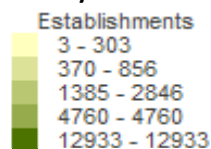

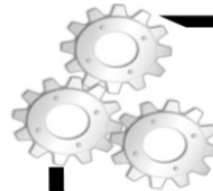
The Manufacturing sector was the 5th largest employer in California in 2010, with 1,144,382 employees, and ranked 7th in terms of average annual payroll per employee (\$57,898). Number of Manufacturing Establishments by County: 2010

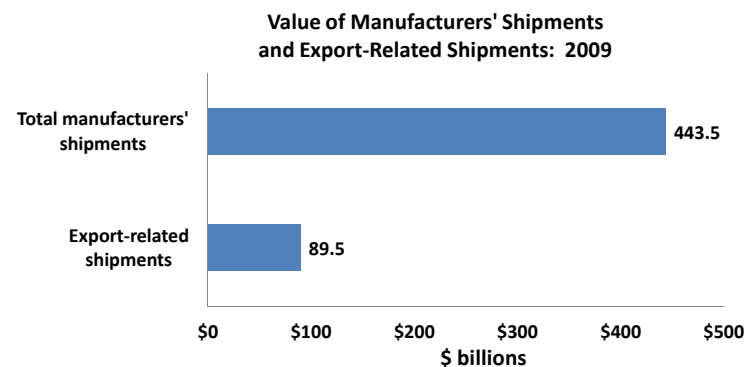

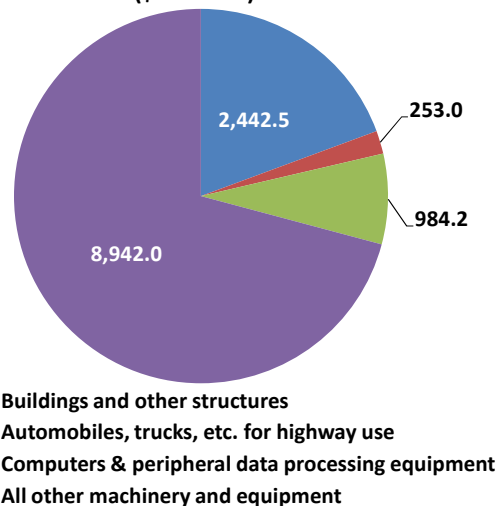
California's manufacturers created 51,571 new jobs in the third quarter of 2011.
