

Getting Started With American FactFinder

1) Go to **factfinder.census.gov** and select the "Advanced Search" tab.




- 2) Click on the "Geographies" box on the left to choose from over 425,000 geographic areas. (Note: Click on the "all geographic types" radio button to see more geographies.)
 - Complete required fields using the drop-down options.
 - Add the desired geography to your selections and close the overlay.




3) Click on the "Topics" box to narrow the number of tables. Example selections are included below.




- ➤ Select Program→American Community Survey.
- Close the topics overlay.
- ➤ Select topic of interest, such as People → Income & Earnings → Income/Earnings (Households).
- Close the topics overlay.








4) Review your selections. Browse the list of results and click on a table title to view data.



- 5) View table data.
 - > Bookmark/save a link to revisit the table later or to share it with others.
 - Download the table into file formats such as CSV, Excel, or PDF.



6) Before starting new searches, clear any remaining selections that are no longer needed from the "Your Selections" box.
