Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders

January 1992

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(All figures in text are in seasonally adjusted current dollars)

Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in January increased \$0.9 billion or 0.4 percent to \$235.0 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. The January increase follows a 3.7 percent December decline and 0.4 percent increase in November. An increase in durables more than offset a decline in nondurables.

Shipments were up \$0.2 billion or 0.1 percent to \$236.2 billion. This is the ninth increase in the last ten months. An increase in durables more than offset a decline in nondurables.

Unfilled orders in January decreased \$1.2 billion or 0.2 percent to \$510.2 billion and are at the lowest level since \$506.2 billion in October 1989. This is the fifth consecutive monthly decline and the eleventh in the last thirteen months.

Inventories were down \$1.3 billion or 0.3 percent to \$374.4 billion and are at the lowest level since \$372.4 billion in February 1989. This is the fourth consecutive monthly decline and tenth in the last eleven months. The inventories-to-shipments ratio in January remained at 1.59.

New Orders

New orders for durable goods in January increased a revised \$2.6 billion or 2.2 percent to \$120.3 billion. The January increase followed a 5.0 percent decrease in December and a 0.6 percent increase in November. Excluding defense, new orders were up \$4.5 billion or 4.1 percent.

New orders for industrial machinery and equipment, led by computer and office equipment, accounted for the largest increase, up \$1.4 billion or 6.9 percent to \$21.2 billion, and is at the highest level since \$21.8 billion in January 1991. Instruments and related products increased \$1.0 billion or 10.9 percent to \$9.8 billion, primarily due to search and navigation equipment and medical instruments and supplies. Fabricated metal products was up \$0.7 billion or 4.6 percent to \$15.8 billion and is at the highest level since \$16.5 billion in September 1990. Electronic and other electrical equipment declined \$0.9 billion or 5.1 percent to \$17.4 billion, following four consecutive monthly increases.

New orders for nondurable goods decreased \$1.7 billion or 1.4 percent to \$114.7 billion, following a 2.3 percent decline in December. These are the first consecutive decreases since five consecutive declines ending with March 1991.

Shipments

Shipments of durable goods in January increased \$1.5 billion or 1.3 percent to \$121.3 billion, following a 5.3 percent decline in December. This is the ninth increase in the last ten months. Transportation equipment was up \$0.8 billion or 2.5 percent to \$30.4 billion. Industrial machinery and equipment increased \$0.5 billion or 2.4 percent to \$20.9 billion, primarily due to computer and office equipment. The largest decline was in electronic and other electrical equipment, down \$0.7 billion or 3.7 percent to \$17.1 billion.

Shipments of nondurable goods decreased \$1.3 billion or 1.1 percent to \$114.9 billion, and are at the lowest level since \$114.2 billion in March 1991. The largest decreases occurred in petroleum and coal products, down \$0.8 billion, and food and kindred products, down \$0.7 billion.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for durable goods in January decreased a revised \$1.0 billion or 0.2 percent to \$488.4 billion, and are at the lowest level since \$484.6 billion in October 1989. This is the fifth consecutive decline. The largest decrease occurred in transportation equipment, down \$1.1 billion or 0.4 percent to \$271.8 billion. Primary metals, down \$0.9 billion or 4.2 percent to \$19.9 billion, is at the lowest level since \$19.8 billion in May 1991. The largest increase occurred in fabricated metal products, up \$0.4 billion or 1.5 percent to \$26.7 billion. Industrial machinery and equipment was up \$0.3 billion or 0.6 percent to \$53.0 billion, following three consecutive monthly declines. Unfilled orders for nondurable goods decreased \$0.2 billion or 0.9 percent to \$21.8 billion.

Inventories

Inventories for durable goods in January were down \$1.1 billion or 0.4 percent to \$239.2 billion. This is the lowest level since \$237.6 billion in November 1988. The largest decreases were in transportation equipment, down \$0.7 billion, industrial machinery and equipment, down \$0.3 billion, and primary metals, down \$0.3 billion. Nondurable goods decreased \$0.2 billion or 0.2 percent to \$135.2 billion, as declines in petroleum and coal products, chemicals and allied products, and food and kindred products more than offset increases in all other major groups.

By stage of fabrication, finished-goods inventories were down 0.3 percent in durables and 0.5 percent in nondurables. Work in process declined 0.6 percent in durables and increased 0.8 percent in nondurables. Materials and supplies decreased 0.2 percent in durables and 0.2 percent in nondurables.




Total Manufacturing


Ratio of Unfilled Orders and Inventories to Shipments


NonDefense Capital Goods
