5-Year Estimates

- Describe the characteristics over a specific period of time, not a single point in time
- Data are pooled across 60 months, weighted to produce estimates, and controlled for age, sex, race, and Hispanic origin
 - 5-year estimates are NOT an average of 1-year estimates
- Estimates are based on geographic boundaries as of January 1 of the last year in the 5-year period
- Dollar-value estimates are inflation adjusted to the most recent year for the period

When to Use 5-Year Estimates?

- No 1-year estimate is available
- Margins of error for 1-year estimates are larger than desired
- Analyzing data for small population groups
- Comparing various geographies when one or more of them do not receive 1-year estimates


5-Year Comparisons

- Only compare non-overlapping time periods (e.g., 2013-2017 and 2008-2012)
- Only compare 1-yr estimates to 1-yr and 5-yr estimates to 5-yr
- Compare across geographies and subpopulations
- Compare percentages, means, medians and rates whenever possible

5-Year Geography and Products



Language

Among people at least five years old living in Prince George's County, Maryland in 2012-2016, 23 percent spoke a language other than English at home. 


▶ Language

Among people at least five years old living in Maryland in 2012-2016, 18 percent spoke a language other than English at home. Of those speaking a language other than English at home, 42 percent spoke Spanish and 58 percent spoke some other language; 37 percent reported that they did not speak English "very well."



▶ Housing Costs

The median monthly housing costs for mortgaged owners was \$1,938, nonmortgaged owners \$586, and renters \$1,264. An estimated 31 percent of owners with mortgages, 14 percent of owners without mortgages, and 51 percent of renters in Maryland spent 30 percent or more of household income on housing.





▶ Employment Status and Type of Employer

In Maryland, 63 percent of the population 16 and over were employed; 32 percent were not currently in the labor force.

An estimated 73 percent of the people employed were private wage and salary workers; 22 percent were federal, state, or local government workers; and 5 percent were self-employed in their own (not incorporated) business.



Statistical Testing Tool

Comparing American Community Survey (ACS) estimates involves more than determining which statistic is higher or lower. Users should also conduct statistical testing to make sure differences are statistically significant and are unlikely to have occurred by chance. This testing takes into account the margin of error (MOE) associated with survey estimates, which are based on responses from only a sample of the full population.
