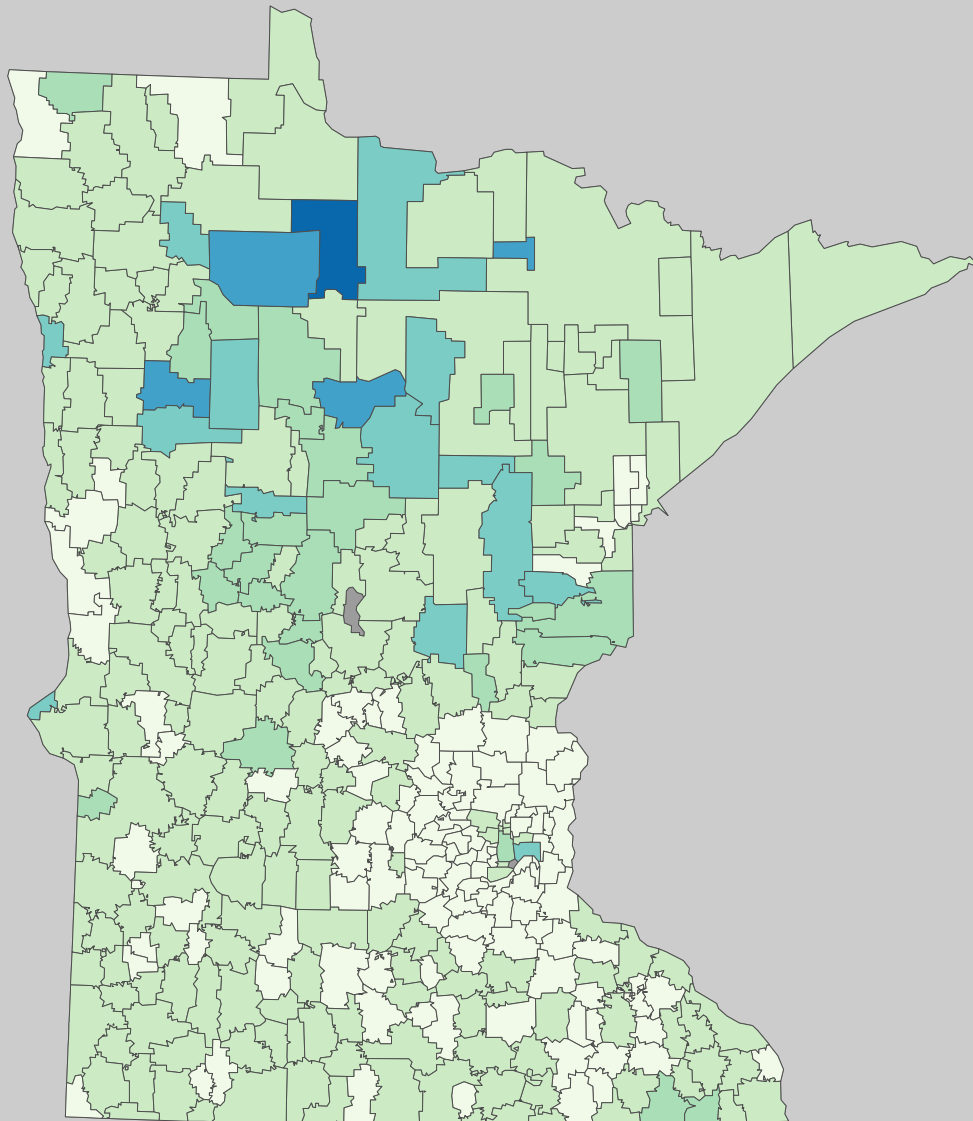

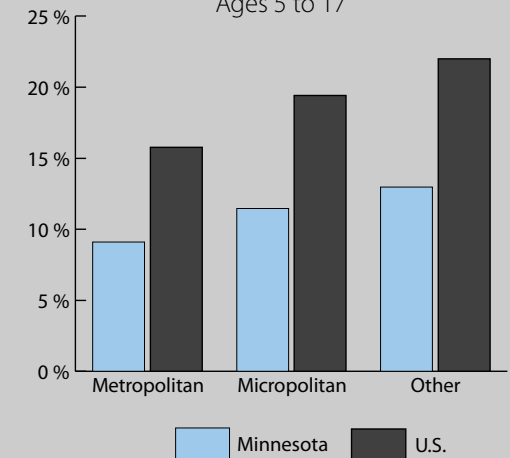

School Age Children In Poverty by School District



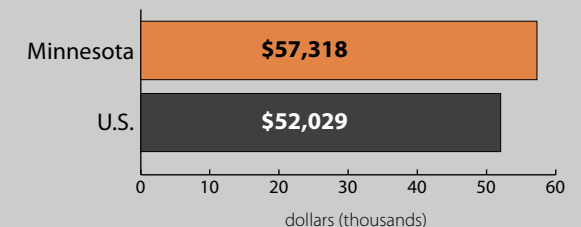
Poverty by Metropolitan Status
