

U.S GOODS TRADE: IMPORTS AND EXPORTS BY RELATED-PARTIES, 2025

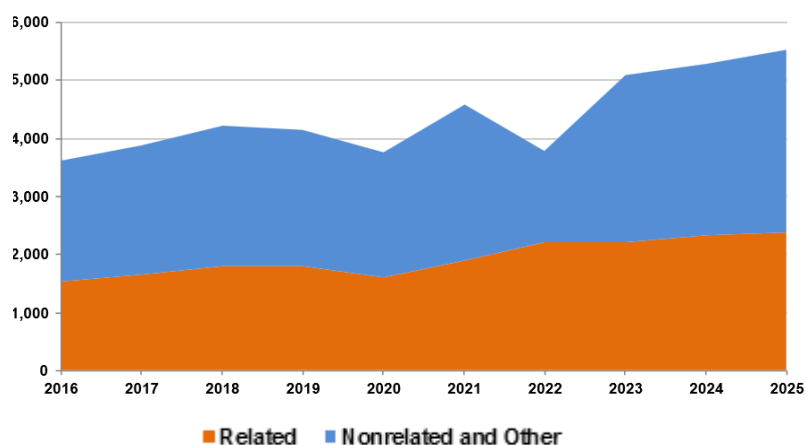
In 2025, the Nation's international related-party trade accounted for 42.8 percent (\$2,384.5 billion) of total goods trade (\$5,571.1 billion). Related-party total goods is based on imports for consumption and total exports (domestic and foreign). Related-party trade includes trade by U.S. companies with their subsidiaries abroad as well as trade by U.S subsidiaries of foreign companies with their parent companies. Other trade is the estimate for shipments with a missing related-party status indicator.

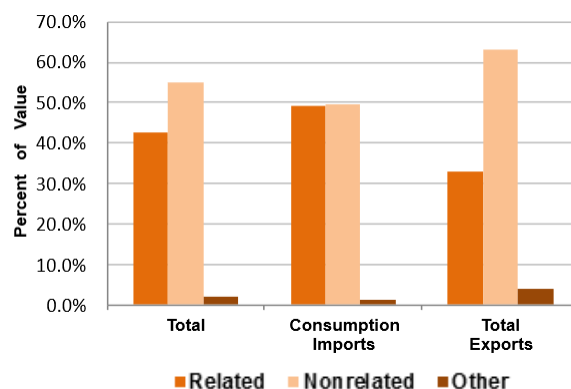
- Related-party total goods trade is based on imports for consumption and total exports (domestic and foreign).
- Related-party trade accounted for 49.0 percent (\$1,663.1 billion) of imports for consumption (\$3,391.2 billion) and 33.1 percent (\$721.4 billion) of total exports (\$2,179.9 billion).
- In 2025, U.S. related-party trade increased by 2.1 percent (\$48.5 billion) while total trade increased by 4.8 percent (\$252.2 billion) from 2024.

Related-Party & Total Trade (billions of dollars)



Related-party trade increased by 55.1% (\$847.2 billion) and total trade increased by 52.7% (\$1,910.5 billion) from 2016 to 2025. In this same period, the value of related-party trade as a percent of all trade ranged between a low of 41.30% in 2021 to a high of 58.14% in 2022.

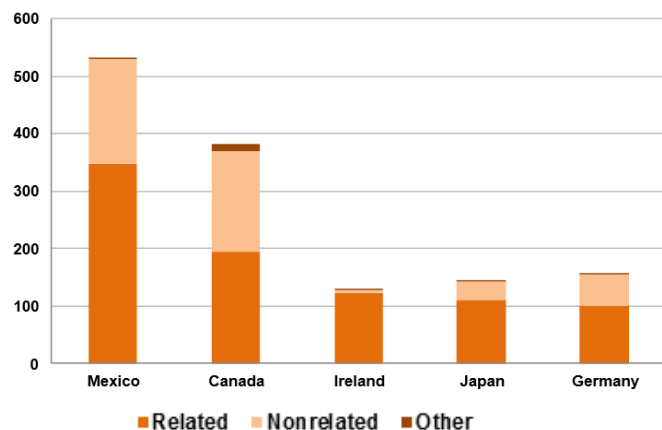

Top 5 Countries By Related-Party Trade

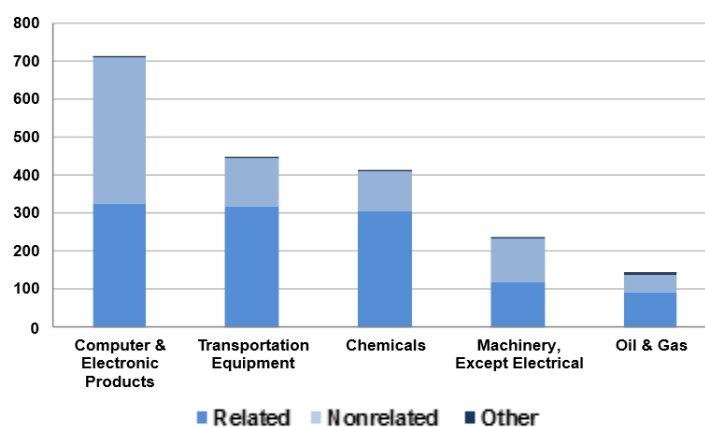

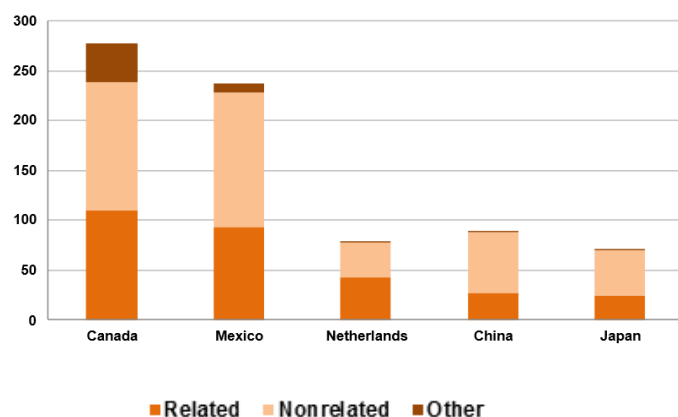

Top 5 Countries By Related-Party Trade

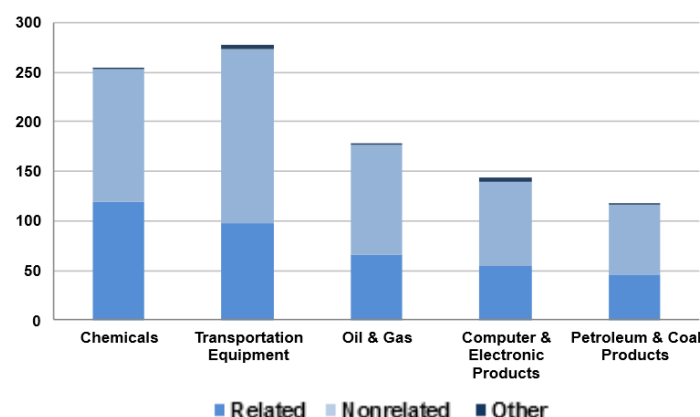
