


Evaluating the Impacts of Health Care Changes in Your State and County?


Find Out Using the Small Area Health Insurance Estimates (SAHIE) Interactive Data and Mapping Tool

Federal health care laws may allow uninsured populations living at or below 400 percent of the poverty line to participate in Health Insurance Exchanges or receive Medicaid subsidies.


Using the SAHIE Interactive Data and Mapping Tool, let's see how health care reform may impact Colorado, for example:



In 2010, SAHIE estimated that 25.6% of Colorado's population under age 65, living at or below 400% of the poverty line, were uninsured.



If we zoom in and look at the county level, we see that uninsured rates varied across Colorado's counties.



If we zoom in more, we can see that Denver County's uninsured rate was 27.4%.
