Summar

New orders for manufactured goods in June increased \$6.4 billion or 2.6 percent to \$254.8 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows a 1.6 percent decrease in May, and is the first increase since February. Year-to-date new orders for 1993 totaled \$1,519.3 billion, 6.1 percent above the same period a year ago.

Shipments increased \$4.6 billion or 1.8 percent to \$258.7 billion, following a 0.4 percent decrease in May. Year-to-date shipments for 1993 totaled \$1,536.4 billion, 6.2 percent above the same period a year ago.

Unfilled orders decreased \$3.9 billion or 0.8 percent to \$458.3 billion, the lowest level since September 1988. This is the fourth consecutive monthly decline. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio decreased from 3.42 in May to 3.33 in June, the lowest ratio since April 1978.

Inventories decreased \$0.2 billion or 0.1 percent to \$381.4 billion. This is the first decline since January. The inventories-to-shipments ratio decreased from 1.50 in May to 1.47 in June.

Please note that revisions in data reported for new orders and unfilled orders for October 1992 through March 1993 appear in Tables A - I.

New Orders

New orders for durable goods in June increased \$4.9 billion or 3.8 percent to \$131.6 billion, following a 2.4 percent decrease in May. This is the first increase since February.

Transportation equipment had the largest increase, up \$4.6 billion or 15.1 percent to \$35.1 billion, primarily due to aircraft and parts. This follows three consecutive monthly declines. Excluding transportation equipment, new orders for durable goods increased \$0.3 billion or 0.3 percent. Electronic and other electrical equipment was up \$0.8 billion or 4.5 percent to \$19.0 billion, primarily due to electronic components. Stone, clay and glass products had the largest decline, down \$0.4 billion or 7.4 percent to \$5.5 billion. Industrial machinery and equipment was down \$0.3 billion or 1.4 percent to \$22.9 billion.

New orders for nondurable goods increased \$1.6 billion or 1.3 percent to \$123.1 billion, following a 0.8 percent decrease in May. The largest increases were in chemicals and allied products and food and kindred products. Paper and allied products and petroleum and coal products had the largest decreases.

Shipments

Shipments of durable goods in June increased \$3.1 billion or 2.3 percent to \$135.4 billion, following a 0.3 percent decrease in May. All major groups increased except lumber and wood products and industrial machinery and equipment. Transportation equipment had the largest increase, up \$1.7 billion or 4.9 percent to \$35.9 billion, due to motor vehicles and parts and aircraft and parts. Electronic and other electrical equipment increased \$0.7 billion or 3.6 percent to \$19.5 billion, primarily due to electronic components. Primary metals increased \$0.4 billion or 3.8 percent to \$11.6 billion.

Shipments of nondurable goods increased \$1.5 billion or 1.3 percent to \$123.2 billion, following a 0.5 percent decrease in May. The largest increases were in chemicals and allied products, up \$1.0 billion or 3.8 percent to \$26.7 billion, and food and kindred products, up \$0.9 billion or 2.6 percent to \$34.3 billion. The largest decrease was in petroleum and coal products, down \$0.3 billion or 2.6 percent to \$12.7 billion. Paper and allied products was down \$0.2 billion or 1.8 percent to \$10.7 billion.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for durable goods in June decreased \$3.8 billion or 0.9 percent to \$435.4 billion, the lowest level since August 1988. This is the fourth consecutive monthly decline. Instruments and related products had the largest decrease, down \$1.0 billion or 1.8 percent to \$54.0 billion, primarily due to search and navigation equipment. Transportation equipment, down for the fourteenth month in a row, declined \$0.9 billion or 0.4 percent to \$230.1 billion, primarily due to aircraft and parts and shipbuilding and tanks. This is the lowest level since April 1989. Electronic and other electrical equipment declined \$0.5 billion or 1.2 percent to \$41.7 billion, the lowest level since March 1987. Unfilled orders for nondurable goods decreased \$0.1 billion or 0.5 percent to \$22.9 billion.

Inventories

Inventories for durable goods in June decreased \$0.2 billion or 0.1 percent to \$237.5 billion. Transportation equipment had the largest decrease, down \$0.3 billion or 0.4 percent to \$65.3 billion, due to aircraft and parts. Industrial machinery and equipment had the largest increase, up \$0.3 billion or 0.6 percent to \$45.1 billion. Nondurable goods inventories declined slightly to \$143.8 billion.

By stage of fabrication, finished goods decreased 0.5 percent in durables and 0.2 percent in nondurables. Work in process was up 0.4 percent in durables and 0.5 percent in nondurables. Materials and supplies decreased 0.4 percent in durables and was unchanged in nondurables.




Total Manufacturing


Ratio of Unfilled Orders and Inventories to Shipments
