Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in March increased \$2.9 billion or 1.1 percent to \$274.7 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This is the seventh increase in the last eight months and follows a 0.3 percent February decrease. Year-to-date new orders for 1994 are 7.2 percent above the same period a year ago.

Shipments increased \$2.5 billion or 0.9 percent to \$274.3 billion, following a 1.3 percent increase in February. This is the seventh increase in the last eight months. Year-to-date shipments for 1994 are 6.0 percent above the same period a year ago.

Unfilled orders increased \$0.4 billion or 0.1 percent to \$446.6 billion, the second increase in the last three months. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio decreased from 3.07 in February to 3.04 in March.

Inventories decreased \$0.2 billion or 0.1 percent to \$379.8 billion, following a 0.3 percent increase in February. The inventories-to-shipments ratio decreased from 1.40 in February to 1.38 in March, the lowest on record.

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in March increased \$1.1 billion or 0.8 percent to \$147.0 billion. This is the seventh increase in the last eight months and follows a 1.8 percent decrease in February. Primary metals had the largest increase, up \$0.7 billion or 5.6 percent to \$13.2 billion, the seventh increase in the last eight months. Fabricated metal products increased \$0.6 billion or 4.0 percent to \$15.5 billion, the fifth consecutive monthly increase. Industrial machinery and equipment increased \$0.4 billion or 1.6 percent to \$27.6 billion, the eighth increase in the last nine months. Electronic and other electrical equipment increased \$0.4 billion or 1.7 percent to \$21.3 billion, due to electronic components. Instruments and related products had the largest decrease, down \$1.0 billion or 8.7 percent to \$10.0 billion, due to search and navigation equipment. Transportation equipment decreased \$0.5 billion or 1.4 percent to \$37.0 billion, as decreases in aircraft and parts and motor vehicles and parts more than offset an increase in railroad equipment.

New orders for nondurable goods increased \$1.8 billion or 1.4 percent to \$127.7 billion, with increases in all major groups except tobacco products. This follows a revised 1.5 percent increase in February and is the fifth consecutive monthly increase.

Shipments

Shipments of durable goods in March increased \$1.0 billion or 0.7 percent to \$147.3 billion, the seventh increase

in the last eight months. All major groups except lumber and wood products and instruments and related products increased. Stone, clay, and glass products had the largest increase, up \$0.3 billion or 5.2 percent to \$6.7 billion, the fourth increase in the last five months. Transportation equipment increased \$0.3 billion or 0.7 percent to \$39.0 billion, the seventh increase in the last eight months, as an increase in aircraft and parts more than offset a decline in motor vehicles and parts.

Shipments of nondurable goods increased \$1.5 billion or 1.2 percent to \$127.1 billion, the fifth consecutive monthly increase. The largest increase was in chemical and allied products, up \$1.1 billion or 4.2 percent to \$27.8 billion. Tobacco products had the only decline, down \$1.0 billion or 31.4 percent to \$2.2 billion.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for durable goods in March decreased \$0.2 billion or 0.1 percent to \$423.5 billion, the twelfth decline in the last thirteen months. Transportation equipment declined \$2.1 billion or 1.0 percent to \$212.3 billion, as a decline in aircraft and parts more than offset an increase in railroad equipment. This is the twenty-second decrease in the last twenty-three months. Instruments and related products decreased \$0.8 billion or 1.5 percent to \$49.9 billion, due to search and navigation equipment. Industrial machinery and equipment, up for the ninth consecutive month, had the largest increase, up \$1.2 billion or 2.1 percent to \$55.9 billion, with increases in nearly all categories. Primary metals, up for the fourth consecutive month, increased \$1.1 billion or 4.6 percent to \$24.1 billion. Unfilled orders for nondurable goods increased \$0.6 billion or 2.9 percent to \$23.1 billion, the fifth increase in a row.

Inventories

Inventories for durable goods in March decreased \$0.5 billion or 0.2 percent to \$238.3 billion, following a 0.3 percent increase in February. Industrial machinery and equipment had the largest increase, up \$0.5 billion or 1.1 percent to \$47.5 billion, the twelfth consecutive monthly increase. Due to aircraft and parts, transportation equipment had the largest decrease, down \$0.9 billion or 1.5 percent to \$60.4 billion, the lowest level since August 1988. Nondurable goods inventories, up for the second consecutive month, increased \$0.3 billion or 0.2 percent to \$141.5 billion, as increases in food and tobacco products more than offset a decline in chemicals and allied products.

By stage of fabrication, finished goods decreased 0.4 percent in durables and was unchanged in nondurables. Work in process decreased 0.1 percent in durables and increased 0.5 percent in nondurables. Materials and supplies decreased 0.2 percent in durables and increased 0.4 percent in nondurables.




Total Manufacturing


Ratio of Unfilled Orders and Inventories to Shipments
