

# Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders

#### Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in September increased \$1.8 billion or 0.7 percent to \$255.2 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows a 1.2 percent increase in August and is the third increase in the last four months. Year-to-date new orders for 1993 totaled \$2,279.3 billion, 5.9 percent above the same period last year.

Shipments increased \$3.7 billion or 1.4 percent to \$260.2 billion, the highest level on record. This follows a 1.9 percent increase in August and is the third increase in the last four months. Year-to-date shipments for 1993 totaled \$2,304.5 billion, 5.6 percent above the same period last year.

Unfilled orders decreased \$5.0 billion or 1.1 percent to \$450.1 billion, the lowest level since June 1988. This is the seventh consecutive monthly decline and the twenty-second in the last twenty-five months. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio decreased from 3.30 in August to 3.21 in September, the lowest since October 1977.

Inventories decreased \$1.1 billion or 0.3 percent to \$380.3 billion, the third decline in the last four months. The inventories-to-shipments ratio decreased from 1.49 in August to 1.46 in September, the lowest on record.

#### **New Orders**

New orders for durable goods in September increased \$1.0 billion or 0.7 percent to \$132.7 billion, following a 2.5 percent increase in August. This is the third increase in the last four months. All major groups except transportation equipment and instruments and related products had increases. The largest increase was in electronic and other electrical equipment, up \$0.5 billion or 2.6 percent to \$20.4 billion, primarily due to communications equipment. Industrial machinery and equipment increased \$0.4 billion or 1.7 percent to \$24.5 billion. The largest decline was in transportation equipment, down \$0.5 billion or 1.6 percent to \$30.9 billion, as a decline in aircraft and parts more than offset increases in motor vehicles and parts and shipbuilding and tanks. Instruments and related products decreased \$0.4 billion or 3.7 percent to \$10.2 billion.

New orders for nondurable goods increased \$0.8 billion or 0.7 percent to \$122.5 billion, as increases, led by tobacco products and chemical and allied products, more than offset declines in petroleum and coal products, food and kindred products, and textile mill products. This follows a 0.3 percent decrease in August and is the first increase in the last three months.

### Shipments

Shipments of durable goods in September increased \$2.9 billion or 2.2 percent to \$137.5 billion, the highest level

on record. This follows a 4.1 percent increase in August and is the third increase in the last four months. All major groups increased. Transportation equipment had the largest increase, up \$1.0 billion or 2.9 percent to \$35.1 billion, as increases in motor vehicles and parts and railroad equipment more than offset a decline in aircraft and parts. This follows a 10.6 percent increase in August. Industrial machinery and equipment increased \$0.6 billion or 2.4 percent to \$24.5 billion.

Shipments of nondurable goods increased \$0.7 billion or 0.6 percent to \$122.8 billion, following a 0.3 percent decrease in August. This is the first increase in the last three months. The largest increase was in tobacco products, up \$0.6 billion or 29.2 percent to \$2.7 billion, following a 36.9 percent decrease in August. Chemicals and allied products increased \$0.3 billion or 1.1 percent to \$26.0 billion. The largest decreases were in petroleum and coal products, down \$0.3 billion or 2.3 percent to \$11.6 billion, and food and kindred products, down \$0.3 billion or 0.7 percent to \$35.2 billion.

### **Unfilled Orders**

Unfilled orders for durable goods in September decreased \$4.7 billion or 1.1 percent to \$428.1 billion, the lowest level since June 1988. This is the seventh consecutive monthly decline and twenty-sixth in the last thirty-one months. Transportation equipment, down for the seventeenth consecutive month, had the largest decrease, down \$4.2 billion or 1.9 percent to \$221.8 billion, as a decrease in aircraft and parts more than offset an increase in shipbuilding and tanks. This is the lowest level since February 1989. Instruments and related products declined \$0.7 billion or 1.4 percent to \$52.8 billion. Electronic and other electrical equipment had the largest increase, up \$0.5 billion or 1.1 percent to \$44.4 billion, as an increase in communications equipment more than offset a decline in electronic components. Unfilled orders for nondurable goods decreased \$0.3 billion or 1.2 percent to \$22.0 billion, the fifth consecutive monthly decline.

### **Inventories**

Inventories for durable goods in September decreased \$0.7 billion or 0.3 percent to \$237.0 billion, the third decline in the last four months. All major groups except lumber and wood products and furniture and fixtures declined. Nondurable goods inventories decreased \$0.5 billion or 0.3 percent to \$143.2 billion, primarily due to petroleum and coal products and food and kindred products. This is the third decline in the last four months.

By stage of fabrication, finished goods decreased 0.6 percent in durables and 0.5 percent in nondurables. Work in process was up 0.2 percent in durables and 0.1 percent in nondurables. Materials and supplies declined 0.7 percent in durables and 0.3 percent in nondurables.




### **Total Manufacturing**

Ratio of Unfilled Orders and Inventories to Shipments


