²³ NASSAU.—Part of Queens County (part of Assembly District 5, Queens Borough) annexed to Lawrence village, Nassau County, in 1928. Long Beach village incorporated as a city and made independent in 1922. Parts of Hempstead town annexed to Floral Park village in 1920, to Freeport village in 1923, and parts annexed to Hempstead village, Lynbrook village and Rockville Centre village, at various dates since 1920. Parts of North Hempstead town annexed to Floral Park and Plandome villages in 1920, and part to Mineola village in 1927. Villages incorporated since 1920: Great Neck, Kennington, Malverne in 1921; Bellerose, Kings Point, Old Westbury in 1924; Hewlett Harbor, Jamaica Square, Mill Neck, Valley Stream in 1925; Centre Island, East Williston, Island Park, Laurelton, Williston Park in 1926; Cove Neck, Elmont, Hewlett Neck, New Hyde Park, Stewart Manor in 1927; Hewlett Bay Park, Matinecock in 1928; North Hills, Old Brookville, Plandome Heights in 1929; Munsey Park in 1930. Lake Success village incorporated in 1927, and name changed from Success in 1928. Bayville village not returned separately in 1920.

²⁴ NEW YORK.—County total for 1910 includes population (430,980) of Bronx Borough, taken to form Bronx County in 1914. For total population of New York City see Table 5.

²⁵ NIAGARA.—Part of Niagara town (La Salle village, population 3,813 in 1920; 1,299 in 1910) annexed to Niagara Falls city in 1927.
