Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in August, up for the first month since May, increased \$7.8 billion or 2.6 percent to \$301.6 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows decreases of 1.0 percent in July and 0.1 percent in June and is the third increase this year. Year to date, new orders are 7.7 percent above the same period a year ago.

Shipments, up three of the last four months, increased \$8.9 billion or 3.0 percent to \$302.3 billion, following a 1.8 percent July decrease. Year to date, shipments are 7.9 percent above the same period a year ago.

Unfilled orders, down four of the last five months, decreased \$0.7 billion or 0.2 percent to \$459.7 billion, following a 0.1 percent July increase. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 2.75, down from 2.84 in July.

Inventories increased slightly to \$412.5 billion, the eleventh consecutive monthly increase and the eighteenth in the last twenty months. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.36, down from 1.41 in July.

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in August, up for the first month since May, increased \$7.4 billion or 4.8 percent to \$163.6 billion, revised from the previously published 4.9 percent increase. The motor vehicle and parts industry, which was heavily affected by the growing practice of shutting down for two weeks in July, contributed to about half of this month's durable goods increase and over three quarters of last month's decline. The August durable goods increase follows decreases of 1.8 percent in July and 0.3 percent in June.

Transportation equipment had the largest increase, \$5.1 billion or 15.2 percent to \$38.3 billion, due to motor vehicles and parts and aircraft and aircraft parts. This is the first increase since May and the third this year. Industrial machinery and equipment, up three of the last four months, increased \$1.5 billion or 5.0 percent to \$31.3 billion, following a 6.6 percent July decrease. Primary metals, up for the first month since December, increased \$0.9 billion or 6.4 percent to \$15.2 billion. Instruments and related products, up four of the last five months, increased \$0.8 billion or 7.4 percent to \$11.7 billion. Fabricated metal products, up three of the last four months, increased \$0.2 billion or 1.5 percent to \$16.0 billion. Electronic and other electrical equipment had the only decrease, \$1.6 billion or 5.5 percent to \$26.7 billion, due to electronic components and accessories and communication equipment. This follows a 7.6 percent July increase and is the fourth decline this year.

New orders for nondurable goods, up for the fifth consecutive month, increased \$0.3 billion or 0.2 percent to \$138.1 billion. Increases, led by rubber and plastic products and food and kindred products, more than offset declines led by textile mill products.

Shipments

Shipments of durable goods in August increased \$7.6 billion or 4.9 percent to \$163.5 billion, revised from the previously published 4.7 percent increase. This follows a 3.1 percent July decrease and is the third increase in the last four months and the eighth in the last ten months. All major industries increased with transportation equipment

having the largest increase, \$3.5 billion or 10.2 percent to \$38.3 billion, due to motor vehicles and parts. This follows an 8.1 percent July decline. Electronic and other electrical equipment increased \$1.3 billion or 5.0 percent to \$27.1 billion, the third increase in the last four months. Industrial machinery and equipment, up three of the last four months, increased \$1.1 billion or 3.7 percent to \$31.3 billion. This follows a 2.2 percent July decline. Following two consecutive monthly decreases, instruments and related products increased \$0.6 billion or 5.3 percent to \$11.7 billion. Fabricated metal products increased \$0.3 billion or 2.1 percent to \$16.1 billion, the second consecutive monthly increase. Primary metals, up for the first month since May, increased \$0.2 billion or 1.4 percent to \$14.9 billion. This follows decreases of 1.9 percent and 1.2 percent in July and June respectively.

Shipments of nondurable goods, up four of the last five months, increased \$1.3 billion or 0.9 percent to \$138.8 billion. Led by rubber and plastic products, food and kindred products, and printing and publishing, nearly every major industry group increased.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for durable goods in August increased slightly to \$434.3 billion, revised from the previously published 0.2 percent increase. This follows a slight July increase and is the ninth increase in the last twelve months. Primary metals, up for the first month since February, increased \$0.3 billion or 1.2 percent to \$27.7 billion. Stone, clay, and glass products, up for the third consecutive month, increased \$0.2 billion or 2.7 percent to \$8.0 billion. This follows a 2.2 percent July increase and is the eighth increase in the last twelve months. Transportation equipment, up for the first month since February, increased slightly to \$195.9 billion. Electronic and other electrical equipment had the largest decrease, \$0.4 billion or 0.6 percent to \$54.5 billion. This follows a 4.8 percent July increase and is the second decline in the last twelve months. Fabricated metal products, down for the third consecutive month, declined \$0.1 billion or 0.5 percent to \$21.3 billion.

Inventories

Inventories of durable goods in August increased \$0.2 billion or 0.1 percent to \$259.7 billion. This follows a 0.8 percent July increase and is the eighteenth increase in the last twenty months. Electronic and other electrical equipment had the largest increase, \$0.5 billion or 1.2 percent to \$45.3 billion. This follows a 2.3 percent July increase and is the twentieth consecutive monthly increase. Transportation equipment had the largest decline, \$0.3 billion or 0.4 percent to \$58.8 billion, following a 0.5 percent July increase. Fabricated metal products, down for the first month since September 1994, decreased \$0.2 billion or 0.8 percent to \$25.4 billion.

Inventories of nondurable goods, down for the first month since September 1994, decreased \$0.2 billion or 0.1 percent to \$152.7 billion. Food and kindred products had the largest decrease, \$0.3 billion or 0.8 percent to \$30.6 billion. Petroleum and coal products and chemical and allied products also declined. Tobacco products, up for the second consecutive month, had the largest increase, \$0.1 billion or 2.0 percent to \$5.5 billion.

By stage of fabrication, finished goods decreased 0.1 percent in durables and 0.2 percent in nondurables. Work in process decreased 0.3 percent in durables and 0.5 percent in nondurables. Materials and supplies increased 0.8 percent in durables and 0.1 percent in nondurables.

Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated. 


Total Manufacturing

Three Month Moving Averages




