Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in October decreased \$1.0 billion or 0.3 percent to \$305.1 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows increases of 1.4 percent in September and 2.7 percent in August and is the sixth decline this year. Excluding transportation equipment, new orders increased \$3.6 billion or 1.4 percent to \$266.6 billion, the third consecutive monthly increase. Year to date, new orders are 7.5 percent above the same period a year ago.

Shipments, down for the fourth month this year, decreased \$1.1 billion or 0.4 percent to \$303.2 billion, following increases of 0.4 percent in September and 3.3 percent in August. Year to date, shipments are 7.6 percent above the same period a year ago.

Unfilled orders, up three of the last four months, increased \$2.0 billion or 0.4 percent to \$463.1 billion, following a 0.4 percent September increase. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 2.77, up from 2.74 in September.

Inventories increased \$1.6 billion or 0.4 percent to \$417.8 billion, the thirteenth consecutive monthly increase and the twentieth in the last twenty-two months. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.38, up from 1.37 in September.

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in October decreased \$1.9 billion or 1.1 percent to \$167.1 billion, revised from the previously published 1.0 percent decrease. This follows increases of 3.0 percent and 5.1 percent in September and August respectively and is the sixth decrease this year.

Transportation equipment had the largest decrease, \$4.5 billion or 10.5 percent to \$38.6 billion; led by aircraft and parts, all component categories decreased. This follows increases of 10.6 percent in September and 17.2 percent in August. Industrial machinery and equipment decreased \$0.3 billion or 0.9 percent to \$31.8 billion, following increases of 2.2 percent in September and 5.4 percent in August. Electronic and other electrical equipment, up three of the last four months, increased \$1.7 billion or 6.1 percent to \$29.7 billion, due to electronic components. Instruments and related products, up two of the last three months, increased \$0.9 billion or 8.6 percent to \$11.8 billion, following a 6.4 percent September decline. Primary metals increased \$0.2 billion or 1.5 percent to \$15.2 billion. New orders for nondurable goods, up six of the last seven months, increased \$0.9 billion or 0.7 percent to \$138.1 billion, following a 0.5 percent September decline. Increases, led by paper and allied products, chemicals and allied products, tobacco products, and food and kindred products, more than offset decreases, led by petroleum and coal products and textile mill products.

Shipments

Shipments of durable goods in October decreased \$1.3 billion or 0.8 percent to \$164.6 billion, revised from the previously published 0.7 percent decrease. This follows increases of 1.1 percent in September and 5.3 percent in August. Transportation equipment, down for the sixth month this year, had the largest decrease, \$1.1 billion or 2.7 percent to \$38.6 billion. This follows increases of 2.6 percent and 11.4 percent in September and August respectively. Industrial machinery and equipment

decreased \$0.2 billion or 0.6 percent to \$31.9 billion, following increases of 2.2 percent in September and 4.0 percent in August. Electronic and other electrical equipment decreased \$0.1 billion or 0.4 percent to \$27.5 billion, following increases of 1.7 percent in September and 5.4 percent in August. Fabricated metal products, up three of the last four months, increased \$0.1 billion or 0.7 percent to \$16.0 billion.

Shipments of nondurable goods, up two of the last three months, increased \$0.2 billion or 0.1 percent to \$138.5 billion, following a 0.3 percent September decrease. Chemicals and allied products, up for the first month since July, had the largest increase, \$0.5 billion or 1.6 percent to \$31.0 billion. Tobacco products increased \$0.4 billion or 15.7 percent to \$3.0 billion, the first increase since July. Petroleum and coal products, down four of the last five months, had the largest decline, \$0.4 billion or 3.4 percent to \$12.2 billion.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for durable goods in October increased \$2.4 billion or 0.6 percent to \$439.6 billion, unrevised from the previously published 0.6 percent increase. This follows a 0.7 percent September increase and is the third increase in the last four months. Electronic and other electrical equipment had the largest increase, \$2.2 billion or 4.0 percent to \$56.9 billion, following a 0.7 percent September increase. This is the eighth increase this year and the twelfth in the last fourteen months. Instruments and related products, up for the first month since February, increased \$0.2 billion or 0.5 percent to \$45.6 billion. Primary metals, up for the third consecutive month, increased \$0.2 billion or 0.8 percent to \$28.0 billion, following a 0.1 percent September increase. Fabricated metal products, down four of the last five months, decreased \$0.1 billion or 0.6 percent to \$21.1 billion. Industrial machinery and equipment, down for the fourth consecutive month, decreased \$0.1 billion or 0.1 percent to \$72.7 billion. Transportation equipment decreased slightly to \$199.4 billion. This follows two consecutive monthly increases and declines in nearly every month since September 1991.

Inventories

Inventories of durable goods in October, up for the thirteenth consecutive month, increased \$1.8 billion or 0.7 percent to \$263.5 billion, following a 0.6 percent September increase. Electronic and other electrical equipment had the largest increase, \$0.9 billion or 2.0 percent to \$47.2 billion. This follows a 1.9 percent September increase and is the twenty-second consecutive monthly increase. Transportation equipment increased \$0.3 billion or 0.5 percent to \$59.5 billion, following a 0.5 percent September increase. Industrial machinery and equipment, up for the fourth consecutive month, increased \$0.2 billion or 0.4 percent to \$53.3 billion. Instruments and related products, up for the fifth consecutive month, increased \$0.2 billion or 0.9 percent to \$22.6 billion.

Inventories of nondurable goods, down for the first month since September 1994, decreased \$0.2 billion or 0.1 percent to \$154.3 billion. Declines, led by chemicals and allied products and petroleum and coal products, more than offset increases, led by paper and allied products and printing and publishing.

By stage of fabrication, finished goods increased 0.6 percent in durables and 0.3 percent in nondurables. Work in process increased 0.1 percent in durables and declined 0.4 percent in nondurables. Materials and supplies increased 1.5 percent in durables and declined 0.4 percent in nondurables.

One major component of survey error is nonsampling error, which includes errors of coverage, response, and nonreporting. Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated. 


Total Manufacturing


Ratio of Unfilled Orders and Inventories to Shipments




New Orders and Shipments Three Month Moving Averages
