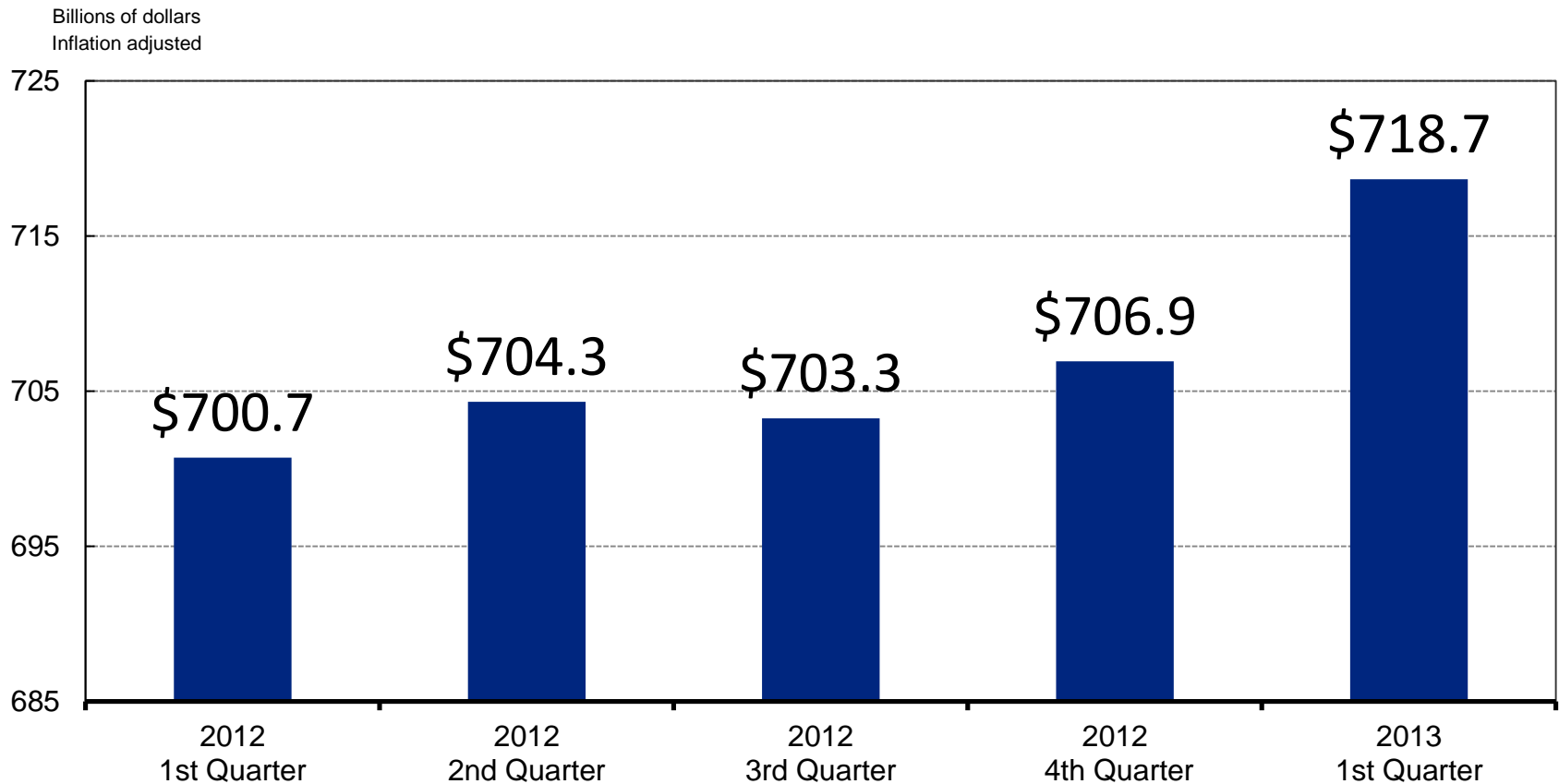


# Vacation time and work trips: What's spent on travel and tourism?

- Travel and tourism spending (adjusted for inflation) rose in the first quarter of 2013
  - Travel and tourism grew 6.8% in the first quarter, from 2.1% in the fourth.
  - The U.S. economy grew 1.8% in the first quarter, from 0.4% in the fourth.

# How much is spent on travel and tourism?



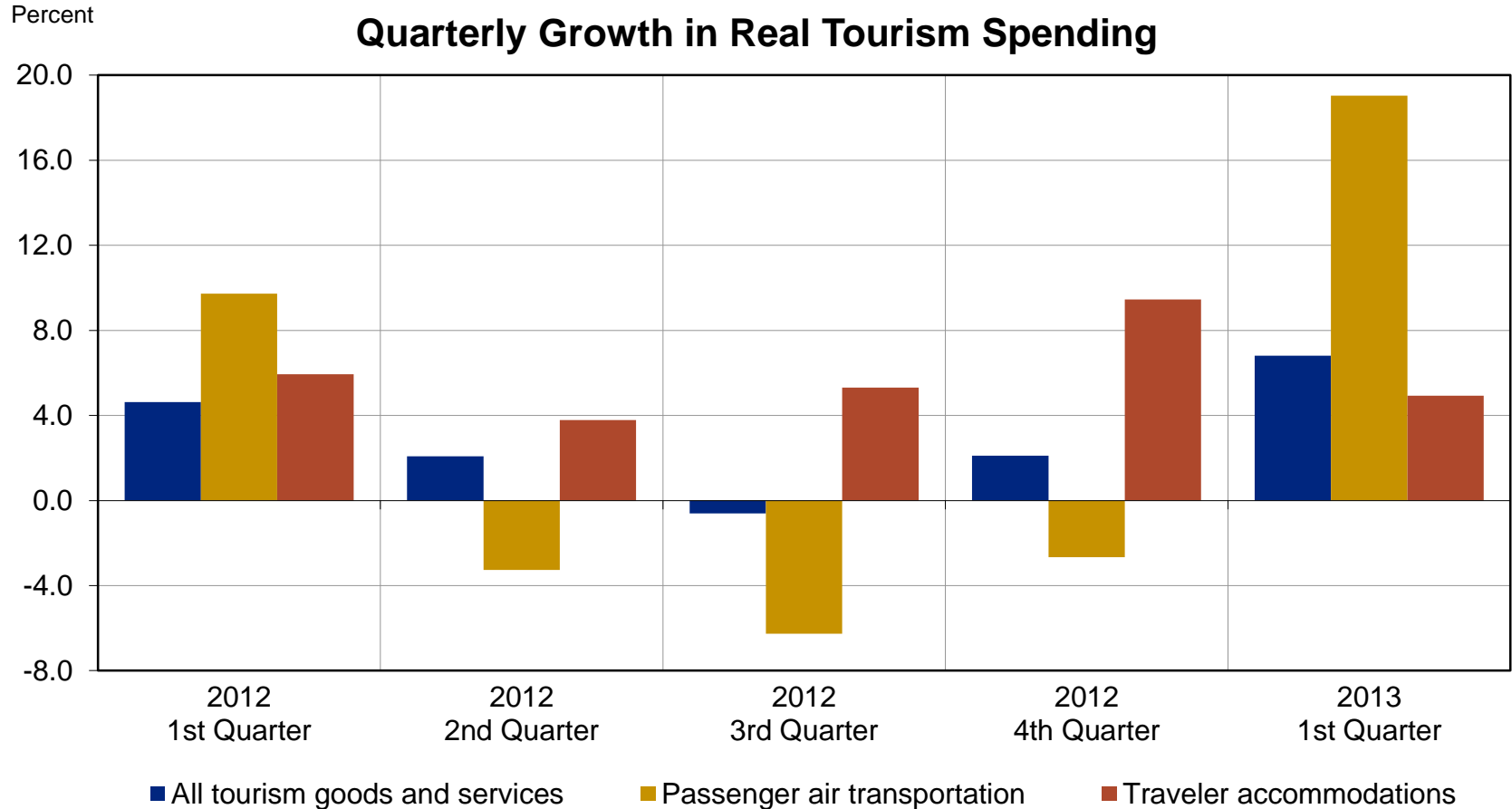

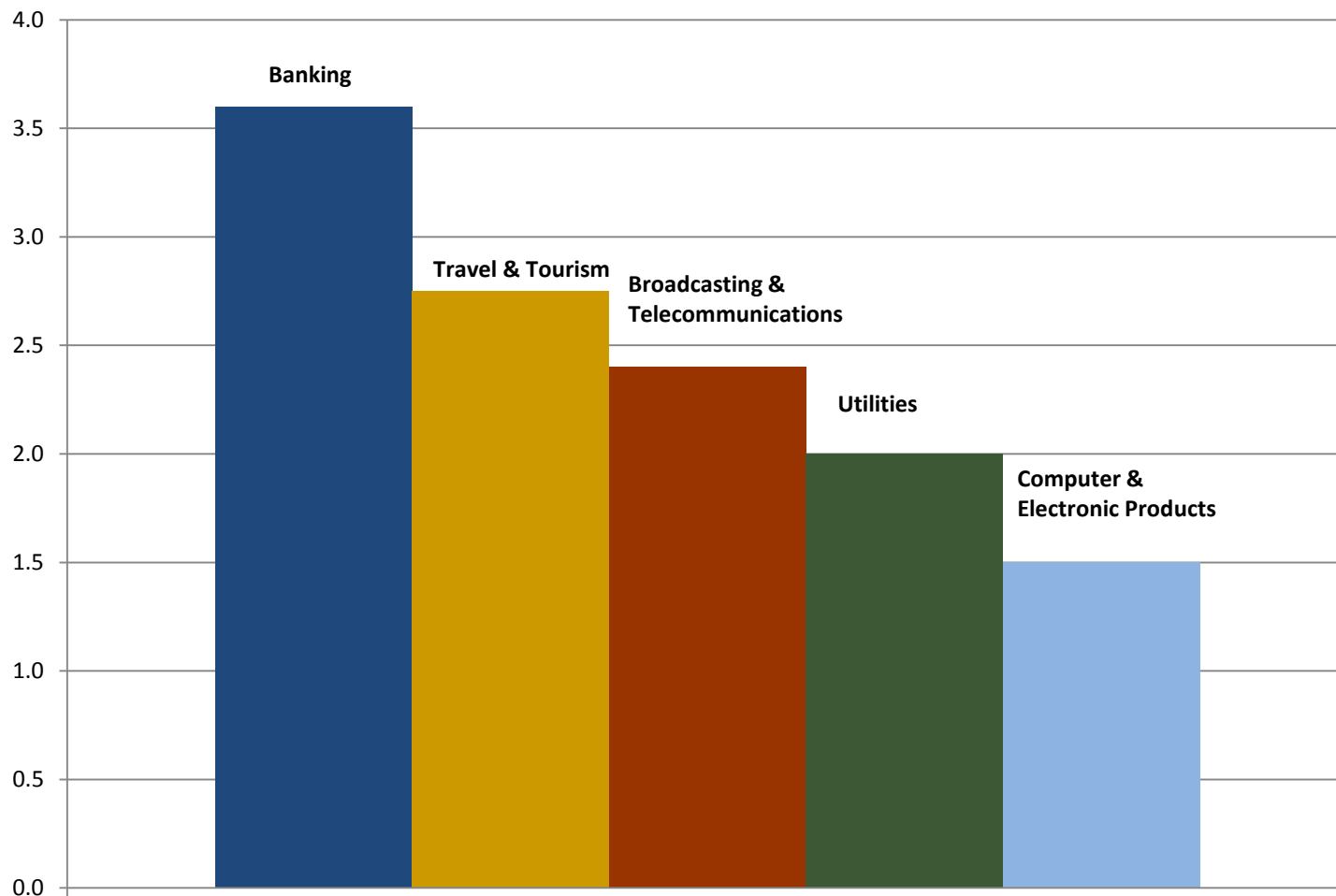
# Which part of travel and tourism grew recently?

# How does travel and tourism compare to other industries?

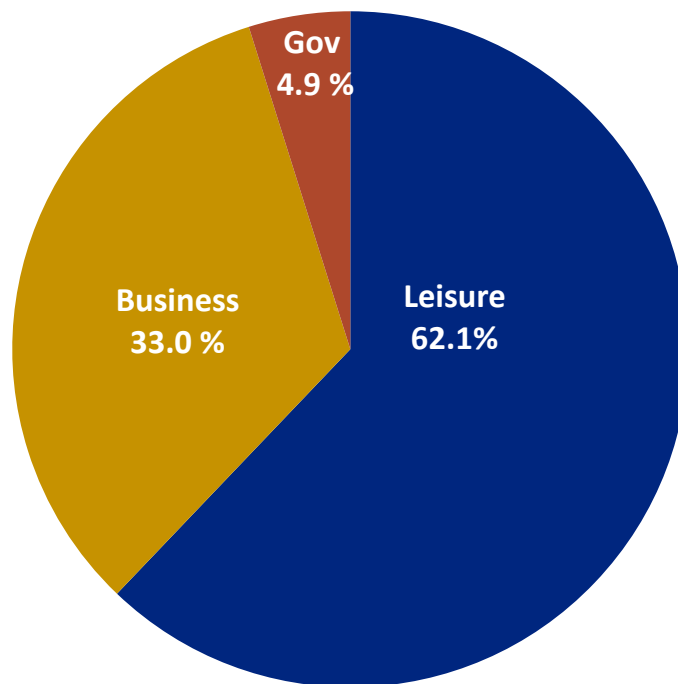
**Travel and tourism as a percent of GDP**

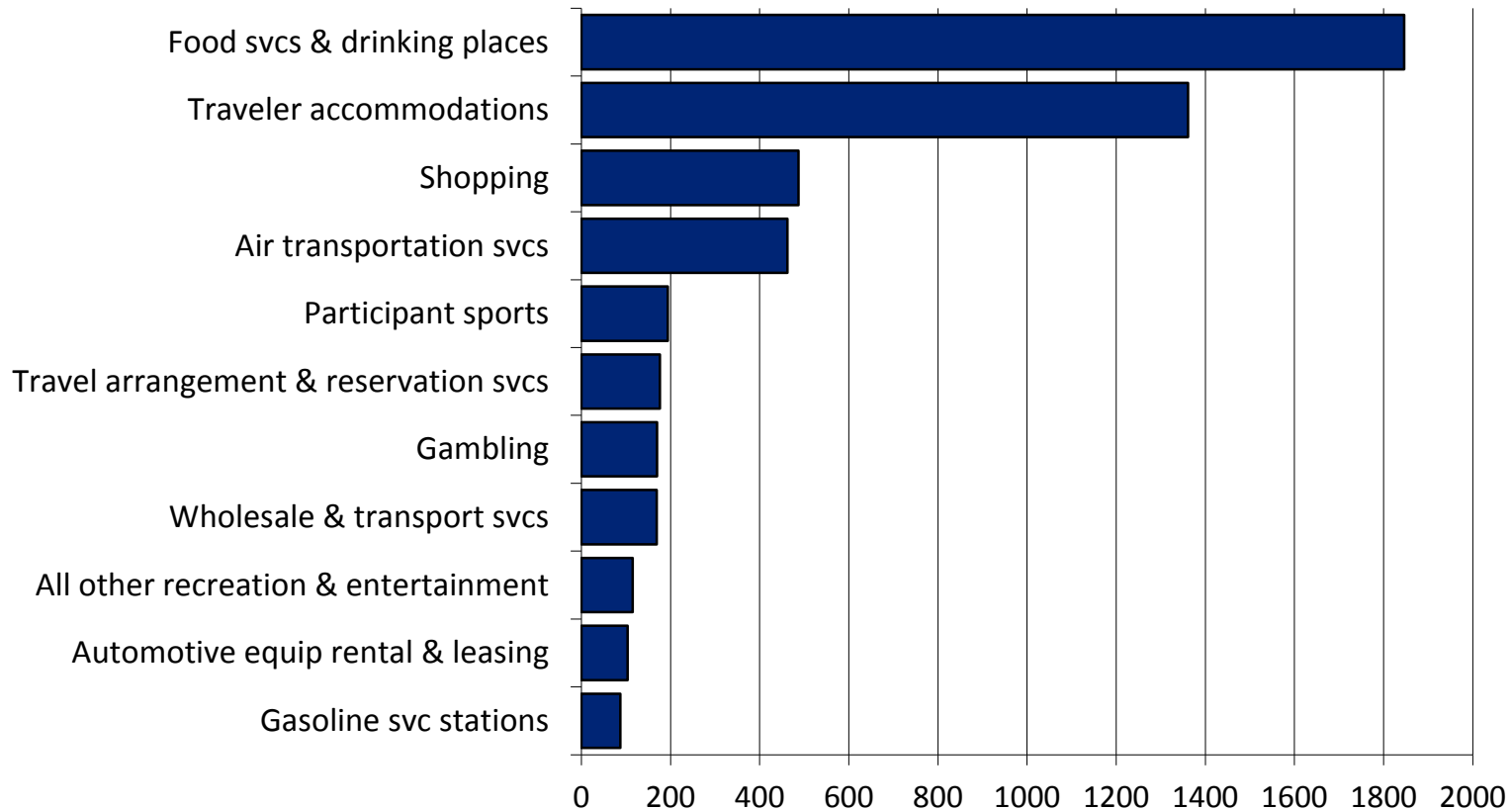
# Are Americans traveling more for business or for leisure?

# Where are international visitors to the U.S coming from?

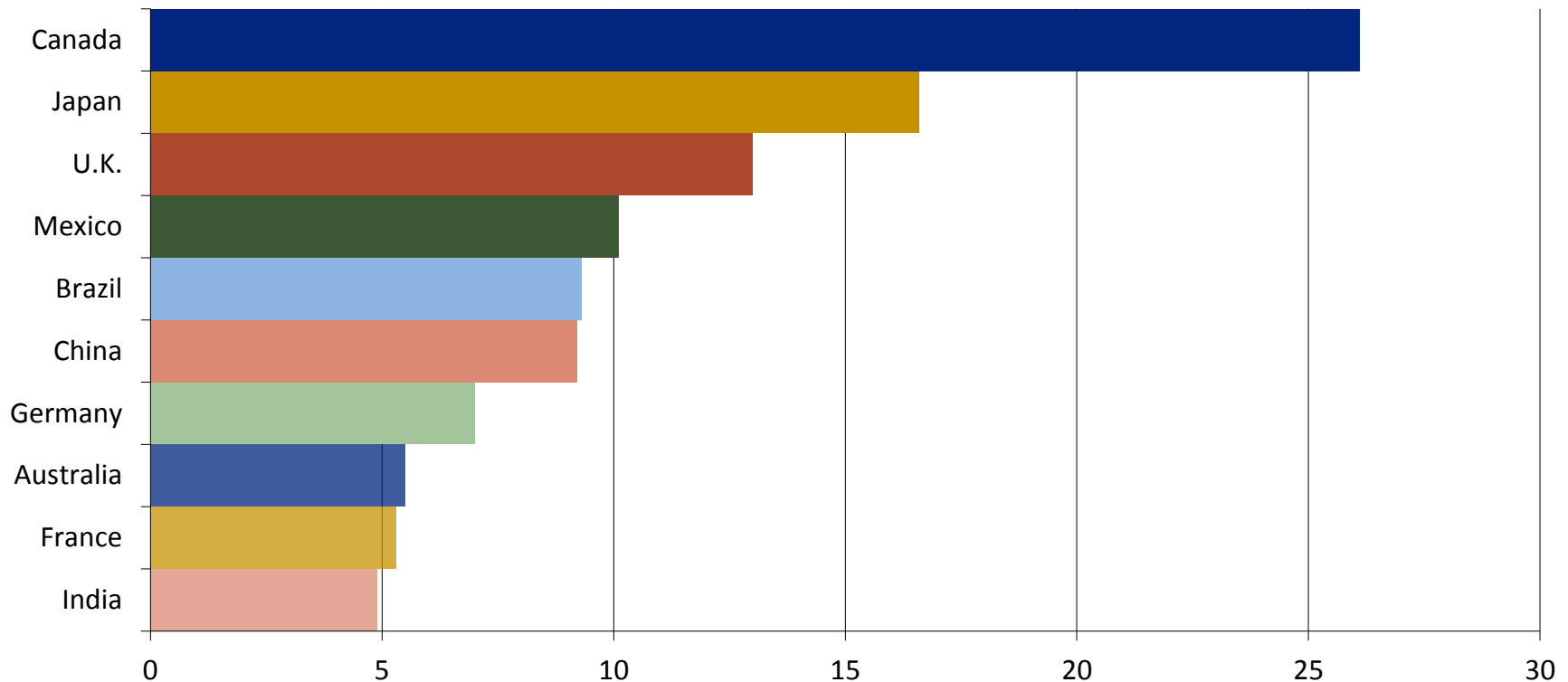
