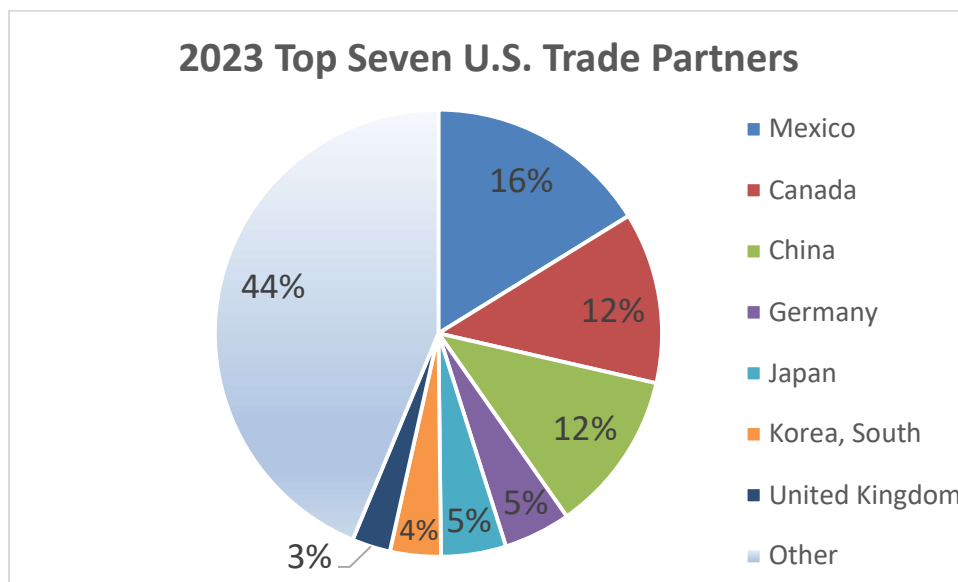
PROFILE OF U.S. IMPORTING AND EXPORTING COMPANIES BY COUNTRY, 2009-2023

Release Number: CB26-94

May 29, 2026 —The U.S. Census Bureau, Department of Commerce, releases a new series of country profiles covering data years 2009 through 2023. These reports are a subset of the full report, A Profile of U.S. Importing and Exporting Companies. These new country Profiles show trade from the United States to the seven largest partner countries. An additional report is provided for U.S. – European Union trade.

Identified companies are enterprise-level companies from the Business Register to which import or export transactions records were linked. The known export or import value is the dollar value of export or import transactions linked to these identified companies. Using the information from the Census Business Register, this report details trade data by various company characteristics of U.S. importing and exporting companies. These characteristics provide insights into import and export data by North American Industry Classification System (NAICS), employee size, value by NAICS-3 company type, and trade value with company count by state and territory.

Based on the total known value (in billions), the seven largest U.S. trading partners for 2023 are:

- 1) Mexico (\$732.4)
- 2) Canada (\$560.6)
- 3) China (\$528.4)
- 4) Germany (\$219.5)
- 5) Japan (\$213.3)
- 6) South Korea (\$166.1)
- 7) United Kingdom (\$124.7)

Trade between the European Union and U.S. accounts for \$862.8 billion in value. Of the 233 trade partners in 2023, the largest seven countries constitute 56.3% of the combined trade value.

NOTE: Export data were first made available in 1987. Import data was introduced with the annual “Profile of U.S. Importing and Exporting Companies” in 2009. Throughout 2022, export data for the prior year were revised. This practice was discontinued during the 2023 production cycle. Import data are not revised. 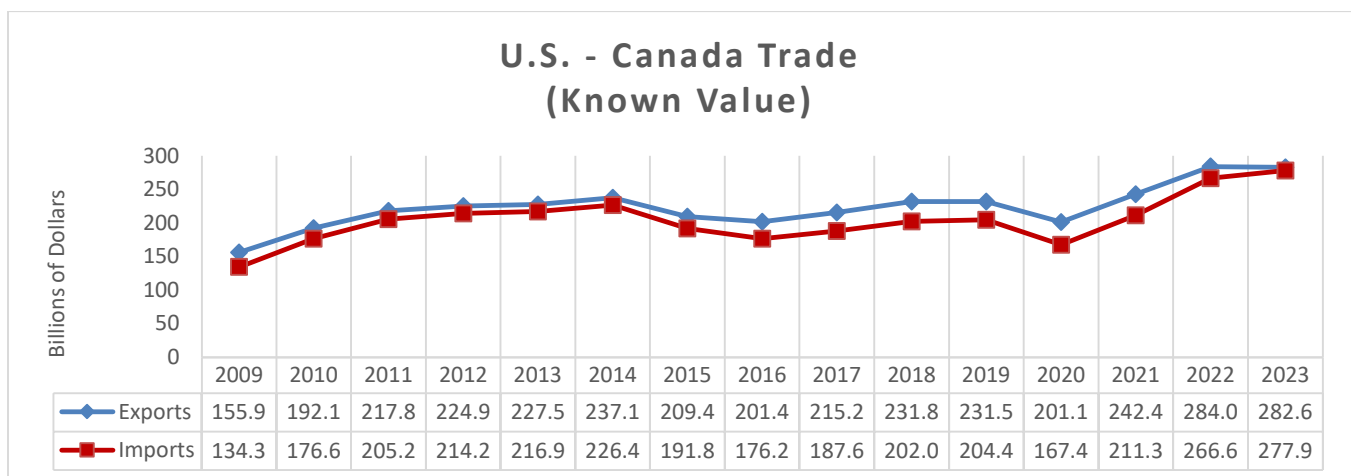

Note: Total value for Canadian imports is typically greater than exports and results from notable match rate difference.



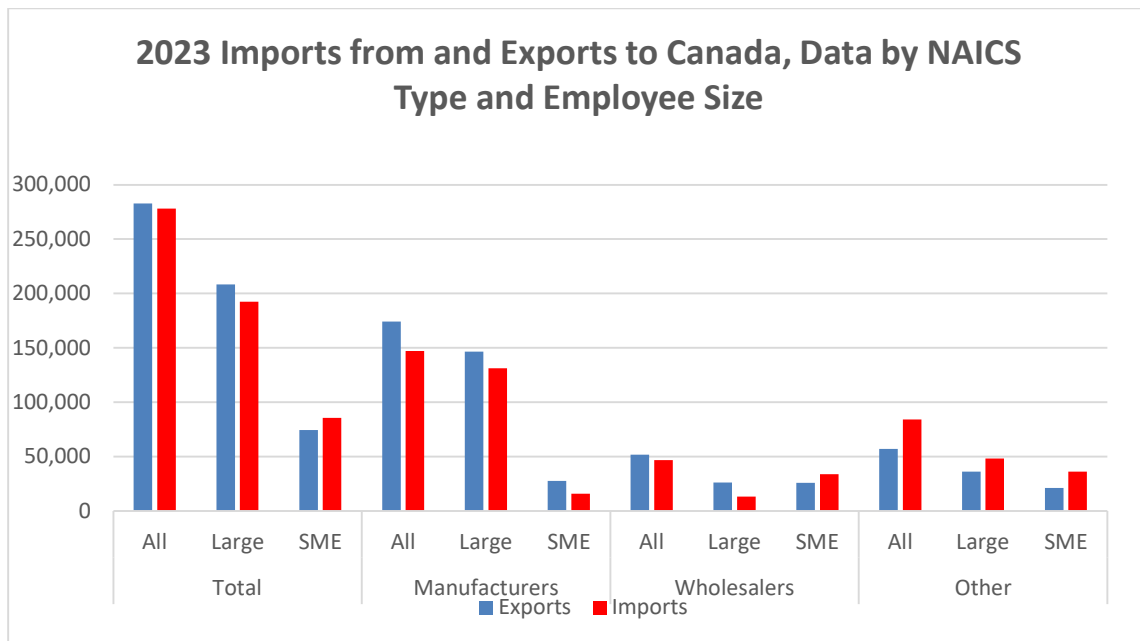

Export and Import Values by NAICS-3 Category

Known export data is displayed by the top five 3-digit company NAICS. Each company is assigned a primary NAICS code using an algorithm based on the annual payroll data for all establishments (i.e., individual locations) owned by a given company. The description associated with a specific code provides a general definition of that code. As an example, 423 (Merchant Wholesalers, Durable Goods), includes commodities with a normal life expectancy of three or more years. A general, non-exhaustive list of some goods classified within 423 includes motor vehicles and motor vehicle parts, furniture and home furnishings, lumber and other construction materials, professional and commercial equipment, photographic equipment, office equipment, computer and computer peripheral equipment, medical supplies, metal and mineral merchant wholesalers, household appliances, other electronic parts and equipment, hardware, machinery, farm and garden machinery, service establishment equipment, sporting and recreational goods, toy and hobby goods, jewelry and others. 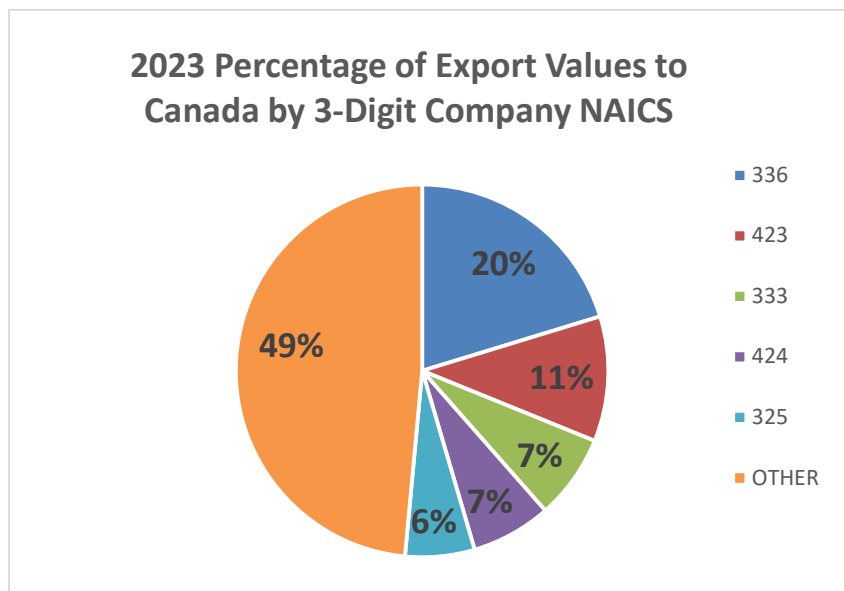

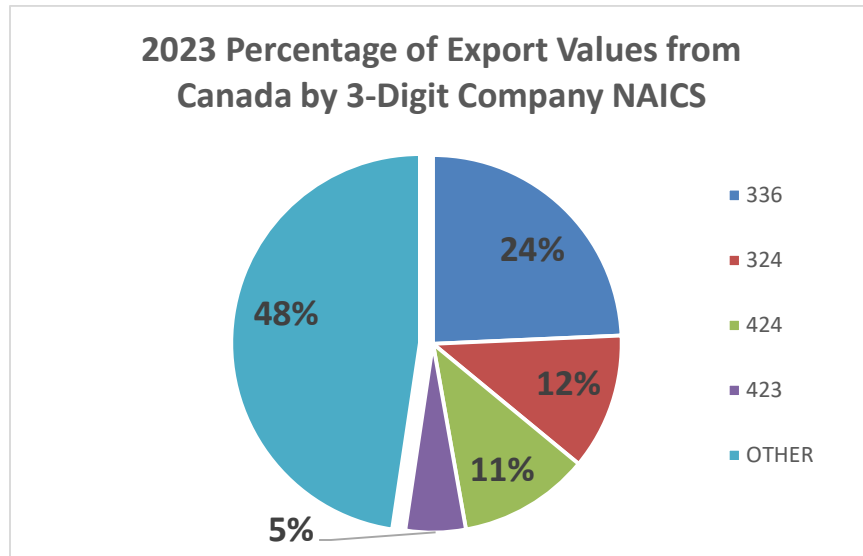

Export and Import Values by State

The number of exporters and importers for each state as well as the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands is provided with the corresponding value in the exhibit below. It is very important to make a distinction, however, in what “State” represents for exports and imports – namely the “Origin of Movement State” for exports and the “U.S. State of Destination” which is used with imports.

The “Origin of Movement State” represents the state in which a good begins its journey to the port of export intended for destinations in other countries.

“U.S. State of Destination” indicates the U.S. state, U.S. territory or U.S. possession where the merchandise is destined, as known at the time of entry summary filing. For shipments into Foreign Trade Zones, the import state represents the location of the zone.

Final Note on U.S. – Canada Trade

According to the annual "Profile of U.S. Importing and Exporting Companies, 2022 – 2023", Canada was the second largest export market and third largest import market for trade in goods with the United States based on known value. However, based on total known value (i.e. combined imports and exports) Canada ranks second in terms of trade volume with the United States.

U.S. – CHINA TRADE, 2009-2023

The U.S. Census Bureau, Department of Commerce, releases the report, *U.S. – CHINA TRADE, 2009 - 2023*. This report provides information on identified U.S. companies and their known export or import value. Identified companies are enterprise-level companies that were successfully linked from the 2009 – 2023 Census Business Registers to import or export transaction records. The known export or import value is the dollar-value of export or import transactions linked to these identified companies. Using the information from the Census Business Register, this report details U.S. and China trade by various company characteristics of U.S. exporting and importing companies.

Import Data

Data for imports entering the United States from China are comparable to export data. Both China and the United States attribute imports to the country of origin and exports to the country of final destination at the time of export. If trade occurs via Hong Kong, the destination at the time of export may appear as Hong Kong in Chinese trade statistics but it is possible that the United States will identify China as the country of origin. Due to this difference data are once again specified by China, Hong Kong, as well as the total for China and Hong Kong.

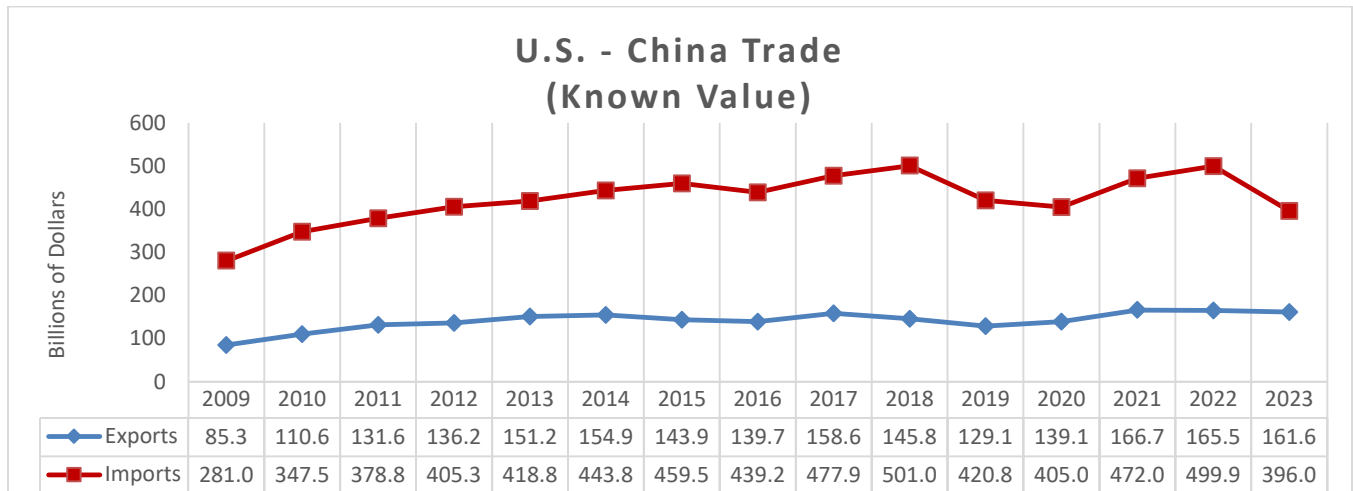

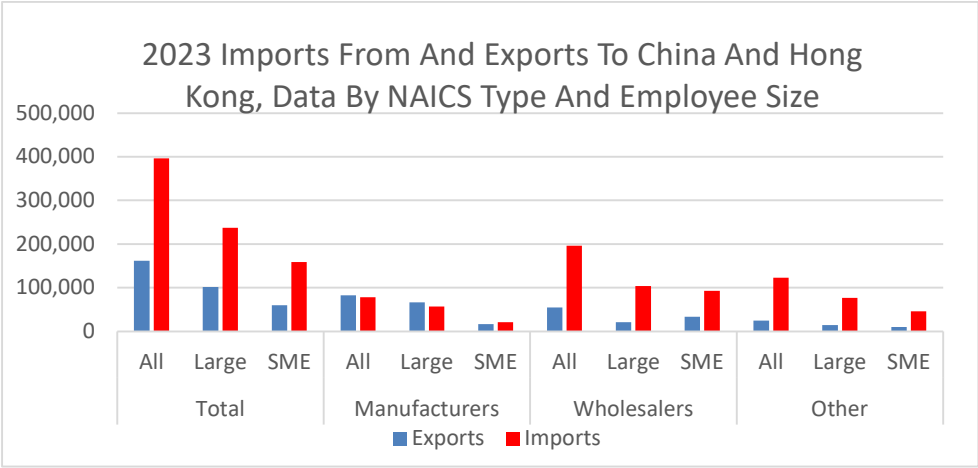

Durable goods recorded under NAICS 423 comprise the largest value in both exports and imports between the United States and China for 2023.

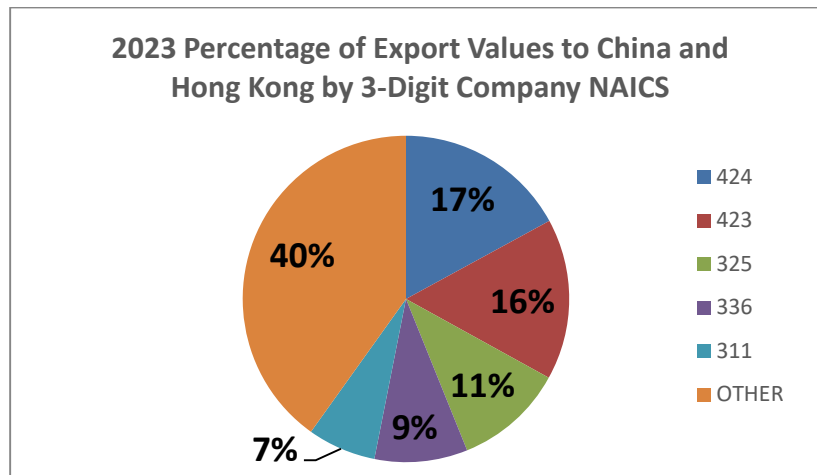

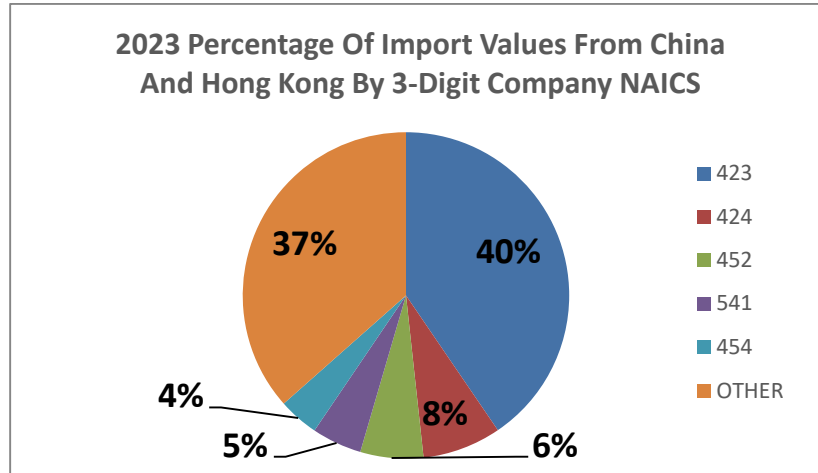

Final Note on U.S. – China Trade

According to the annual “Profile of U.S. Importing and Exporting Companies, 2022 – 2023”, China plus Hong Kong was the third largest export market and second largest import market for trade in goods with the United States based on known value. Based on total known value (i.e. combined imports and exports) China ranks third in terms of trade volume with the United States.

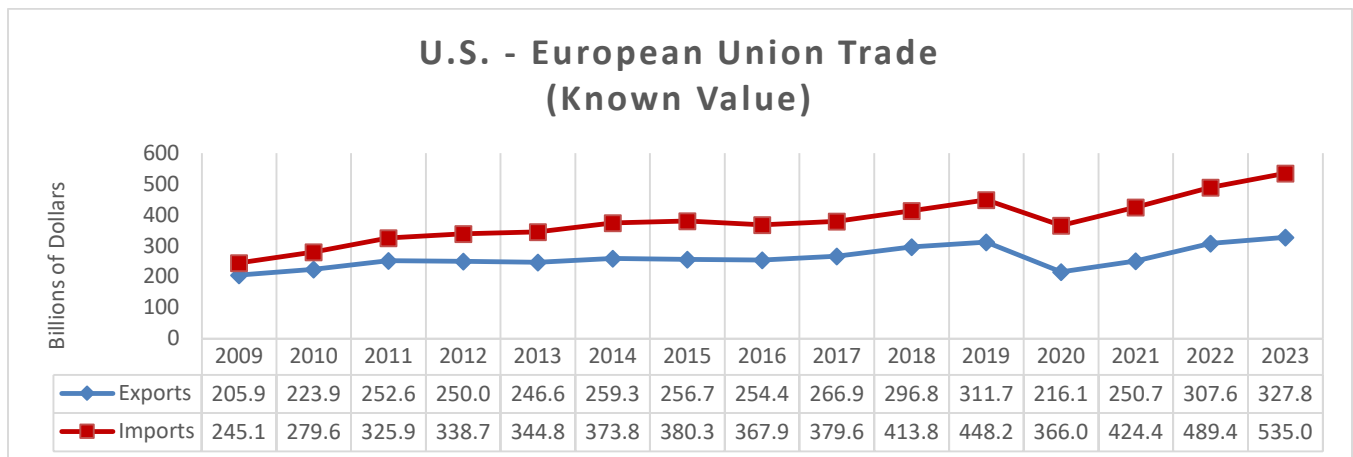

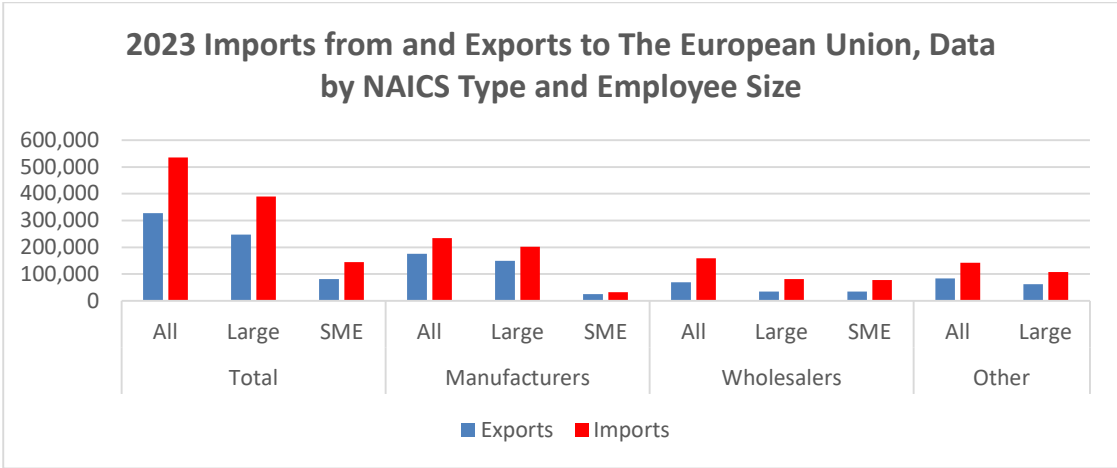

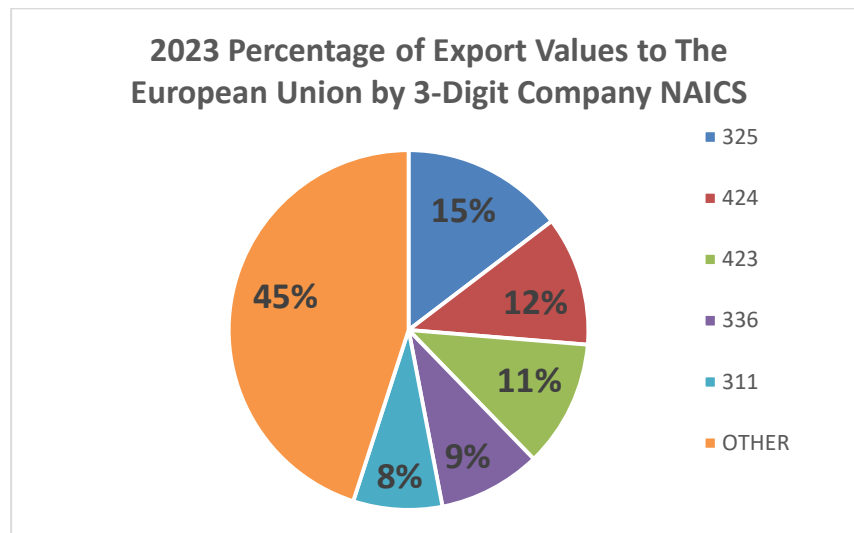

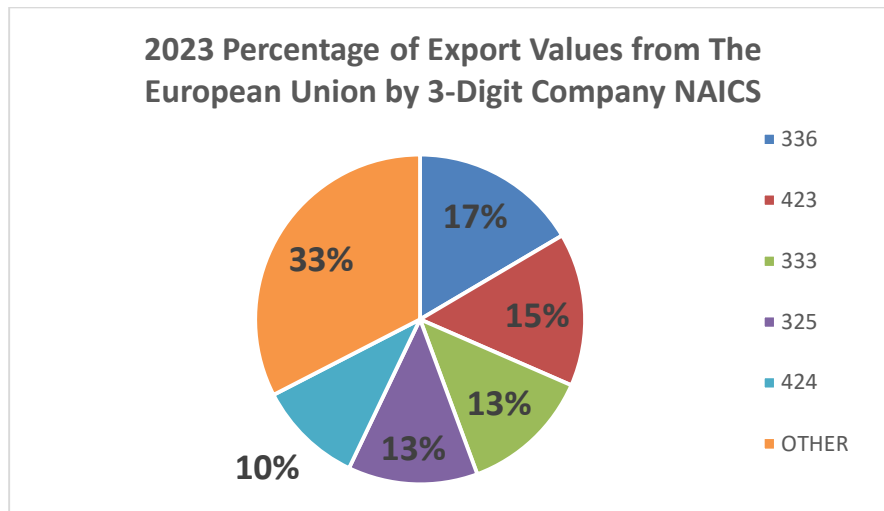

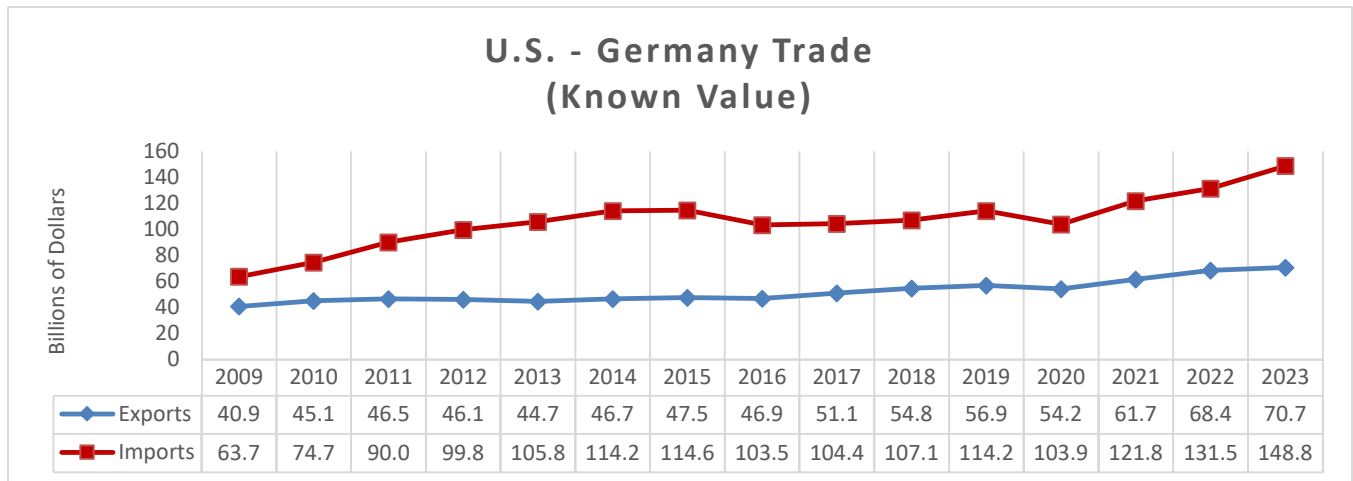

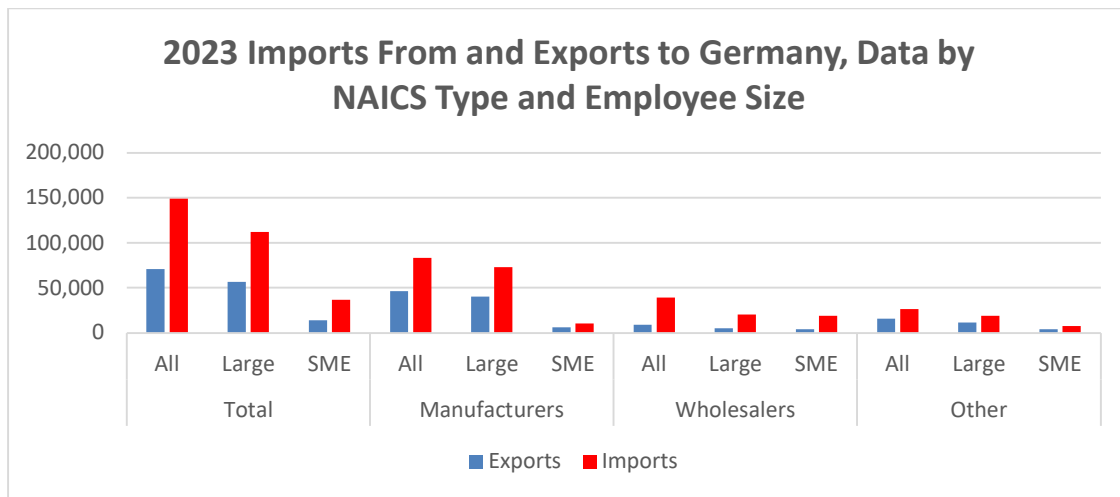

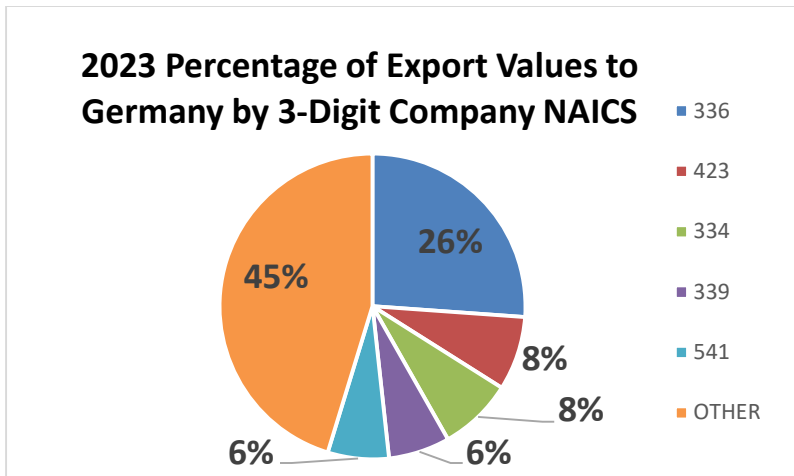

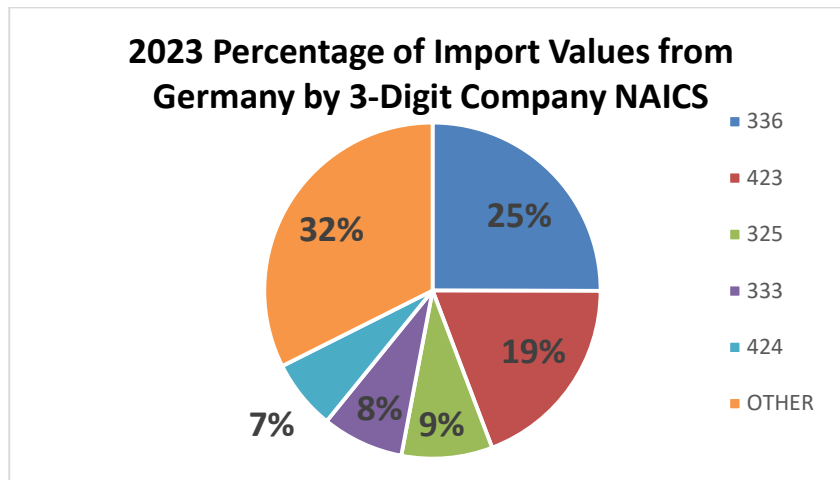

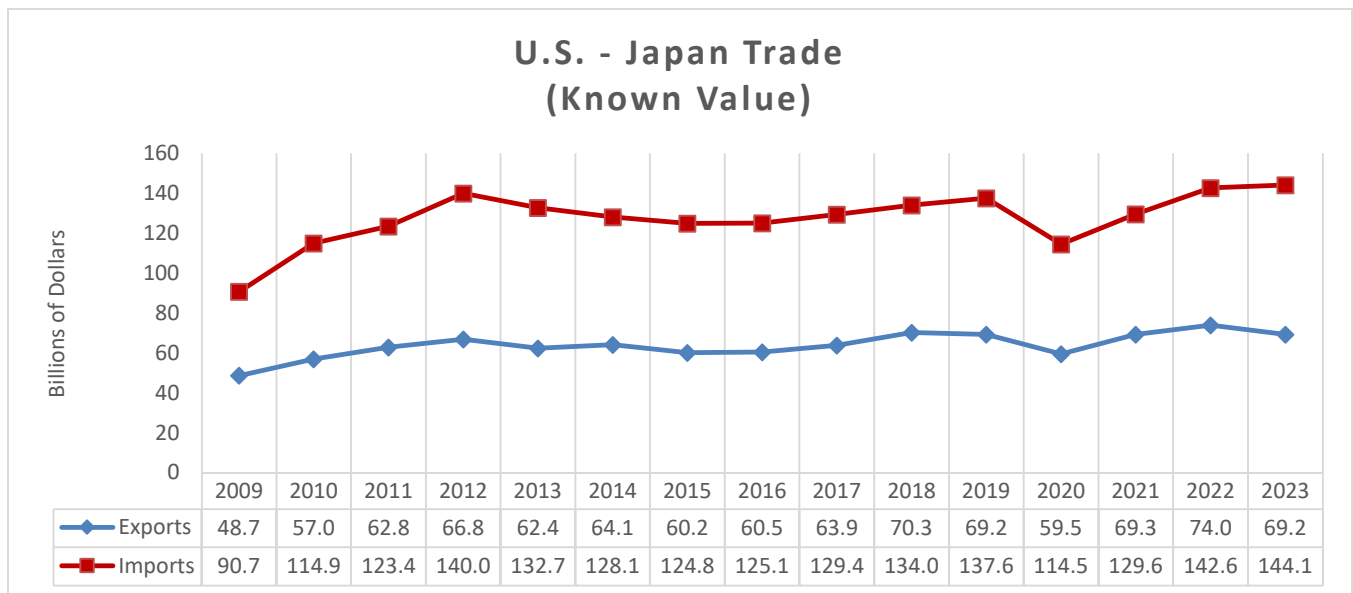

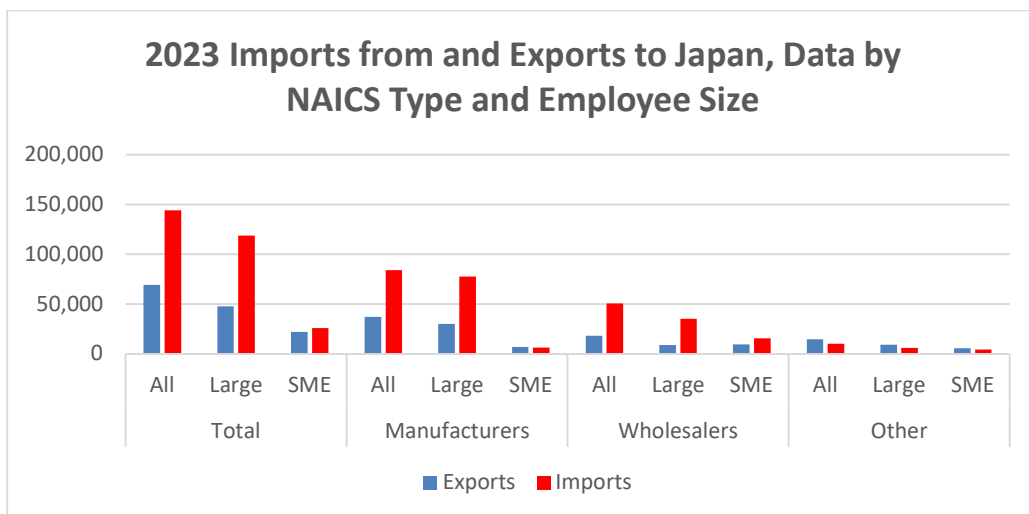

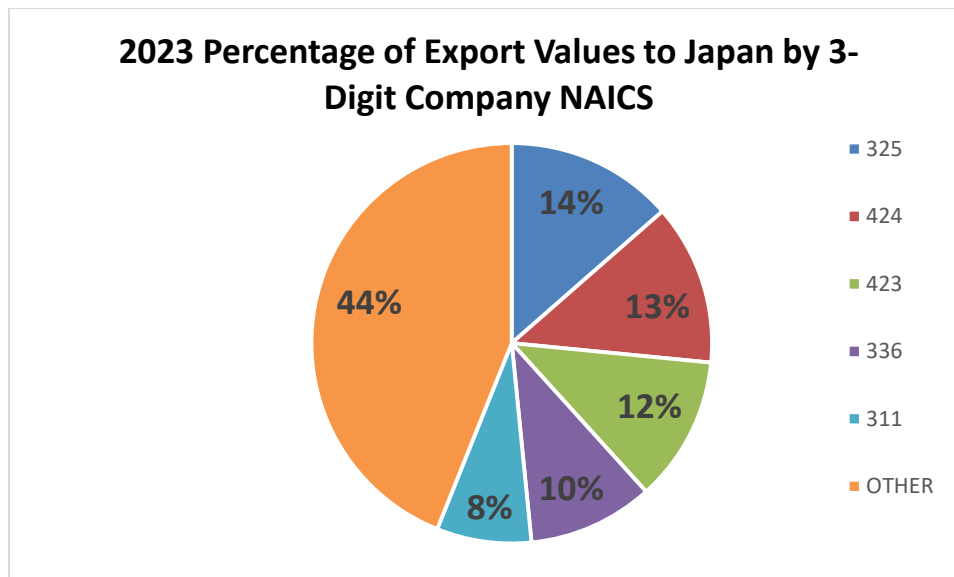

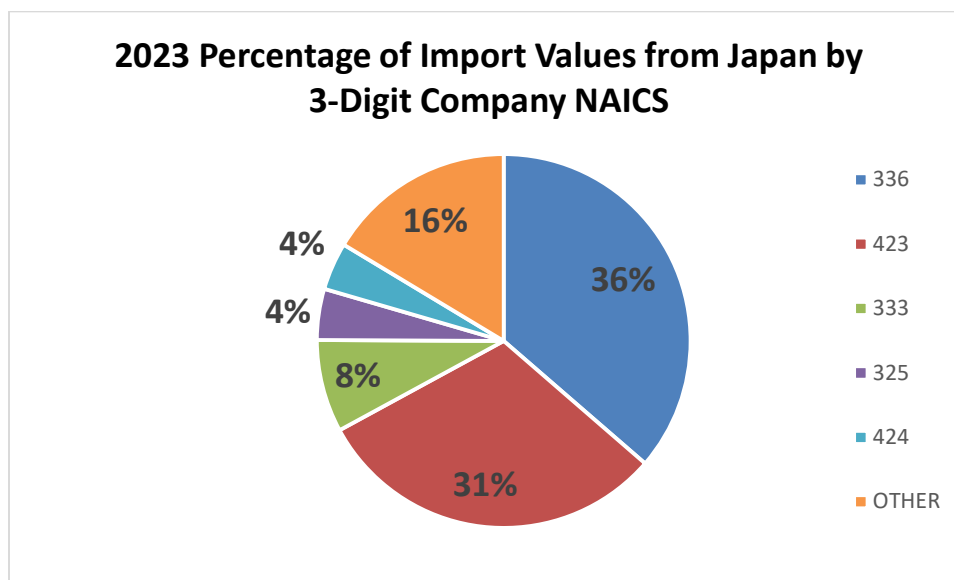

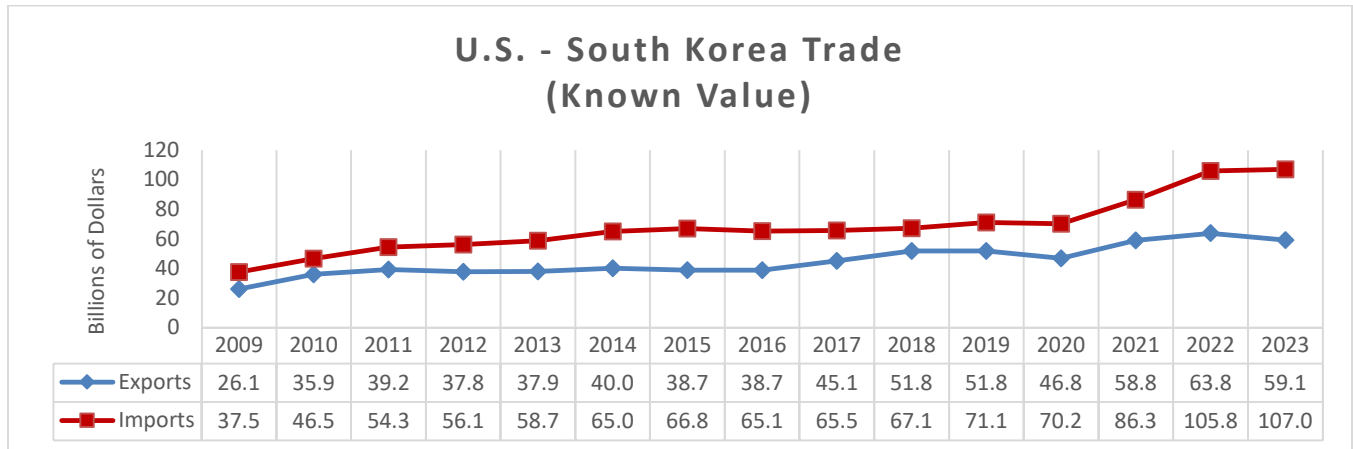

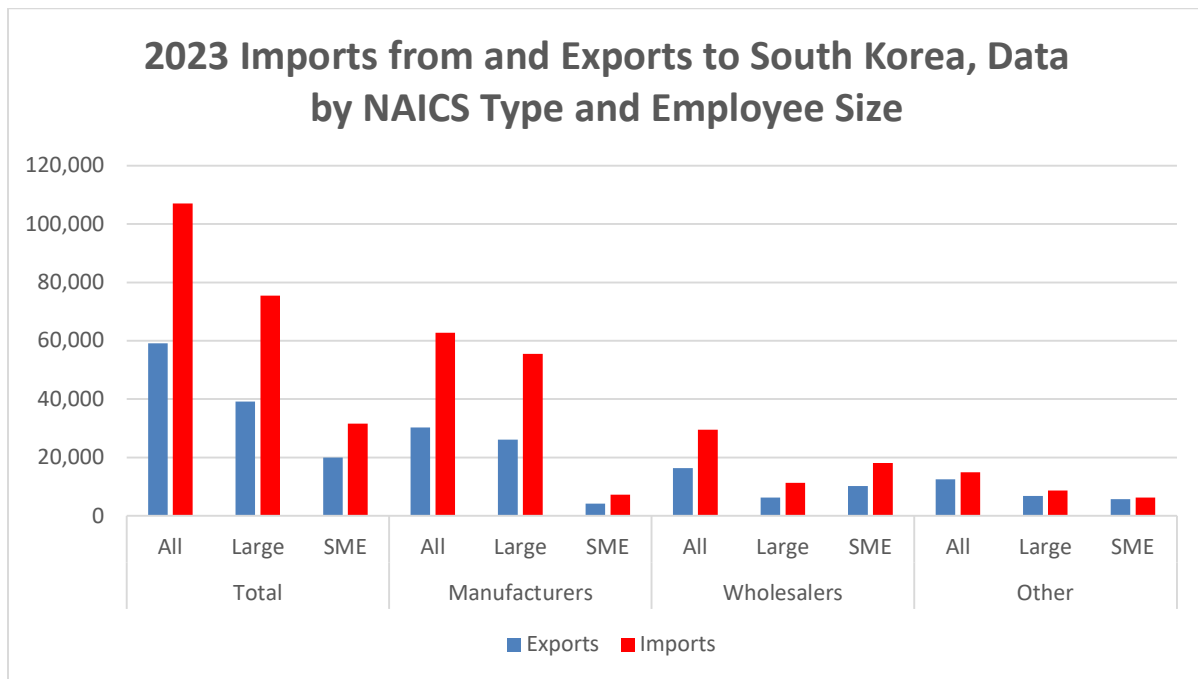

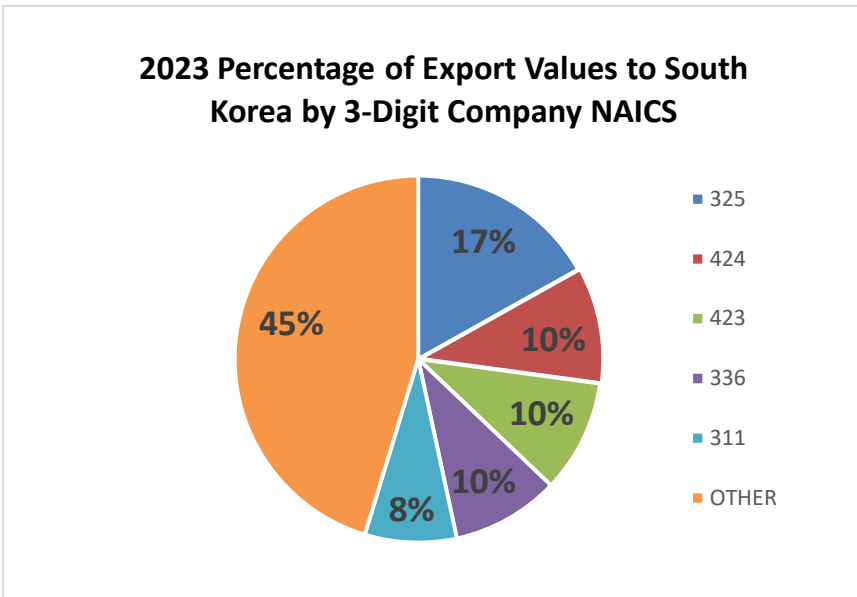

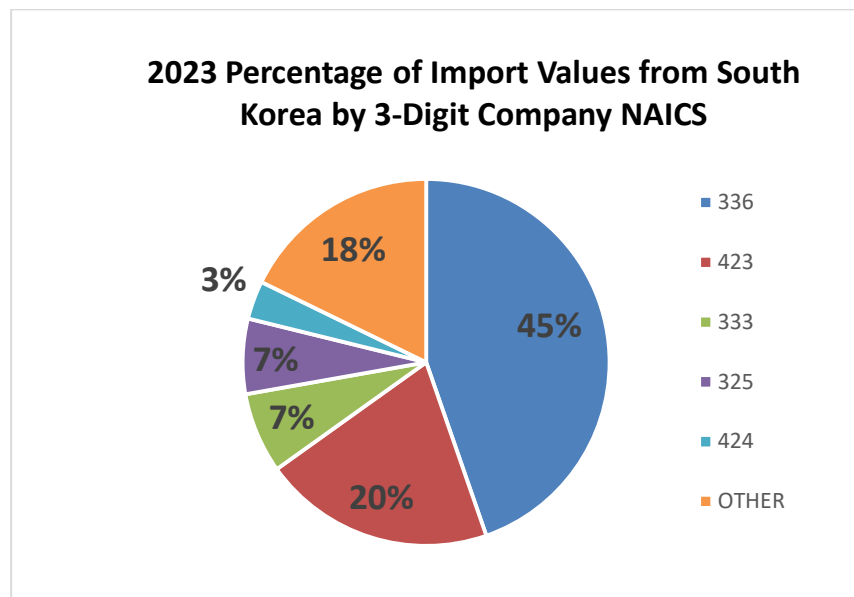

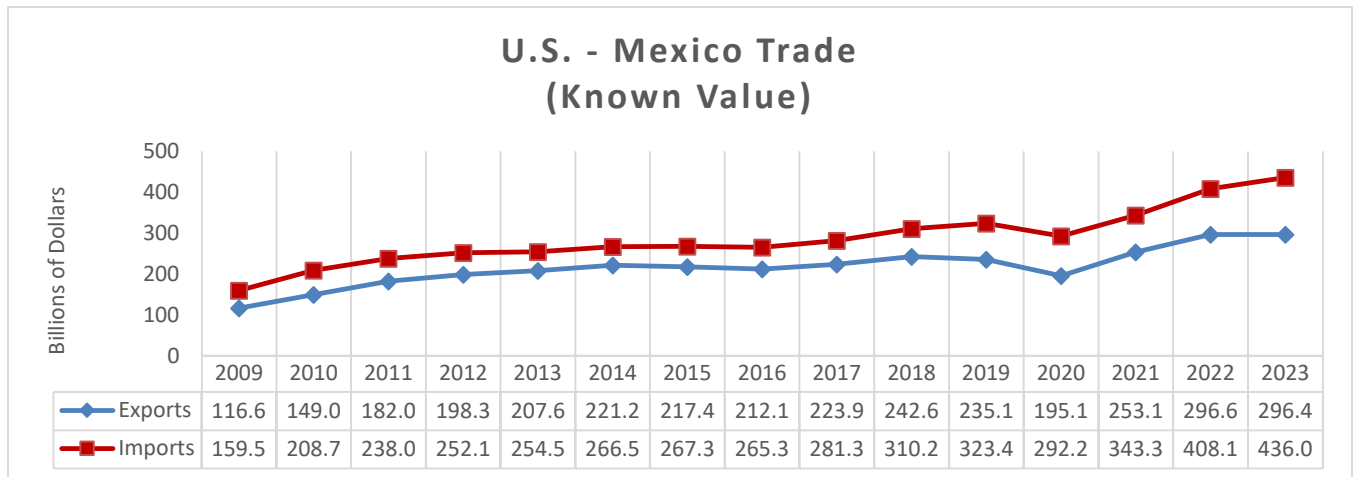

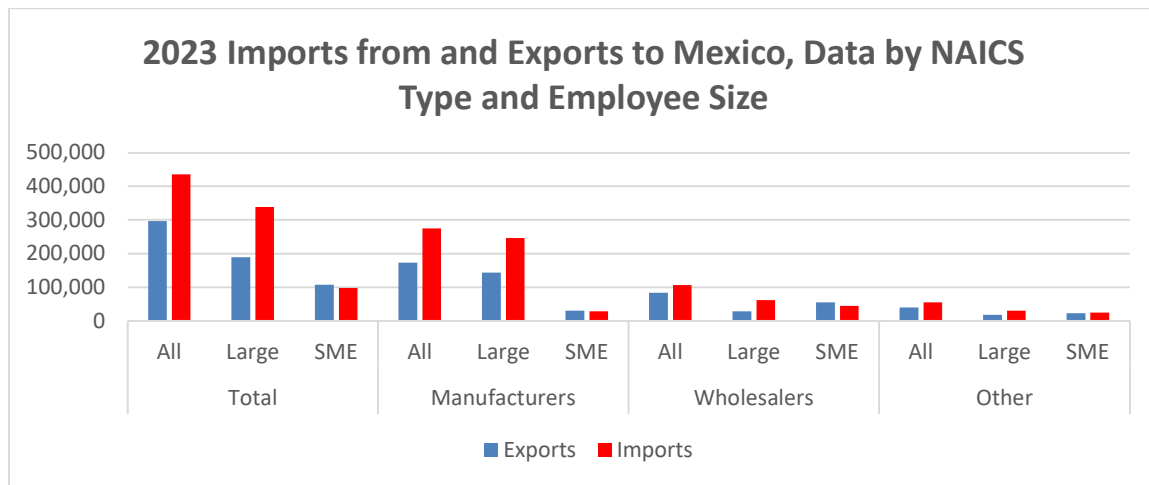

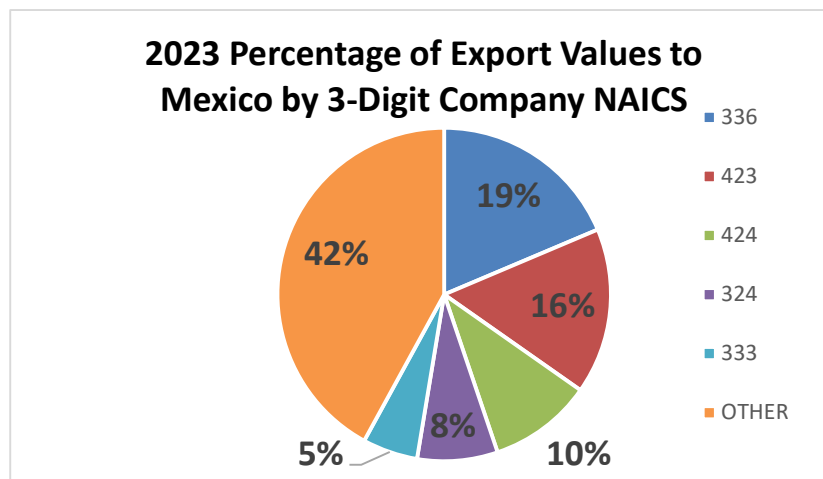

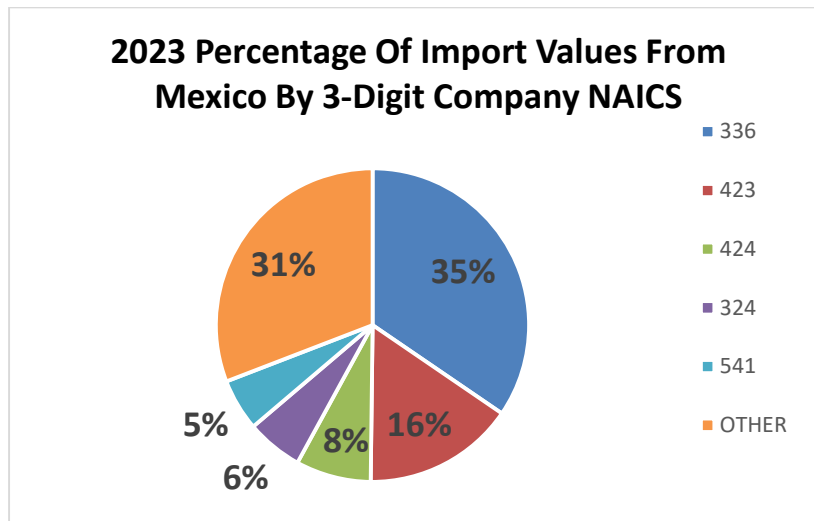

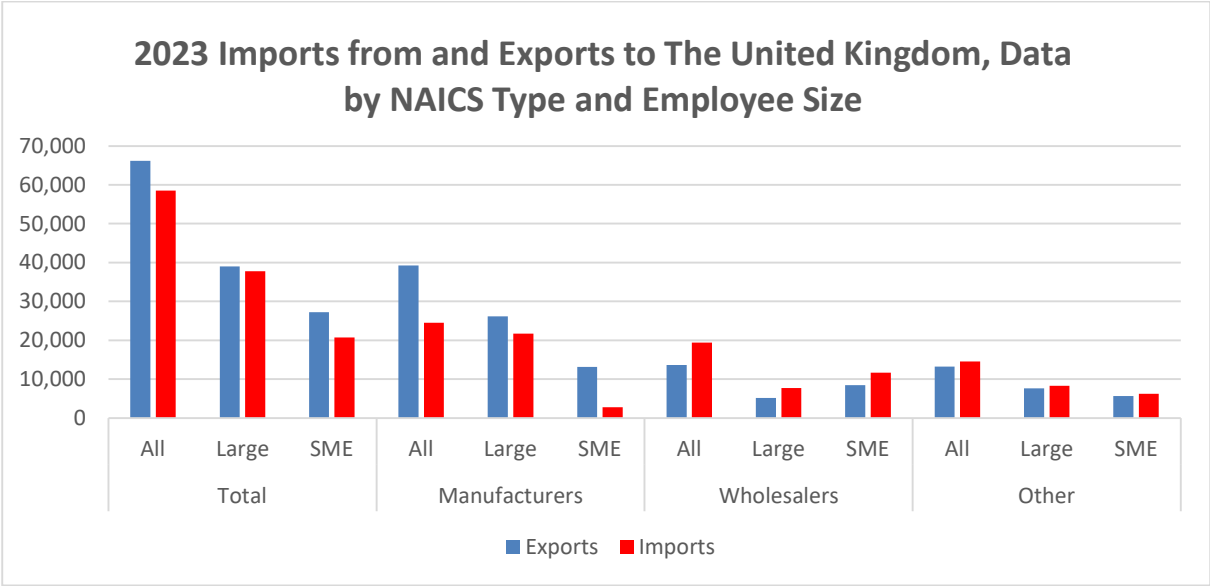

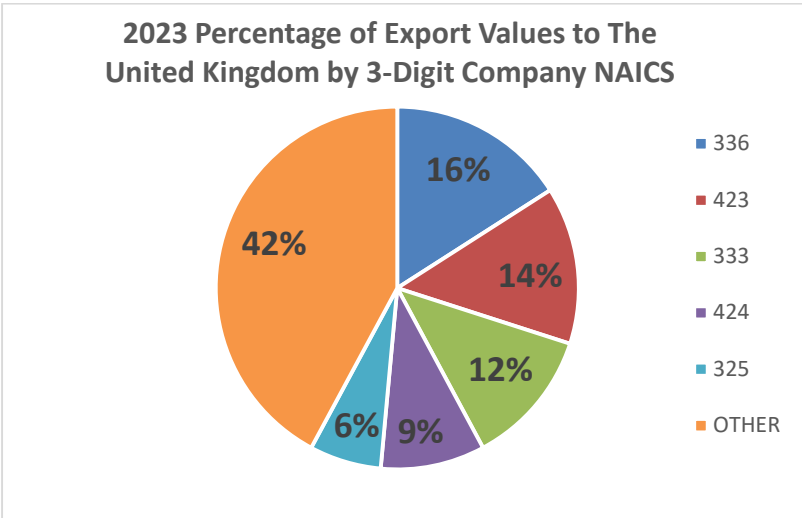

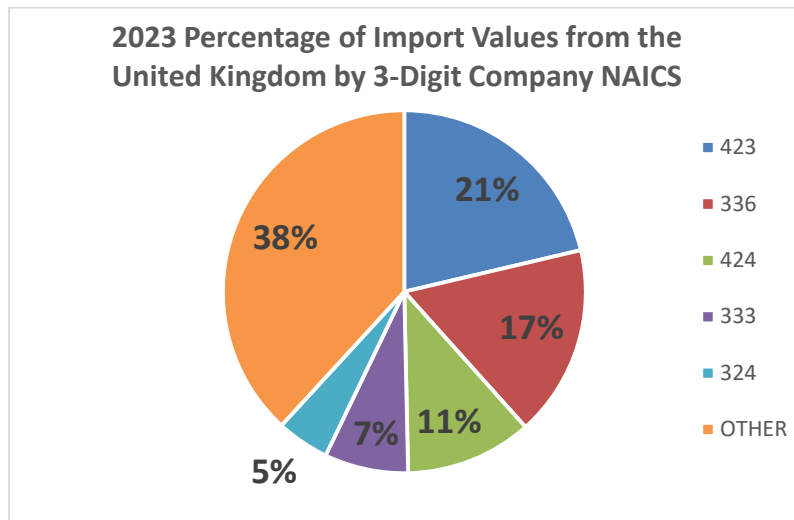

Export and Import Values by State

The number of exporters and importers for each state as well as the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands is provided with the corresponding value in the exhibit below. It is very important to make a distinction, however, in what “State” represents for exports and imports – namely the “Origin of Movement State” for exports and the “U.S. State of Destination” which is used with imports.

The “Origin of Movement State” represents the state in which a good begins its journey to the port of export intended for destinations in other countries.

“U.S. State of Destination” indicates the U.S. state, U.S. territory or U.S. possession where the merchandise is destined, as known at the time of entry summary filing. For shipments into Foreign Trade Zones, the import state represents the location of the zone.

Final Note on U.S. – United Kingdom Trade

According to the annual “Profile of U.S. Importing and Exporting Companies, 2022 – 2023”, the United Kingdom was the seventh largest export market and twelfth largest import market for trade in goods with the United States based on known value. However, based on total known value (i.e. combined imports and exports) the United Kingdom ranks seventh in terms of trade volume with the United States.
