

Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders

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Note: All figures in text are in seasonally adjusted current dollars

Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in July decreased \$6.5 billion or 2.3 percent to \$273.3 billion, the largest decline since December 1991, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows a 0.8 percent increase in June and is the first decline since February. Year-to-date new orders for 1994 are 8.7 percent above the same period a year ago.

Shipments decreased \$4.6 billion or 1.6 percent to \$274.0 billion, following a 0.8 percent increase in June. This is the third decrease this year and the fourth since last July. Year-to-date shipments for 1994 are 7.3 percent above the same period a year ago.

Unfilled orders decreased \$0.7 billion or 0.2 percent to \$449.0 billion, the first decrease since February. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio increased to 3.01 from 2.98 in June.

Inventories increased \$3.3 billion or 0.9 percent to \$386.4 billion, following a 0.2 percent increase in June. This is the sixth increase this year. The inventories-to-shipments ratio increased from 1.38 in June to 1.41 in July.

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in July decreased \$6.5 billion or 4.3 percent to \$144.8 billion. This is revised from the previously published 4.2 percent decline. Over half of the July decrease was due to the motor vehicle and parts industry, which was heavily affected by the growing practice of shutting down for two weeks in July. The July decline follows a 1.2 percent increase in June and is the first decrease since February.

Transportation equipment had the largest decline, down \$6.0 billion or 15.7 percent to \$31.9 billion, primarily due to motor vehicles and parts, and aircraft and parts. This follows a 2.2 percent increase in June and is the fourth decline this year. Instruments and related products declined \$0.6 billion or 5.1 percent to \$10.9 billion, following a 10.5 percent June increase. Industrial machinery and equipment was down \$0.4 billion or 1.3 percent to \$28.4 billion, following a 3.0 percent increase in June. Fabricated metals had the largest increase, up \$0.2 billion or 1.3 percent to \$15.2 billion.

New orders for nondurable goods were \$128.5 billion, down \$0.1 billion or 0.1 percent from June. The largest increases were in tobacco products and leather and leather products. The largest declines were in food and kindred products, and paper and allied products.

Shipments

Shipments of durable goods in July decreased \$4.4 billion or 3.0 percent to \$145.6 billion. This is revised from the previously published 2.8 percent decline. The decline

follows two consecutive increases and is the third decrease this year. Transportation equipment had the largest decrease, down \$4.5 billion or 11.7 percent to \$34.1 billion, primarily due to motor vehicles and parts. Instruments and related products declined \$0.2 billion or 2.2 percent to \$10.9 billion, following three consecutive increases. The largest increase was in electronic and other electrical equipment, up \$0.1 billion or 0.6 percent to \$22.8 billion, the ninth consecutive monthly increase.

Shipments of nondurable goods declined \$0.1 billion or 0.1 percent to \$128.4 billion. This follows eight consecutive monthly increases. The largest decrease was in food and kindred products, down \$0.4 billion or 1.0 percent to \$35.1 billion. Rubber and plastic products and chemical and allied products also had large declines. The largest increase was in tobacco products, up \$0.2 billion or 8.9 percent to \$2.6 billion.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for durable goods in July decreased \$0.8 billion or 0.2 percent to \$425.0 billion. The percent change is the same as reported earlier. This follows three consecutive monthly increases. Transportation equipment had the largest decrease, down \$2.1 billion or 1.0 percent to \$206.4 billion, due to aircraft and parts. This is the twenty-sixth decrease in the last twenty-seven months. Electronic and other electrical equipment was down \$0.5 billion or 1.1 percent to \$46.2 billion, the third consecutive decline. Industrial machinery and equipment, up for the thirteenth consecutive month, had the largest increase, up \$1.3 billion or 2.1 percent to \$61.7 billion. Unfilled orders for nondurable goods increased \$0.1 billion or 0.3 percent to \$24.1 billion, the ninth consecutive increase.

Inventories

Inventories for durable goods in July increased \$2.2 billion or 0.9 percent to \$243.2 billion, the sixth increase this year. All major groups increased except instruments and related products. Electronic and other electrical equipment had the largest increase, up \$0.6 billion or 1.6 percent to \$37.0 billion, the nineteenth increase in the last twenty-one months. Fabricated metal products increased \$0.6 billion or 2.4 percent to \$23.8 billion, the fourth consecutive increase. Transportation equipment increased \$0.4 billion or 0.6 percent to \$60.7 billion. Industrial machinery and equipment increased \$0.3 billion or 0.6 percent to \$48.8 billion, the sixteenth consecutive monthly increase. Nondurable goods inventories increased \$1.1 billion to \$143.2 billion, the fifth increase in the last six months.

By stage of fabrication, finished goods increased 1.3 percent in durables and 1.5 percent in nondurables. Work in process increased 0.5 percent in durables and 1.2 percent in nondurables. Materials and supplies increased 1.1 percent in durables and declined 0.2 percent in nondurables.




Total Manufacturing

New Orders and Shipments Three Month Moving Averages




