

State of Oklahoma for ratification or rejection, was that the said Constitution was ratified together with a provision for state-wide prohibition, separately submitted at the said election; and the State of Oklahoma is to be deemed admitted by Congress into the Union under and by virtue of the said act on an equal footing with the original States;
