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# Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders

December 1993

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Note: All figures in text are in seasonally adjusted current dollars

### Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in December increased \$3.2 billion or 1.2 percent to \$266.0 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows a 1.7 percent November increase and is the lifth monthly increase in a row, the longest string of consecutive monthly increases since September 1987 to June 1988. New orders in 1993 totaled \$3,066 billion, up 5.9 percent from 1992, the largest annual increase since 1988.

Shipments increased \$3.7 billion or 1.4 percent to \$269.2 billion. This follows a 2.0 percent increase in November and is the fifth consecutive monthly increase. For the year, shipments totaled \$3,100 billion, up 5.7 percent from 1992, the largest annual increase since 1988.

Unfilled orders decreased \$3.2 billion or 0.7 percent to \$442.1 billion, the lowest level since March 1988. This is the tenth monthly decline in a row and twenty-fifth in the last twenty-eight months. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio decreased from 3.12 in November to 3.04 in December, the lowest in nearly thirty years. Unfilled orders are 7.0 percent lower than year-end 1992.

Inventories decreased \$2.2 billion or 0.6 percent to \$377.9 billion, the lowest level since March 1989. This follows a revised \$0.1 billion decline in November and is the fifth consecutive monthly decline. The inventories-to-shipments ratio decreased from 1.43 in November to 1.40 in December, the lowest on record. Inventories are 0.3 percent lower than year-end 1992.

### **New Orders**

New orders for manufactured durable goods in December increased \$3.0 billion or 2.1 percent to \$142.7 billion. This follows a 2.2 percent increase in November and is the fifth monthly increase in a row, the longest string of consecutive monthly increases since February to July 1987. The largest increase was in transportation equipment, up \$1.0 billion or 2.9 percent to \$35.5 billion, with increases in all industry categories except aircraft and parts. Electronic and other electrical equipment increased \$0.8 billion or 4.0 percent to \$20.7 billion, due to electronic components and communications equipment.

New orders for nondurable goods increased \$0.3 billion or 0.2 percent to \$123.4 billion, as an increase in food and kindred products more than offset a decline in petroleum and coal products. This follows a 1.2 percent increase in November and is the third increase in the last four months.

### Shipments

Shipments of durable goods in December increased \$3.3 billion or 2.3 percent to \$146.0 billion. This follows a 3.3 percent increase in November and is the fifth consecutive

monthly increase. All major groups had increases. Transportation equipment had the largest increase, up \$1.3 billion or 3.4 percent to \$38.0 billion, due to motor vehicles and parts and aircraft and parts. Industrial machinery and equipment increased \$0.7 billion or 2.7 percent to \$26.4 billion, with increases in most categories. Electronic and other electrical equipment increased \$0.6 billion or 3.1 percent to \$21.1 billion, due to communications equipment and electronic components.

Shipments of nondurable goods increased \$0.3 billion or 0.3 percent to \$123.2 billion, following a 0.5 percent increase in November. This is the third increase in the last four months. The largest increase was in food and kindred products, up \$0.5 billion or 1.3 percent to \$35.5 billion. Petroleum and coal products had the largest decline, down \$0.2 billion or 2.2 percent to \$11.0 billion.

#### Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for durable goods in December decreased \$3.3 billion or 0.8 percent to \$420.6 billion, the lowest level since March 1988. This is the tenth consecutive monthly decline and twenty-ninth in the last thirty-four months. Transportation equipment decreased for the twentieth consecutive month, down \$2.6 billion or 1.2 percent to \$213.4 billion, as a decline in aircraft and parts more than offset an increase in railroad equipment. Excluding transportation equipment, unfilled orders decreased \$0.8 billion or 0.4 percent. Instruments and related products decreased \$0.9 billion or 1.6 percent to \$51.3 billion. Industrial machinery and equipment, up for the sixth consecutive month, had the largest increase, up \$0.6 billion or 1.1 percent to \$53.2 billion. Unfilled orders for nondurable goods increased \$0.1 billion or 0.6 percent to \$21.5 billion, the second increase in a row, following six consecutive monthly declines.

#### **Inventories**

Inventories for durable goods in December decreased \$1.5 billion or 0.6 percent to \$236.4 billion. Transportation equipment had the largest decrease, down \$1.7 billion or 2.7 percent to \$61.5 billion, due to aircraft and parts. Excluding transportation equipment, inventories increased \$0.2 billion or 0.1 percent. Nondurable goods inventories decreased \$0.7 billion or 0.5 percent to \$141.6 billion, primarily due to petroleum and coal products. This is the sixth decline in the last seven months.

By stage of fabrication, finished goods decreased 0.8 percent in durables and 0.5 percent in nondurables. Work in process decreased 0.7 percent in durables and 0.1 percent in nondurables. Materials and supplies decreased 0.4 percent in durables and 0.7 percent in nondurables.






Ratio of Unfilled Orders and Inventories to Shipments
