

 - Concurrence and/or sequence
 - Number of contacts and timing
 - Incentive structures and delivery
 - Cross-sectional or longitudinal
 - Adaptive and responsive designs



The Multimode Era (Continued)

- > Potential benefits (AAPOR, 2019)
 - Improve coverage
 - Increase response rates
 - Decrease nonresponse error
 - Decrease cost
 - Improve measurement


