

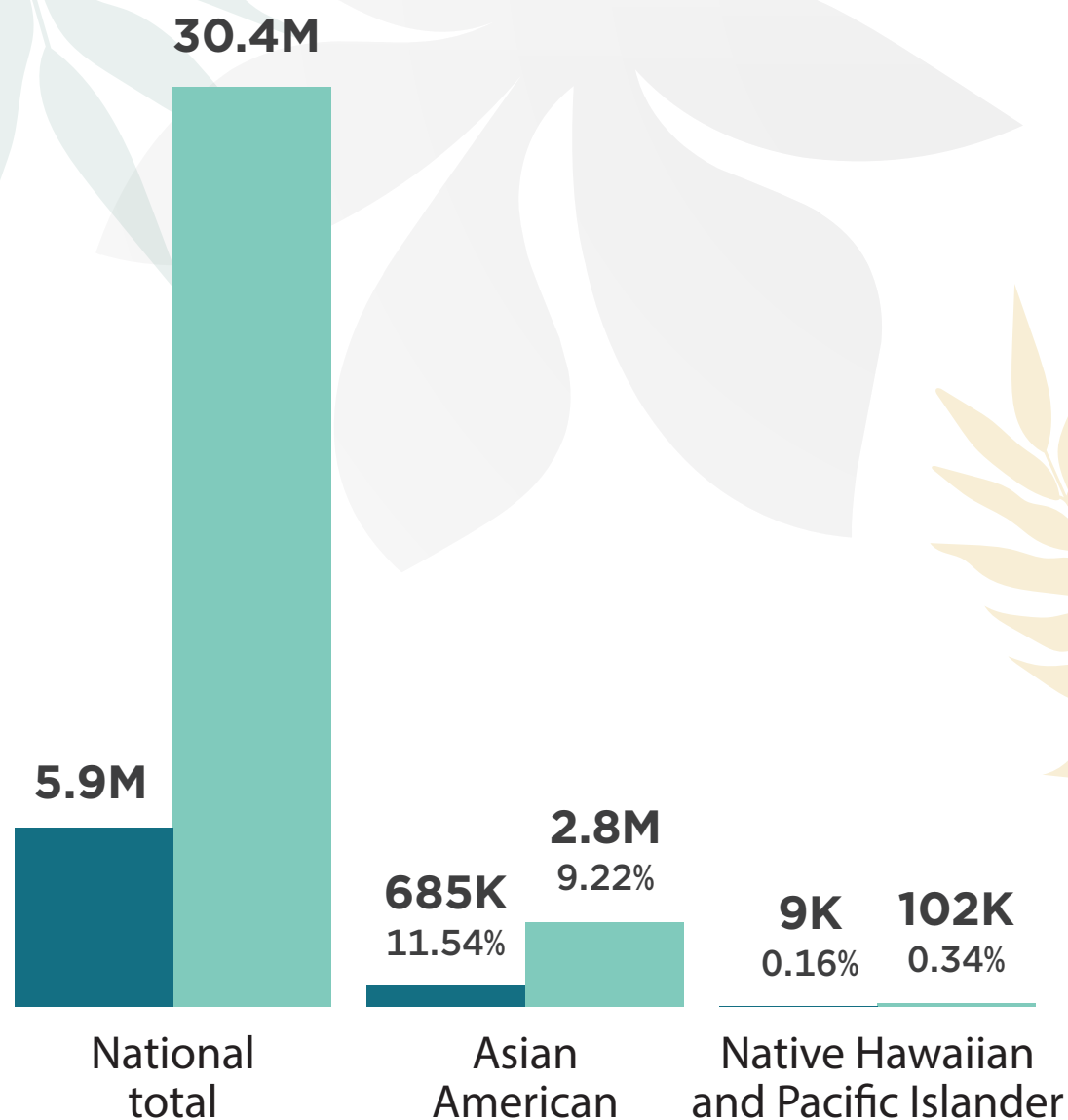

■ Employer ■ Nonemployer

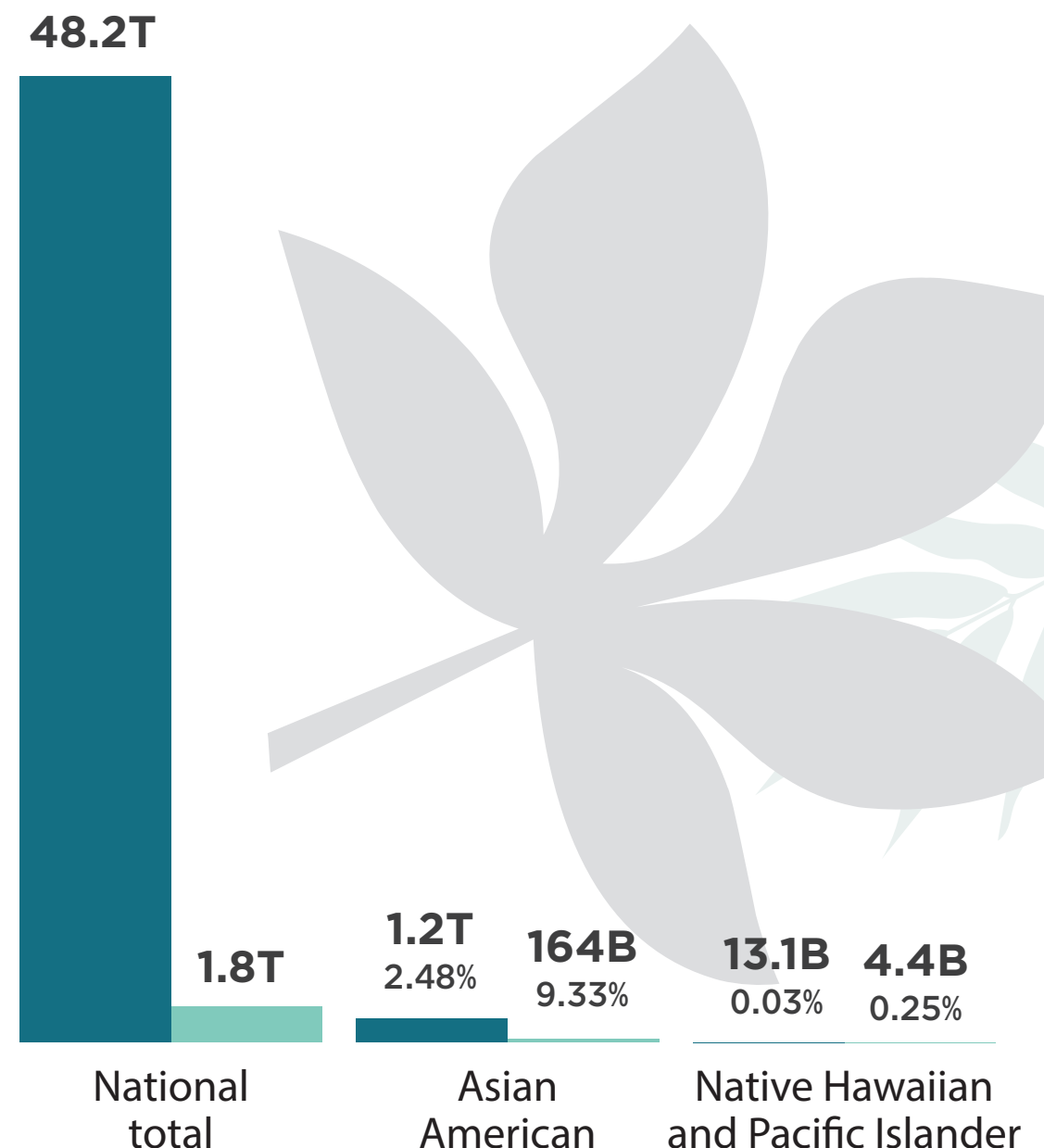
K = Thousand, M = Million, B = Billion, T = Trillion

Note: A nonemployer business is one that has no paid employees, has annual business receipts of \$1,000 or more (\$1 or more in the Construction industry), and is subject to federal income taxes. Race classification is based on business ownership. Business ownership is defined as having 51% or more of the stock or equity in the business. Receipts (net of taxes collected from customers or clients) are defined as operating revenue for goods produced or distributed, or for services provided. Receipts exclude local, state, and federal sales and other taxes collected from customers or clients and paid directly to a tax agency.
