

Annual economic surveys cover selected sectors of the U.S. economy and feature industry and geographic statistics that supplement those published in the economic census. Data are available at the national level, and in some cases, for states, metro areas and counties. These surveys provide interim information that is critical for understanding changes in the nation's economic structure and performance.

What is the Economic Census?

- Cornerstone of the United States' system of economic statistics.
- Essential to understanding the American economy.
- Foundation for other key measures of economic performance.
- Only source to provide revenue data across industries and geographic areas that are consistent, comparable, and comprehensive .
- Every 5 years—in years ending in “2” and “7”.

What does the Economic Census Cover?

- All domestic non-farm businesses, other than those operated by governments.
- Mostly businesses with paid employees.
- Establishments based
- Based on the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS)






Employer establishments in Maryland: 2008-2013

County Business Patterns (CBP) is an annual series that provides subnational economic data by industry. This series includes the number of establishments, employment during the week of March 12, first quarter payroll, and annual payroll. This data is useful for studying the economic activity of small areas; analyzing economic changes over time; and as a benchmark for other statistical series, surveys, and databases between economic censuses. Businesses use the data for analyzing market potential, measuring the effectiveness of sales and advertising programs, setting sales quotas, and developing budgets. Government agencies use the data for administration and planning.

ZIP Code Business Patterns (ZBP) data is available shortly after the release of County Business Patterns. It provides the number of establishments by employment-size classes by detailed industry in the U.S.

These two programs cover most of the country's economic activity based on establishments, with a few noted exclusions. For more information on the coverage and methodology of CBP, see [How the Data are Collected](#). For information on businesses without paid employees, see [Nonemployer Statistics](#).  - Demographics (gender, ethnicity, race, and veteran status)
 - Business characteristics (e.g., source and amount of start-up capital)
 - Owner characteristics (e.g., age and education)
- New Annual Survey of Entrepreneurs (ASE)
 - Supplement to the Survey of Business Owners







SBO Data Collection

- Combines data from several sources
 - Online reporting and mailout/mailback survey
 - IRS business tax returns
 - Other Economic Census reports
- Conducted on a company or firm basis
- NAICS coverage similar to the Economic Census
- Tabulations at the national, state and substate regional geographic levels

Approximately 1.75 million businesses were selected for the 2012 SBO asking for information about characteristics of the businesses and their owners.

These data supercede the preliminary estimates that were published in August 2015.

SBO data are presented by:

- Gender, ethnicity, race, and veteran status
- Geography (U.S., states, metropolitan areas, counties, and places)
- Industry (2- through 6-digit NAICS for selected geographies)
- Firm receipts size
- Firm employment size

The Characteristics of Businesses and the Characteristics of Business Owners data will be released in March 2016 and will include estimates at the U.S. geography level and 2-digit NAICS industry detail.



Annual Survey of Manufacturers

- Manufacturing establishments with one or more paid employees or nonemployers that use leased employees for manufacturing and are classified in NAICS sector 31-33.
- Employment, payroll, worker hours, payroll supplements, cost of materials, selected operating expenses, value added by manufacturing, capital expenditures, inventories, and energy consumption.
- Annually, except for years ending in 2 and 7, at which time ASM data are included in the manufacturing sector of the Economic Census.
- Produces several reports including Statistics for Industry Groups and Industries, Value of Products Shipments, Geographic Area Statistics: Statistics for All Manufacturing by State, and Geographic Area Statistics: Supplemental Statistics for the United States and States.



Components of Gross Domestic Product











State & Local Public Employment: A Comparison









2013 State Government Totals for Revenue & Expenditure




Contrast Revenue Components from 2012 to 2013




