

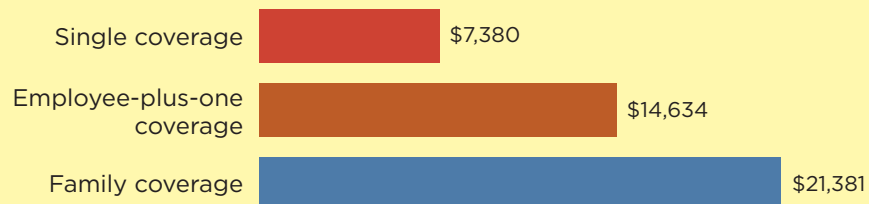
Health Insurance Cost Study
