## POPULATION OF IOWA BY COUNTIES AND MINOR CIVIL DIVISIONS.

This bulletin, prepared under the direction of Mr. WILLIAM C. HUNT, chief statistician for population, gives the aggregate population of Iowa by counties and minor civil divisions, according to the official count of the returns of the Twelfth Census, taken as of June 1, 1900.

Iowa was organized as a territory July 3, 1838, admitted as a state March 3, 1845, and readmitted with enlarged boundaries December 28, 1846. Table 1 shows the population of Iowa at each census from 1840 to 1900, inclusive, together with the increase by number and per cent during each decade.

The population of the state in 1900 is 2,231,853 as against 1,911,896 in 1890, representing an increase since 1890 of 319,957, or 16.7 per cent. This is a somewhat lower rate of increase than that for the decade from 1880 to 1890, and much lower than that for any decade preceding 1880. The population of the state in 1840 was 43,112, and during the next ten years it increased 149,102, or 345.8 per cent. From 1850 to 1860 the increase was from 192,214 to 674,913, or 251.1 per cent, the numerical increase being 482,699. In 1870 the population had become 1,194,020, which represented a numerical increase for the preceding decade of 519,107, the largest gain for any ten years in the history of the state.

The population of Iowa in 1900 is more than fifty-one times as large as the population reported for 1840, the first census taken after its organization as a territory in 1838.

The total land surface of Iowa is, approximately, 55,475 square miles, the average number of persons to the square mile at the censuses of 1890 and 1900 being as follows: 1890, 34.5; 1900, 40.2.

Table 2 shows the population of Iowa by counties at each census from 1840 to 1900, inclusive, while table 3, which immediately follows, shows, for each county, the increase (or decrease) by number and per cent during the ten years from 1890 to 1900.

There have been no territorial changes in the counties of Iowa since 1890.

Of the 99 counties in the state all but one have increased in population during the decade, the counties showing more than 50 per cent of increase being Emmet, 132.5 per cent; Dickinson, 84.7 per cent; Hancock, 80.4 per cent; Winnebago, 73.7 per cent; Kossuth, 73.2 per cent; Pocahontas, 60.6 per cent; Osceola, 56.5 per cent; Palo Alto, 54.0 per cent; Lyon, 51.7 per cent; and Wright, 51.2 per cent.

The largest numerical increase (17,214) appears in Polk county, but more than two-thirds of this is due to the increase in the population of Des Moines, the capital city.

Woodbury county shows a decrease of 1,022, or 1.8 per cent.

Table 4 shows the population of Iowa by minor civil divisions, so far as it was separately returned at the censuses of 1890 and 1900.
