Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in June decreased \$3.0 billion or 0.9 percent to \$311.2 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows a 2.3 percent May increase and is the first decline since February. Excluding transportation, new orders decreased 0.8 percent, the first decrease since March. Year to date, new orders are 4.3 percent above the same period a year ago.

Shipments, down for the first month since March, decreased \$3.0 billion or 1.0 percent to \$308.2 billion, following a 1.0 percent May increase. Year to date, shipments are 3.3 percent above the same period a year ago.

Unfilled orders, up nine of the last ten months, increased \$3.0 billion or 0.6 percent to \$499.0 billion, following a 0.6 percent May increase. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 2.91, up from 2.89 in May.

Inventories decreased \$0.1 billion to \$434.1 billion, following a 0.3 percent May decrease. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.41, up from 1.40 in May.

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in June decreased \$1.1 billion or 0.6 percent to \$169.2 billion, revised from the previously published 0.8 percent decrease. This follows a 4.2 percent May increase and is the second decrease in the last three months.

Transportation equipment, down two of the last three months, decreased \$0.7 billion or 1.7 percent to \$41.6 billion; a large decline in aircraft and parts, and motor vehicles and parts more than offset an increase in shipbuilding and tanks. This follows a 14.6 percent May increase. Instruments and related products, down three of the last four months, declined \$0.4 billion or 3.0 percent to \$12.1 billion. Fabricated metal products decreased \$0.3 billion or 1.5 percent to \$17.8 billion. This follows a 3.4 percent May increase and is the first decline since March. Primary metals, down for the first month since March, decreased \$0.2 billion or 1.4 percent to \$15.4 billion, following a 2.0 percent May increase. Industrial machinery and equipment, also down for the first month since March, decreased \$0.1 billion or 0.4 percent to \$31.5 billion. This follows a 1.2 percent May increase. Electronic and other electrical equipment, up for the first month since March, increased \$0.5 billion or 2.0 percent to \$26.3 billion, mostly due to communication equipment.

New orders for nondurable goods, down for the first month since February, decreased \$1.9 billion or 1.3 percent to \$142.0 billion, following a 0.3 percent May increase. The largest declines were in petroleum and coal products, food and kindred products, and chemicals and allied products; textile mill products had the largest increase.

Shipments

Shipments of durable goods in June decreased \$1.1 billion or 0.6 percent to \$166.4 billion, revised from the previously published 1.0 percent decrease. This is the first decrease since March.

Transportation equipment, down for the first month since March, had the largest decrease, \$1.3 billion or 3.3 percent to \$38.4 billion, due to aircraft and parts, and motor vehicles and parts. This follows a 4.2 percent May increase. Primary metals decreased \$0.5 billion or 3.2 percent to \$14.6 billion. This follows a slight May decline and is the ninth decline in the last

ten months. Stone, clay, and glass products, down for the first month since February, declined \$0.1 billion or 1.6 percent to \$6.9 billion, following a 3.6 percent May increase. Industrial machinery and equipment increased \$0.4 billion or 1.3 percent to \$31.7 billion, following a 0.5 percent May increase. Electronic and other electrical equipment increased \$0.2 billion or 0.9 percent to \$26.9 billion. This is the second consecutive increase and the fourth in the last five months.

Shipments of nondurable goods, down for the first month since December, decreased \$2.0 billion or 1.4 percent to \$141.7 billion, following a 0.2 percent May increase. Petrolcum and coal products had the largest decrease, \$0.8 billion or 5.1 percent to \$14.5 billion. Food and kindred products, down for the first month since February, decreased \$0.7 billion or 1.9 percent to \$37.9 billion. Chemicals and allied products, down for the first month since March, declined \$0.6 billion or 1.8 percent to \$30.7 billion.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for durable goods in June increased \$2.8 billion or 0.6 percent to \$475.1 billion, revised from the previously published 0.7 percent increase. This follows a 0.6 percent May increase and is the ninth increase in the last ten months.

Transportation equipment, up nine of the last ten months. had the largest increase, \$3.2 billion or 1.4 percent to \$240.3 billion, mostly due to aircraft and parts, and shipbuilding and tanks. This follows a 1.1 percent May increase. Primary metals, up eight of the last nine months, increased \$0.8 billion or 2.6 percent to \$30.6 billion. This follows a 1.8 percent May increase. Fabricated metal products increased \$0.1 billion or 0.6 percent to \$22.3 billion, the fifth consecutive monthly increase. Electronic and other electrical equipment, down seven of the last eight months, decreased \$0.6 billion or 1.3 percent to \$47.9 billion, following a 1.8 percent May decrease. Instruments and related products, down three of the last four months, decreased \$0.4 billion or 0.8 percent to \$47.9 billion, following a 0.1 percent May decline. Industrial machinery and equipment, down for the first month since March, decreased \$0.3 billion or 0.4 percent to \$71.8 billion.

Inventories

Inventories of durable goods in June increased \$0.2 billion or 0.1 percent to \$274.1 billion, following a slight May decrease. This is the fifth increase in the last six months. Transportation equipment, up five of the last six months, increased \$0.9 billion or 1.3 percent to \$66.5 billion. This follows a 0.2 percent May increase. Electronic and other electrical equipment increased \$0.2 billion or 0.6 percent to \$41.2 billion, following a 0.1 percent May decrease. Industrial machinery and equipment, down three of the last four months, decreased \$0.6 billion or 1.1 percent to \$58.9 billion, following a 0.3 percent May decline. Fabricated metal products, down ten of the last eleven months, decreased \$0.2 billion or 0.8 percent to \$25.7 billion, following a 0.6 percent May decline. Instruments and related products, down for the first month since May 1995, declined \$0.2 billion or 0.6 percent to \$24.5 billion.

Inventories of nondurable goods, down for the fourth consecutive month, decreased \$0.3 billion or 0.2 percent to \$160.0 billion, following a 0.7 percent May decline. The largest decreases were in printing and publishing, and paper and allied products.

By stage of fabrication, June finished goods increased 0.8 percent in durables and 0.2 percent in nondurables. Work in process increased 0.5 percent in durables and 0.1 percent in nondurables. Materials and supplies decreased 1.1 percent in durables and 0.9 percent in nondurables.

Note: Estimates of manufacturers' shipments, inventories and orders are subject to survey error and revision. One major component of survey error is nonsampling error which includes errors of coverage, response, and nonreporting. Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated. Further details on survey design, methodology, and data limitations are contained in our most recent annual benchmark publication, Current Industrial Reports: M3-1(92), "Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders: 1982-1992."




Total Manufacturing

New Orders and Shipments Three Month Moving Averages




