# Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders

### Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in July decreased \$5.3 billion or 2.1 percent to \$250.2 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows a 2.9 percent increase in June and is the fourth decline in the last five months. Year-to-date new orders for 1993 totaled \$1,770.2 billion, 5.8 percent above the same period a year ago.

Shipments decreased \$6.8 billion or 2.6 percent to \$251.5 billion, the largest decline since December 1991. This follows a 1.7 percent increase in June and is the third decline in the last four months. Year-to-date shipments for 1993 totaled \$1,787.6 billion, 5.6 percent above the same period a year ago.

Unfilled orders decreased \$1.4 billion or 0.3 percent to \$457.9 billion, the lowest level since September 1988. This is the fifth consecutive monthly decline and the twentieth in the last twenty-three months. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio increased from 3.33 in June to 3.41 in July.

Inventories increased \$0.1 billion to \$381.4 billion, the fifth increase in the last six months. The inventories-to-shipments ratio increased from 1.48 in June to 1.52 in July.

### **New Orders**

New orders for manufactured durable goods in July decreased a revised \$4.1 billion or 3.1 percent to \$128.1 billion. This follows a 4.3 percent increase in June and is the fourth decline in the last five months.

Transportation equipment had the largest decrease, down \$5.8 billion or 16.7 percent to \$29.1 billion, as declines in aircraft and parts, motor vehicles and parts, and railroad equipment more than offset an increase in shipbuilding and tanks. This follows a 14.5 percent increase in June and is the largest decrease since November 1990. Excluding transportation equipment, new orders increased \$1.7 billion or 1.8 percent. Industrial machinery and equipment had the largest increase, up \$1.0 billion or 4.2 percent to \$23.9 billion, with nearly half the increase in computer and office equipment. Instruments and related products increased \$0.6 billion or 6.4 percent to \$10.4 billion, primarily due to search and navigation equipment.

New orders for nondurable goods decreased \$1.2 billion or 1.0 percent to \$122.0 billion, following a 1.4 percent increase in June. This is the third decline in the last four months. The largest decreases were in chemicals and allied products and rubber and plastics products. Tobacco products had the largest increase.

### **Shipments**

Shipments of durable goods in July decreased \$5.9 billion or 4.4 percent to \$129.2 billion, the largest decline since December 1991. This follows a 2.1 percent increase in June, and is the third decline in the last four months. Transportation equipment had the largest decrease, down \$4.5 billion or 12.8 percent to \$30.9 billion, primarily due to motor vehicles and parts and aircraft and parts. Primary metals and fabricated metal products each decreased \$0.5 billion. Industrial machinery and equipment had the largest increase, up \$0.4 billion or 1.7 percent to \$23.6 billion, due to computer and office equipment.

Shipments of nondurable goods decreased \$0.9 billion or 0.7 percent to \$122.4 billion, following a 1.3 percent increase in June. This is the third decline in the last four months. The largest decrease was in chemicals and allied products, down \$0.6 billion or 2.3 percent to \$26.1 billion. The largest increase was in tobacco products, up \$0.5 billion or 16.7 percent to \$3.2 billion.

### **Unfilled Orders**

Unfilled orders for durable goods in July decreased \$1.0 billion or 0.2 percent to \$435.3 billion, the lowest level since August 1988. This is the fifth consecutive monthly decline. All major groups declined except electronic and other electrical equipment, industrial machinery and equipment, and stone, clay, and glass products. Transportation equipment had the largest decrease, down \$1.8 billion or 0.8 percent to \$228.7 billion, as a decrease in aircraft and parts more than offset an increase in shipbuilding and tanks. Excluding transportation equipment, unfilled orders were up \$0.8 billion or 0.4 percent. Electronic and other electrical equipment had the largest increase, up \$1.1 billion or 2.6 percent to \$43.6 billion. Unfilled orders for nondurable goods decreased \$0.3 billion or 1.5 percent to \$22.6 billion.

### **Inventories**

Inventories for durable goods in July increased \$0.3 billion or 0.1 percent to \$237.8 billion, the third increase in the last four months. Electronic and other electrical equipment had the largest increase, up \$0.4 billion or 1.2 percent to \$33.0 billion, primarily due to communications equipment. Nondurable goods inventories declined \$0.2 billion or 0.2 percent to \$143.6 billion.

By stage of fabrication, finished goods increased 0.5 percent in durables and 0.2 percent in nondurables. Work in process was down 0.4 percent in durables and unchanged in nondurables. Materials and supplies increased 0.6 percent in durables and declined 0.6 percent in nondurables.




### **Total Manufacturing**

Ratio of Unfilled Orders and Inventories to Shipments


