0.2 percent increase.

Transportation equipment had the largest increase, \$3.6 billion or 1.3 percent to \$279.8 billion. Machinery, down eight of the last nine months, decreased \$1.2 billion or 2.2 percent to \$54.1 billion.

Inventories

Inventories of durable goods (excluding semiconductors) in March, down fourteen consecutive months, decreased \$2.6 billion or 1.0 percent to \$268.5 billion, revised from the previously published 1.1 percent decrease. Durable goods inventories were at their lowest level since December 1996.

Transportation equipment had the largest decrease, \$1.9 billion or 2.7 percent to \$71.1 billion.

Inventories of nondurable goods, down fourteen consecutive months, decreased \$0.1 billion or 0.1 percent to \$163.0 billion.

By stage of fabrication (excluding semiconductors), March materials and supplies increased 0.1 percent in durables and decreased 0.4 percent in nondurables. Work in process decreased 2.9 percent in durables and decreased 0.4 percent in nondurables. Finished goods increased 0.2 percent in durables and 0.2 percent in nondurables.

One major component of survey error is nonsampling error, which includes errors of coverage, response, and nonreporting. Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated. Further details on survey design, methodology, and data limitations are contained in our most recent annual benchmark publication, Current Industrial Reports: M3-1(00), "Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders: 1992-2000."
