










### Change in Median Household Income 2007 to 2012




Note: A statistically significant increase and decrease indicates that the 2012 median household income was statistically different at the 90% confidence level from what it was in 2007.

# Poverty Rates by County: 2012








# Percentage of School-Age Children in Families of Poverty: 2012


