## 2023 Annual Building Permits

#### **New Residential Construction**

During 2023, local building permit offices authorized the construction of 1,511,102 new privately-owned housing units with a total valuation of \$365.4 billion. This was 2.8 percent above the preliminary annual estimate of 1,470,596 housing units and is a 10.1 percent decrease from the 2022 total of 1,680,368.




