Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in May decreased \$3.5 billion or 1.4 percent to \$249.3 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows a 0.3 percent decrease in April. New orders have declined four of the last five months. Year-to-date new orders for 1993 totaled \$1,268.0 billion, 6.7 percent above the same period a year ago.

Shipments decreased \$1.4 billion or 0.5 percent to \$253.7 billion, following a 1.5 percent decrease in April. Year-to-date shipments for 1993 totaled \$1,277.5 billion, 6.4 percent above the same period a year ago.

Unfilled orders decreased \$4.4 billion or 0.9 percent to \$468.6 billion, the lowest level since November 1988. This is the third consecutive decline. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio decreased from 3.50 in April to 3.46 in May.

Inventories increased \$1.1 billion or 0.3 percent to \$381.4 billion. This is the fourth consecutive monthly increase. The inventories-to-shipments ratio increased from 1.49 in April to 1.50 in May.

Please note that due to more complete reporting, revised data for inventories for January 1993 through March 1993 appear in Tables A, B, C, and D.

New Orders

New orders for durable goods in May decreased \$2.3 billion or 1.7 percent to \$128.0 billion, following a 0.2 percent decrease in April. This is the fourth decline in the last five months.

Instruments and related products had the largest decline, down \$1.1 billion or 10.3 percent to \$9.9 billion. Transportation equipment was down \$1.0 billion or 3.0 percent to \$31.3 billion, with decreases in nearly all industry categories. This is the third consecutive monthly decline. Electronic and other electrical equipment decreased \$0.5 billion or 2.5 percent to \$18.4 billion, following a 5.5 percent increase in April. Industrial machinery and equipment increased \$0.3 billion or 1.4 percent to \$23.3 billion.

New orders for nondurable goods decreased \$1.2 billion or 1.0 percent to \$121.3 billion, following a 0.5 percent decrease in April. The largest declines were in food and kindred products, chemical and allied products, and leather and leather products.

Shipments

Shipments of durable goods in May decreased \$0.5 billion or 0.4 percent to \$132.3 billion, following a 2.0 percent decrease in April. Transportation equipment had the largest decline, down \$1.0 billion or 2.8 percent to \$34.2

billion, primarily due to motor vehicles and parts. Excluding transportation equipment, shipments increased \$0.5 billion or 0.5 percent. Industrial machinery and equipment had the largest increase, up \$0.4 billion or 1.8 percent to \$23.3 billion, with increases in nearly all industry categories. This follows a 3.8 percent decrease in April.

Shipments of nondurable goods decreased \$0.9 billion or 0.7 percent to \$121.5 billion, following a 0.9 percent decrease in April. The largest declines were in food and kindred products, down \$0.9 billion or 2.5 percent to \$33.3 billion, and chemicals and allied products, down \$0.4 billion or 1.7 percent to \$25.5 billion.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for durable goods in May decreased \$4.2 billion or 0.9 percent to \$445.6 billion, the lowest level since November 1988. This is the third consecutive monthly decline. Transportation equipment had the largest decrease, down \$2.9 billion or 1.2 percent to \$237.0 billion, primarily due to aircraft and parts and shipbuilding and tanks. This is the twelfth decline in the last thirteen months. Instruments and related products decreased \$0.7 billion or 1.2 percent to \$55.1 billion, primarily due to search and navigation equipment. Stone, clay, and glass products were up \$0.2 billion or 2.7 percent to \$7.5 billion. Unfilled orders for nondurable goods decreased \$0.2 billion or 0.7 percent to \$23.0 billion.

Inventories

Inventories for durable goods in May increased \$0.6 billion or 0.2 percent to \$237.6 billion. Electronic and other electrical equipment had the largest increase, up \$0.4 billion or 1.3 percent to \$32.7 billion. Nondurable goods increased \$0.5 billion or 0.4 percent to a new high of \$143.8 billion. This is the fourth increase in the last five months.

By stage of fabrication, finished goods increased 0.1 percent in durables and 0.6 percent in nondurables. Work in process was up 0.1 percent in durables and down 0.5 percent in nondurables. Materials and supplies increased 0.6 percent in durables and 0.4 percent in nondurables.
