Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in February decreased \$2.7 billion or 1.0 percent to \$269.9 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This is the first decline since July and follows a 2.4 percent January increase. A decline in durables more than offset an increase in nondurables.

Shipments increased \$2.8 billion or 1.1 percent to \$271.2 billion, following a 0.5 percent decrease in January. This is the sixth increase in the last seven months. Both durables and nondurables increased.

Unfilled orders decreased \$1.3 billion or 0.3 percent to \$445.0 billion, the eleventh decline in the last twelve months. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio decreased from 3.11 in January to 3.07 in February.

Inventories increased \$1.1 billion or 0.3 percent to \$380.0 billion, the second consecutive increase. durables and nondurables increased. The inventories-toshipments ratio decreased from 1.41 in January to 1.40 in February.

New Orders

New orders for durable goods in February decreased \$3.9 billion or 2.6 percent to \$144.7 billion, the first decline since July. This follows a 4.3 percent increase in January. Transportation equipment had the largest decrease, down \$3.5 billion or 8.6 percent to \$37.8 billion, due to aircraft and parts. This follows four consecutive monthly increases. Excluding transportation equipment, new orders decreased. Excluding transportation equipment, new orders decreased \$0.3 billion or 0.3 percent, the first decline since May. Following two consecutive monthly increases, electronic and other electrical equipment decreased \$1.2 billion or 5.4 percent to \$21.1 billion, as a decline in electronic components more than offset an increase in communications equipment. Industrial machinery and equipment, up seven of the last eight months, had the largest increase, up \$1.1 billion or 4.1 percent to \$26.9 billion, with increases in nearly all categories.

New orders for nondurable goods increased \$1.1 billion or 0.9 percent to \$125.2 billion, primarily due to food and kindred products and petroleum and coal products. This tollows a 0.2 percent increase in January and is the fourth consecutive monthly increase.

Shipments

Shipments of durable goods in February increased \$1.5 billion or 1.0 percent to \$146.2 billion, following a 1.0 percent decline in January. This is the sixth increase in the last seven months. Industrial machinery and equipment, up three of the last four months, had the largest increase, up \$1.3 billion or 5.0 percent to \$26.3 billion, with increases in nearly all categories. Primary metals, also up three of the last four months, increased \$0.3 billion or 2.7 percent to \$12.1 billion. Transportation equipment, down for the first time since July, decreased \$0.2 billion or 0.4 percent to \$38.9 billion, due to aircraft and parts.

Shipments of nondurable goods increased \$1.4 billion or 1.1 percent to \$125.0 billion, following a 0.1 percent increase in January. This is the fourth consecutive monthly increase. All major groups increased except tobacco products and chemicals and allied products. The largest increases were in food and kindred products, up \$0.5 billion or 1.5 percent to \$35.6 billion, and petroleum and coal products, up \$0.5 billion or 4.3 percent to \$11.5 billion. Textile mill products and paper and allied products each increased \$0.2 billion.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for durable goods in February decreased \$1.5 billion or 0.3 percent to \$422.7 billion, following a 0.9 percent increase in January. This is the eleventh decline in the last twelve months. Transportation equipment, down twenty-one of the last twenty-two months, had the largest decrease, down \$1.1 billion or 0.5 percent to \$214.5 billion, due to aircraft and parts and shipbuilding and \$214.5 billion, due to aircraft and parts and shipbuilding and tanks. Instruments and related products, down for the tenth consecutive month, declined \$0.6 billion or 1.2 percent to \$50.0 billion, primarily due to search and navigation equipment. Industrial machinery and equipment, up for the eighth consecutive month, had the largest increase, up \$0.6 billion or 1.1 percent to \$54.5 billion, with increases in nearly all categories. Unfilled order for nondurable goods increased \$0.2 billion or 1.0 percent to \$22.3 billion the increased \$0.2 billion or 1.0 percent to \$22.3 billion, the fourth monthly increase in a row.

Inventories

Inventories for durable goods in February increased \$0.5 billion or 0.2 percent to \$238.7 billion, following a 0.8 percent increase in January. Electronic and other electrical equipment, up seven of the last eight months, had the largest increase, up \$0.4 billion or 1.2 percent to \$34.7 billion. Industrial machinery and equipment increased \$0.3 billion or 0.6 percent to \$46.9 billion the elevanth consecutive monthly. 0.6 percent to \$46.9 billion, the eleventh consecutive monthly increase. Transportation equipment had the largest decrease, down \$0.5 billion or 0.8 percent to \$61.4 billion, due to aircraft and parts. Nondurable goods inventories, up for the first time since August, increased \$0.6 billion or 0.4 percent to \$141.3 billion, primarily due to petroleum and coal products and chemicals and allied products.

By stage of fabrication, finished goods increased 0.8 percent in durables and 0.8 percent in nondurables. Work in process decreased 0.7 percent in durables and 0.1 percent Materials and supplies increased 0.9 in nondurables. percent in durables and 0.2 percent in nondurables.




Total Manufacturing

Three Month Moving Averages





Ratio of Unfilled Orders and Inventories to Shipments




