




Rate of Driving Alone to Work for Selected Geographies:

Commute Mode Share in Atlanta: 1990 to 2014






Commuting across counties in the Atlanta Area


Crossing County Lines for Work: 2014

■ Worked in county of residence ■ Worked outside county of residence






Commuters into Fulton County on a Typical Workday from...







Large County-to-County Commuting Flows Within the Atlanta Area








Travel Time to Work






Average Travel Time by Mode of Transporation
