Col. 1. VALUE OF DWEL. IF OWNED: When owner's household averages only a part of a structure, estimate value of portion occupied by owner's household. When the value of the real occupied by the owner of a two-family house, it should be approximately one-half the total value of the structure.

Col. 2. COLOR OF HAIR: White, W; Black, B; Brown, Br; Red, R; Gray, G; Blue, Bl; Green, Gr; Other, Oth.

Col. 3. AGE AT LAST MARRIAGE: Enter age of children born on or after April 1, 1930, as follows: None, N; April 1930, 1; May 1930, 2; June 1930, 3; July 1930, 4; August 1930, 5; September 1930, 6; October 1930, 7; November 1930, 8; December 1930, 9; 1931, 10; 1932, 11; 1933, 12; 1934, 13; 1935, 14; 1936, 15; 1937, 16; 1938, 17; 1939, 18; 1940, 19.

Col. 4. HIGHEST GRADE OF SCHOOL COMPLETED: None, 0; Elementary school, less than 8th grade, 1-7; 8th grade, 8; High school, less than 12th grade, 9-11; 12th grade, 12; College, less than 4th year, 13-14; 4th year, 15; 5th year, 16; 6th year, 17; 7th year, 18; 8th year, 19; 9th year, 20; 10th year, 21; 11th year, 22; 12th year, 23; Graduate work, 24-30.

Col. 5. CITIZENSHIP OF THE FOREIGN BORN: Naturalized, Na; Foreign born, Fb; Alien, Al; American citizen born abroad, Ab.

Col. 6. WAS THIS PERSON AT WORK? Enter "Y" for persons at work for pay or profit, in private or non-emergency Government work; "N" for persons not at work during year of March 20-31 for any of the following reasons: Family; temporary illness; industrial disaster; injury; and attending a worker with instructions to return to work at a specific time; leave due to temporary and weather conditions.

Col. 7. DID THIS PERSON HAVE A JOB? Enter "Y" for persons not making work, who had a job, business, or professional enterprise but did not work during year of March 20-31 for any of the following reasons: Family; temporary illness; industrial disaster; injury; and attending a worker with instructions to return to work at a specific time; leave due to temporary and weather conditions.

Col. 8. AND CLASS OF WORKER: Wage or salary worker in private work, PW; Wage or salary worker in Government work, GW; Employee, E; Working on own account, SA; Unpaid family worker, UF.

Col. 9. YEAR OF MILITARY SERVICE: World War, WW; Spanish-American War, SpA; Philippine Insurrection, PI; World War I, WWI; World War II, WWII; Other, Oth.
