Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in May increased \$1.6 billion or 0.6 percent to \$276.8 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows a 0.2 percent April increase. Year-to-date new orders for 1994 are 8.4 percent above the same period a year ago.

Shipments increased \$1.4 billion or 0.5 percent to \$275.7 billion, following a 0.1 percent decrease in April. This is the third increase in the last four months. Year-to-date shipments for 1994 are 6.8 percent above the same period a year ago.

Unfilled orders increased \$1.1 billion or 0.3 percent to \$448.5 billion, the fourth increase in the last five months. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio decreased from 3.04 in April to 3.01 in May, the lowest in nearly thirty years.

Inventories increased \$1.9 billion or 0.5 percent to \$382.6 billion, following a 0.2 percent increase in April. This is the fourth increase in the last five months. The inventories-to-shipments ratio remained at 1.39 in May.

New Orders

New orders for durable goods in May increased \$1.6 billion or 1.1 percent to \$148.9 billion, following a 0.3 percent increase in April. This is the third consecutive monthly increase and the ninth in the last ten months.

All major groups except industrial machinery and equipment, electronic and other electrical equipment, and stone, clay, and glass products increased. Transportation equipment had the largest increase, up \$0.8 billion or 2.1 percent to \$36.7 billion, as an increase in aircraft and parts more than offset declines in railroad equipment and motor vehicles and parts. Primary metals increased \$0.7 billion or 5.3 percent to \$13.3 billion, following a 5.1 percent decrease in April. Electronic and other electrical equipment had the largest decrease, down \$1.1 billion or 4.9 percent to \$22.2 billion, primarily due to communications equipment and electronic components. This follows an 8.7 percent increase in April.

New orders for nondurable goods remained at \$127.9 billion as increases, led by paper and allied products, offset decreases, led by tobacco products. This follows six consecutive monthly increases.

Shipments

Shipments of durable goods in May increased \$1.3 billion or 0.9 percent to \$148.2 billion, the third increase in the last four months. All major groups except transportation

equipment increased. Industrial machinery and equipment had the largest increase, up \$0.5 billion or 2.0 percent to \$26.9 billion, with increases in nearly all categories. Primary metals increased \$0.4 billion or 3.0 percent to \$12.7 billion, the fourth consecutive monthly increase. Transportation equipment decreased \$0.5 billion or 1.2 percent to \$37.4 billion, following a 2.5 percent decline in April.

Shipments of nondurable goods increased \$0.1 billion or 0.1 percent to \$127.5 billion, the seventh consecutive monthly increase. The largest increases were in chemicals and allied products, up \$0.3 billion or 1.0 percent to \$28.1 billion, and paper and allied products, up \$0.3 billion or 2.5 percent to \$11.2 billion. Tobacco products had the largest decrease, down \$0.6 billion or 18.2 percent to \$2.6 billion.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for durable goods in May increased \$0.7 billion or 0.2 percent to \$424.4 billion, the second consecutive monthly increase. Industrial machinery and equipment, up for the eleventh consecutive month, had the largest increase, up \$1.1 billion or 1.9 percent to \$58.7 billion, with nearly half the increase in computer and office equipment. Primary metals increased \$0.6 billion or 2.4 percent to \$24.9 billion, the sixth consecutive monthly increase. Transportation equipment decreased \$0.7 billion or 0.3 percent to \$209.1 billion, primarily due to shipbuilding and tanks. This is the twenty-fourth decrease in the last twenty-five months. Instruments and related products decreased \$0.7 billion or 1.5 percent to \$48.5 billion, the twelfth decline in the last thirteen months. Unfilled orders for nondurable goods increased \$0.4 billion or 1.7 percent to \$24.1 billion, the seventh increase in a row.

Inventories

Inventories for durable goods in May increased \$1.5 billion or 0.6 percent to \$240.7 billion, the fourth increase in the last five months. Electronic and other electrical equipment had the largest increase, up \$0.6 billion or 1.6 percent to \$36.1 billion, the seventeenth increase in the last nineteen months. Transportation equipment increased \$0.5 billion or 0.8 percent to \$61.0 billion, primarily due to motor vehicles and parts. Industrial machinery and equipment increased \$0.3 billion or 0.6 percent to \$48.2 billion, the fourteenth consecutive monthly increase. Nondurable goods inventories increased \$0.4 billion or 0.3 percent to \$141.8 billion, the third increase in the last four months.

By stage of fabrication, finished goods increased 0.4 percent in durables and were unchanged in nondurables. Work in process increased 0.7 percent in both durables and nondurables. Materials and supplies increased 0.8 percent in durables and 0.5 percent in nondurables.




Total Manufacturing

Three Month Moving Averages




