## Population growth

US Population: Projections 2020-2060
» Projected growth of
(in millions)

78 million people
between 2017 and 2060
" 25\% growth rate

## Population growth

Percentage growth in the US population
(percent increase compared to the prior decade)
» Despite continued population growth, the growth rate is projected to slow

# Population aging 

By 2035, we project that older adults
will outnumber children for the first time in US history

## Population aging

»By 2030, every baby
boomer will be over 65

## Consequences of population aging

## More older adults than kids

» Older adults are projected to outnumber kids beginning in 2035
» Between today and 2060:
<18 population grow by 8\%
$65+$ population grow by $92 \%$

More retirees than workers
» Old age dependency ratios projected to double by 2060

$$
21 \text { in } 2010 \longrightarrow 41 \text { in } 2060
$$

» Working age population will remain relatively constant while the old age population grows

## Projecting race and ethnicity

## Change

» Self-identification
and self-reporting of
race change over time

## Measurement

» People who select one and only race ("race alone")
» People who select one race or others ("race alone or in combination with others")

## Need

» Why project race at all?
» Demographic experiences
like fertility and mortality
differ across groups

## Projected births and deaths

The cause?
» Largely driven by a rising number of deaths to an aging white population
(White population)

## Demographic turning points

## Aging

» More older adults than kids by 2035
» More young children than elderly by 2060

## Immigration

» Immigration projected to become the primary driver of population growth starting in 2030
» Due to population aging and a rising number of deaths

## Diversity

» White population projected to shrink
» Due to demographic momentum of younger, more racially diverse cohorts
