

Note: The Census Bureau scored establishments based on their responses to 16 questions about their management practices on a scale from zero (least structured) to one (most structured, more explicit, formal, frequent or specific). The scores presented in the infographic are representative of its corresponding estimation domain. These statistics are estimated from a sample survey and are subject to sampling variability, as well as nonsampling error.
