

Corrected Census 2000 Total Population, Group Quarters Population, Total Housing Unit, and Vacant Housing Unit Counts for Governmental Units

Note: Corrected counts are a result of the Count Question Resolution (CQR) Program.

Federal Register/Vol. 66, No. 130/Friday, July 6, 2001 (Summary): *The CQR program is not a mechanism or process to challenge the March 6, 2001, decision of the Secretary of Commerce to release unadjusted numbers from Census 2000 for redistricting purposes; nor is it a mechanism or process to challenge or revise the numbers sent to the President on December 28, 2000, to be used to apportion the U.S. House of Representatives.*

The state level census counts will always be presented, regardless of whether or not there is a CQR change to the counts at the state level. Below the state level, the tables will present census counts only for those governmental units in which a CQR change has occurred, with one exception. When a CQR change occurs in a place that is in more than one county, the table will display census counts for all the county parts, regardless of whether or not every part had a CQR change.
