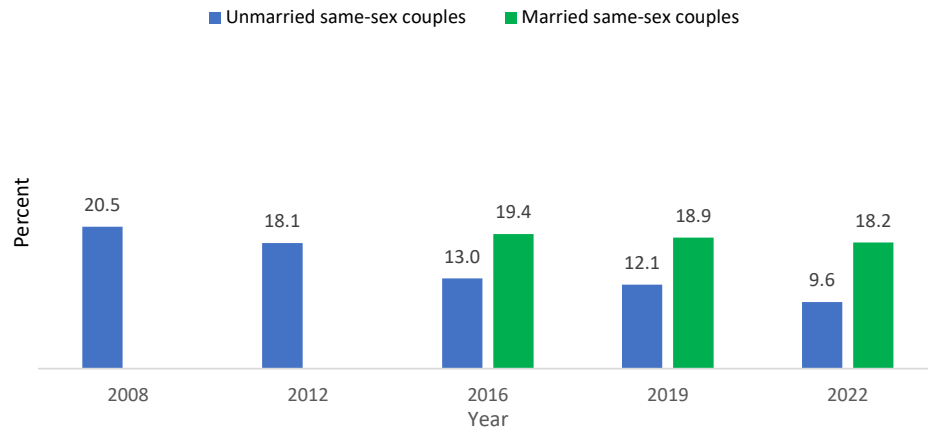


Figure 1a. Percent of Same-Sex Households with Children Under 18 for Selected Years

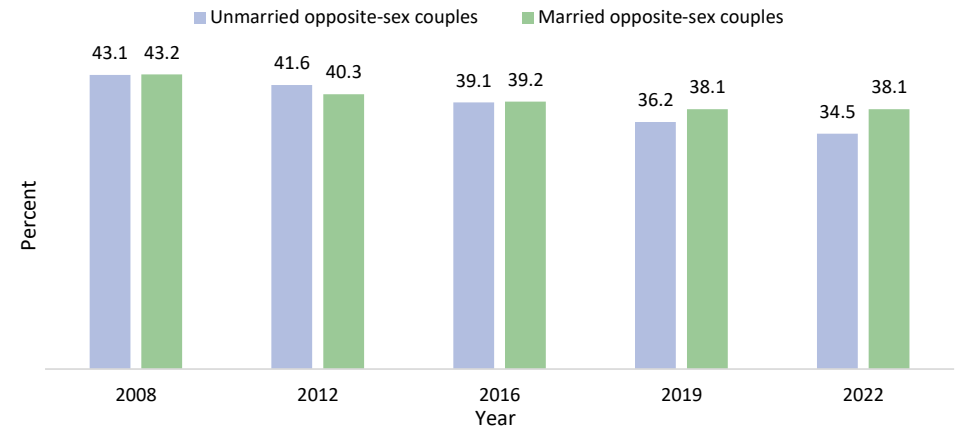
