Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in August increased \$2.2 billion or 0.9 percent to \$252.8 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows a 1.9 percent decrease in July and is the second increase in the last three months. Year-to-date new orders for 1993 totaled \$2,023.4 billion, 5.9 percent above the same period a year ago.

Shipments increased \$3.8 billion or 1.5 percent to \$255.5 billion, following a 2.6 percent decrease in July. This is the second increase in the last three months. Year-to-date shipments for 1993 totaled \$2,043.2 billion, 5.6 percent above the same period a year ago.

Unfilled orders decreased \$2.7 billion or 0.6 percent to \$455.5 billion, the lowest level since July 1988. This is the sixth consecutive monthly decline and the twenty-first in the last twenty-four months. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio decreased from 3.41 in July to 3.32 in August, the lowest level since April 1978.

Inventories decreased \$0.1 billion to \$381.4 billion, the second decline in the last three months. The inventories-to-shipments ratio decreased from 1.52 in July to 1.49 in August.

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in August increased \$2.9 billion or 2.3 percent to \$131.4 billion, following a 2.8 percent decrease in July. This is the second increase in the last three months.

Transportation equipment had the largest increase, up \$2.3 billion or 7.8 percent to \$31.5 billion, as increases in motor vehicles and parts and aircraft and parts more than offset a decline in shipbuilding and tanks. This follows a 16.3 percent decrease in July. Excluding transportation equipment, new orders increased \$0.6 billion or 0.6 percent. Fabricated metal products increased \$0.4 billion or 2.8 percent to \$14.0 billion, the first increase since May. Industrial machinery and equipment, up for the second consecutive month, increased \$0.4 billion or 1.5 percent to \$24.1 billion. Instruments and related products increased \$0.3 billion or 2.9 percent to \$10.8 billion, following a 7.6 percent increase in July. The largest decline was in electronic and other electrical equipment, down \$0.8 billion or 4.1 percent to \$19.6 billion, primarily due to electronic components. This follows a 2.9 percent increase in July.

New orders for nondurable goods decreased \$0.7 billion or 0.6 percent to \$121.4 billion, following a 0.9 percent decrease in July. This is the fourth decline in the last five months. Tobacco products had the largest decrease. The largest increases were in food and kindred products and rubber and plastics products.

Shipments

Shipments of durable goods in August increased \$4.6 billion or 3.6 percent to \$133.9 billion, the largest increase since December 1992. This follows a 4.3 percent decrease in July and is the second increase in the last three months. Nine of ten major industry groups increased. Transportation equipment had the largest increase, up \$3.0 billion or 9.8 percent to \$33.9 billion, primarily due to motor vehicles and parts and aircraft and parts. This follows a 12.9 percent decline in July.

Shipments of nondurable goods decreased \$0.8 billion or 0.7 percent to \$121.6 billion, following a 0.7 percent decrease in July. This is the fourth decline in the last five months. The largest decrease was in tobacco products, down \$1.2 billion or 38.1 percent to \$2.0 billion, the largest decline on record. The largest increase was in food and kindred products, up \$0.6 billion or 1.7 percent to \$35.0 billion, the highest level on record. Rubber and plastics products increased \$0.4 billion or 4.9 percent to \$8.6 billion, following a 4.8 percent decline in July.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for durable goods in August decreased \$2.4 billion or 0.6 percent to \$433.2 billion, the lowest level since July 1988. This is the sixth consecutive monthly decline and twenty-fifth in the last thirty months. Transportation equipment, down for the sixteenth consecutive month, had the largest decrease, down \$2.4 billion or 1.0 percent to \$226.4 billion, primarily due to aircraft and parts. This is the lowest level since March 1989. Excluding transportation equipment, unfilled orders were virtually unchanged. Industrial machinery and equipment had the largest increase, up \$0.3 billion or 0.5 percent to \$50.9 billion. Unfilled orders for nondurable goods decreased \$0.3 billion or 1.1 percent to \$22.3 billion, the fourth consecutive monthly decline.

Inventories

Inventories for durable goods in August decreased \$0.5 billion or 0.2 percent to \$237.5 billion, the second decline in the last three months. Transportation equipment had the largest decrease, down \$1.0 billion or 1.5 percent to \$64.0 billion, primarily due to aircraft and parts. Excluding transportation equipment, inventories were up \$0.6 billion or 0.3 percent. Nondurable goods inventories increased \$0.3 billion or 0.2 percent to \$143.9 billion, following two consecutive monthly declines.

By stage of fabrication, finished goods decreased 0.7 percent in durables and increased 0.4 percent in nondurables. Work in process was down 0.2 percent in durables and up 0.3 percent in nondurables. Materials and supplies increased 0.3 percent in durables and declined 0.1 percent in nondurables.




Total Manufacturing

Three Month Moving Averages


