Errata

A processing error was discovered that affected the June 2003 New single family estimates. The estimates have been corrected. The error affects data for April, May and June because current month estimates affect estimates for prior months. The following seasonally adjusted and not seasonally adjusted series were affected: Total construction, Total residential, Total private, Private residential, and New single family.

JUNE 2003 CONSTRUCTION AT \$872.5 BILLION ANNUAL RATE

Construction put in place spending during June 2003 was estimated at a seasonally adjusted annual rate of \$872.5 billion, 0.3 (±1.3) percent above the revised May estimate of \$870.1 billion, according to the U.S. Commerce Department's Census Bureau. The June figure is 2.0 (±1.8) percent above the June 2002 estimate of \$855.0 billion.

During the first 6 months of this year, construction spending amounted to \$411.0 billion, 1.9 (±1.6) percent above the \$403.4 billion for the same period in 2002.

PRIVATE CONSTRUCTION

Spending on private construction was at a rate of \$660.3 billion, 0.0 (±1.3) percent above the revised May estimate of \$660.0 billion. Residential construction was at a seasonally adjusted annual rate of \$443.0 billion in June, 0.1 (±1.3) percent above the revised May estimate of \$442.7 billion.

PUBLIC CONSTRUCTION

In June, the estimated seasonally adjusted annual rate of public construction spending was \$212.2 billion, 1.0 (±2.1) percent above the revised May estimate of \$210.1 billion. Educational construction was at a seasonally adjusted annual rate of \$56.8 billion, 2.1 (±3.7) percent below the revised May estimate of \$58.1 billion. Highway construction was at a seasonally adjusted annual rate of \$58.4 billion, 1.9 (±5.4) percent above the revised May estimate of \$57.3 billion.

July 2003 data will be released on September 3, 2003 at 10:00 AM EDT.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

In interpreting changes in the statistics in this release, note that month-to-month changes in seasonally adjusted statistics often show movements which may be irregular. It may take 2 months to establish an underlying trend for total construction and as long as 8 months for specific categories of construction.

The statistics in this release are estimated from several sources and surveys and are subject to sampling variability as well as nonsampling errors including bias and variance from response, nonreporting, and undercoverage. Estimates of the standard errors are provided in Table 3. Whenever a statement such as "2.3 (±3.1) percent above" appears in the text, this indicates the range (-0.8 to +5.4 percent) in which the actual percent change is likely to have occurred. All ranges given are 90 percent confidence intervals. If the range contains zero, it is uncertain whether there was an increase or decrease; that is, the change was not statistically significant. For any comparison cited without a confidence interval, the change is statistically significant. Statistics for the current month are preliminary estimates subject to revision in following months as additional data become available. The average absolute percent changes from preliminary estimate to first revision for the major seasonally adjusted components are as follows: total construction, 0.7 percent; private construction, 0.7 percent; and public construction, 1.6 percent.

This is the first release of construction spending data in a new and improved format. Also, the constant (1996 dollars) series has been discontinued. More detailed data and a discussion of methodologies appear at our website: http://www.census.gov/const/www/c30index.html
